**SUBJECT: MORE RAIN-WINDSTORM/THUNDERSTORM (WITH ISOLATED HEAVYFALLS/HAILSTORM) PREDICTED DURING COMING WEEK.**

Met office (vide Letter No. NWFC-5(10A)/2017/161) has informed that another western disturbance is likely to approach western parts of Balochistan on 5<sup>th</sup> April (evening) and likely to persist in upper parts till 9<sup>th</sup> April. Under the influence of this weather system:

- **Widespread rain- windstorm /thunderstorm (with isolated heavyfalls/hailstorm)** is expected in Murree, Galliyat, Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Sargodha, Mianwali, Faisalabad, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Khushab, Jhang, Noorpurthal, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Mandi Bahauddin, Sialkot, Narowal, Lahore, Pakpattan, Okara, Kasur, Sahiwal from 6<sup>th</sup> (evening/night) to 9<sup>th</sup> April with occasional gaps.
- **Rain- windstorm /thunderstorm (with isolated hailstorm)** is expected in Dera Ghazi Khan, Rajanpur, Kot Addu, Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, Rahim Yar Khan, Bhakkar, Layyah, Multan and Khanewal on 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> April.
- **Heavy falls/hailstorm** is also likely in Pothohar region and upper districts on 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> April.

**2. Possible Impacts:**

- Urban flooding is expected in Rawalpindi, Gujrat, Gujranwala and Sialkot on 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> April.
- Due to heavy rains, Flash flood is expected Koh e Sulaiman mountains on 6<sup>th</sup> April.
- Windstorm/ hailstorm and lightning may damage weak structures (electric poles, bill boards, solar panels etc) during the forecast period.
- Hailstorm/windstorm may damage standing crops in Punjab. .
- Farmers are advised to manage their crops according to the prevailing weather conditions
- Tourists and travellers are advised to remain extra cautious and avoid unnecessary travelling during the forecast period.
- Day time temperatures are likely to decrease during the forecast period.

3. In order to maintain high level of preparedness and mitigation of the disaster all the District administrations and line departments are requested to ensure the following measures:

- i. Ensure **sufficient staffing round-the-clock in DEOCs** for effective coordination and response.
- ii. **Coordinate** with PDMA and all relevant departments to ensure **a unified prompt response**.
- iii. Ensure accurate and timely dissemination of **information on safety measures and evacuation plans** through **electronic and social media**.
- iv. Motorway Police shall ensure regular traffic advisories, timely updates on road conditions, and guidance to travelers for safe travel.
- v. Deploy **additional staff** and resources to high-risk areas.
- vi. Stay **alert Rescue 1122** and ensure pre-position search and rescue teams (DRF) along with necessary equipment
- vii. Generate **Situation Reports (SITREPS)** to cover any major incidents/developments on regular basis.
- viii. Ensure **data collection and reporting** for post-flood analysis and improvements.
