CONTINGENCY PLAN -MONSOON FLOOD-2018

INTRODUCTION

District Attock Flood fighting plan envisages such measures, which are required to be taken if the district is threatened by floods. Ordinarily Attock District is not flood prone. However, areas mentioned at **Annex. "A"** are likely to be affected in the coming rainy season. Experience of historic floods of 2010 shows that unusual rains and release of excessive water from Terbela Dam can cause considerable damage, both to life and property specially crops in these areas.

MAIN CAUSE OF FLOOD

After the construction of Terbela Dam, river Indus at times goes in high flood during the monsoon season. If river Kabul also goes into flood, then these two rivers combining at Khairabad can cause havoc down stream as was experienced during historic floods of 2010. Similarly, a number of Nullahs in the District also cause damage to the low lying areas in case of excessive rains. Three tehsils of District Attock namely Attock, Hazro and Jand are likely to be affected, if river Indus bursts into flood.

OBJECTIVE.

The objective of this plan is:-

- a. To take all precautionary measures in order to safeguard human life, cattle and property.
- b. To minimize human misery and suffering in case of unpredicted rains/floods.
- c. To protect vital installation and equipment in case of flood.
- d. To successfully carry out rescue, relief and rehabilitation measures under emergency situations.

CLASSIFICATION OF FLOOD

July to September is the usual period when flood can threaten the District.
Following table shows the rating of flood with reference to water discharge from Terbela.

FLOOD INFORMATION

The Gauge Reader at Skardu is responsible for communicating advance warning. Information received from the Gauge Reader will immediately be passed to the Deputy Commissioner and in case the Deputy Commissioners away from the district then Additional Deputy Commissioner, Attock for appropriate orders. However, concerned authorities of Terbela Dam (for Indus) and Khanpur Dam (for Harro) are also responsible for communicating the release of water from their respective reservoirs. In case of any emergency, they can be contacted at the following telephone numbers:

- Terbela Dam, Terbela 0995-660571
- Khanpur Dam, Khanpur 0995-640061

Although, primarily decision regarding release of water from Terbela Dam is the responsibility of WAPDA/Dam authorities but last years experience shows that had the dam authorities considered the flow in Kabul river before letting loose Indus from Terbela, we might have averted inundation of Nowshera. Close coordination is required between Terbela Dam authorities and respective district administration of surrounding districts which include Attock, Haripur, Sawabi and Nowshera.

DISTRICT FLOOD RELIEF COMMITTEE/EMERGENCY BOARD

OPERATIONAL STRATEGY

EARLY WARNING FROM PDMA/ MET OFFICE

Early warning through district administration, media, Announcements etc. Central Control Room has been established in the office of the District Emergency Officer (Rescue-1122) Attock with Telephone Number 057-9316021. It will work round the clock and will be responsible to collect and coordinate for submission of different reports. Control rooms shall also be established in all the four Tehsil headquarters. Public is being educated time to time and they are being given trainings by Rescue 1122.

ACTIVATION OF ALL DDMA MEMBERS

All the DDMA members will be informed about the level of flood by the secretary DDMA. All departments will send their teams at the camp station. All teams will be responsible for the works assigned to them

MOVING OF RESOURCES TO THE FLOOD AFFECTED AREAS

The Punjab Emergency Services shall deploy resources and staff to the flood prone areas if a need arises keeping in view the severity of the disaster. The resources of adjacent district can also be mobilized to flood hit areas for managing of flood

ESTABLISHMENT OF CAMPS

The sites for the camps have been selected. Keeping in view the experience of Flood 2010, following officials buildings have been identified for establishment of Relief Centres on need basis as such a situations arises, the affectees shall be shifted to these centres.

LIGHT DRF ACTIVATION

Punjab Emergency Service shall declare a state of emergency during which 50% of operational fire and rescue staff shall be mobilized to the flood affected areas.

EVACUATION OF FLOOD AFFECTEES TO THE CAMPS

. The affectees will be taken to the camps. Every department will do its specified job.

CAMP MANAGEMENT

Camp manager will look after the camp. The international standards will be observed in camps. Security, information desk, record keeping, dispensary, school, play area for kids, drinking water, food, live stocks camp, will be maintained.




LONG / LATS OF RESCUE STATION IN DISTRICT

FUNCTIONS OF VARIOUS OFFICERS / DEPARTMENTS

POLICE DEPARTMENT

The District Police Officer, Attock shall.

- a) Provide police assistance in various sectors during emergency to maintain law and order.
- b) Assist Sector Officers in discharge of their duties.
- c) Pass flood messages in affected areas through concerned Station House Officers to sector Incharges.
- d) Make alternate arrangements for traffic in case of suspension of normal routes.

DISTRICT REGIONAL TRANSPORT AUTHORITY

The Secretary District Regional Transport Authority Attock will requisition buses, wagons, Suzuki's for evacuation and relief on demand by the Sector Officers/Sub Sector Officers.

COs (MCs)

The Chief Officer MC in Attock District will conduct survey of the weak structure house building, earmarking the dangerous buildings in their respective areas specially flood prone areas and provide a list thereof to the Sector In charge concerned who shall warn the inhabitants to remain extra careful.

HEALTH DEPARTMENT

The Chief Executive Officer (Health) Attock will be responsible for the following:-

- a. Planning and organizing emergency station for first Aid and medical cover to those who suffer injuries as consequences of flood/heavy rains.
- b. To provide necessary medical facilities and medicines for the affected persons.
- c. To assist in evacuation and hospitalization of the injured/snake bite victims.
- d. To institute preventive and curative measures to prevent occurrence and also stop the spread of disease.

DISTRICT OFFICER (LIVESTOCK AND DAIRY DEVELOPMENT), ATTOCK

The District Officer (Livestock and Dairy Development) Attock will be responsible for the following.

- a. Establishment of flood centers, deputing staff at each centre and briefing the staff accordingly.
- b. Regular submission of daily flood/vaccination report to the District Flood Relief Officer.

- c. Timely collection of vaccine from VRI.
- d. Ensure that sufficient quantity of medicines/vaccine is kept reserved/available in his office.
- e. Assist in saving livestock and maintaining reserves of dry fodder in stock of animal feed.
- f. Provide assistance on flood warning and ensure relief/evacuation operations.
- g. Organize mobile patrolling in the flood affected areas.

DISTRICT FOOD CONTROLLER ATTOCK

The District Food Controller will be responsible to ensure adequate availability of food stock and to organizing depots at locations as required by the District Government, Attock.

XEN BUILDING / XEN HIGHWAY

The Chief Executive Officer (W&S) Attock will ensure that.

- a. Roads are in satisfactory state of repairs and normal flow of traffic during flood emergency continuous.
- b. Survey and inspection of damaged roads and compilation of all repair works immediately.

REVENUE DEPARTMENT

Officials of both departments will be responsible to manage relief camps under the administrative control of Deputy Commissioner, Attock and to assist the District Government in rescue evacuation and relief operation.

WAPDA/IESCO

- a. They will carry out regular survey of WAPDA's installations particularly in flood/rain affected areas and make appropriate arrangements for uninterrupted supply of electricity and also to discontinue the same as and when required by the District Administration.
- b. Ensure electric supply to the residences of Senior Government functionaries to ensure un-interrupted work functioning of government.

PTCL/ NTC

They shall provide uninterrupted telephone communication and keep the telephone exchange open round the clock during emergency.

LIASON WITH LOCAL ARMY UNITS

Close coordination is being ensured with HQ 28 Brigade Abbotabad and 54 Medium Regiment Artillery.

DEWATERING PUMPS

As the Katchi Abdies are badly affected by heavy rains, it is essential to make all possible steps for dewatering in low lying areas of villages after the rains. There are 18 Dewatering Pumps with Tehsil Municipal Administrations in District Attock, which are in working condition, MC Attock has 01, MC Hazro has 02, MC Hassanabdal has 08, MC Pindigheb has 04, MC jand has 01 and MC Fatehjang has 02 Dewatering Pumps. However, arrangements for procuring additional dewatering pumps if required will be the responsibility of respective MCs.

ORGANIZATION

The Attock District is divided into 13 Sectors Officers who are to be appointed by the Deputy Commissioner Attock, will be Incharge of each Sector. The DEO, Attock will act as District Flood Relief Officer and the Assistant Commissioners will act Sector Officer in the Sub Division of their respective jurisdictions. They will be Incharge of the arrangement and will elicit the cooperation and coordination of Health, Livestock & Dairy Development, Communication & Works, Police Civil Defense, Flood Community Development and Telephone Department.

CONTROL ROOMS

A District Control Room at District Headquarter will be established in the Office of Additional Deputy Commissioner , Attock with telephone No. 9316013 and General Assistant (Revenue), Attock will be the overall Incharge of the said Control Room whereas, NTO will assist him in managing the control room. Similar control rooms will be established in the offices of Assistant Commissioners in the District.

VILLAGE COMMITTEES

Village Committees consisting of village notables, nominees of concerned elected representatives, revenue department and union administrations of respective areas will be formed by the concerned Assistant Commissioners and these committee will be kept updated and consulted on all matters to flood efforts.

EVACUATION AND RESCUE

The evacuation and rescue work should undertake in affected areas as and when required. The concerned Sectors Officer will personally supervise any such operation and if the same is spread over different venues then the concerned revenue officer will supervise the same. They shall have the following details with them.

- a. A map of the area giving details of means of communication.
- b. A list of all the habitations with approximate population.
- c. A list of village's areas at higher/safe grounds.
- d. Point to which the evacuated/rescued population shall be shifted.

ASSESSMENT OF DAMAGES

After restoration of normalcy in case flood/heavy rains, a survey of the affected areas will be carried out and loss/damages assessment report will be submitted by the Assistant Commissioners in the District to the Deputy Commissioner for onward submission to the Relief Commissioner, Government of the Punjab, Lahore for further necessary action.
