

- Bhakkar = 39.4 °C



**WEATHER FORECAST (NEXT 24 HOURS)
 (Divisions and upper catchments of rivers wise)**

Scattered thunder storm rain of moderate intensity is expected over the upper catchments of rivers Indus, Jhelum and Sutlej along with Rawalpindi, Sargodha, Gujranwala and DG khan divisions.
Isolated thunder storm rain is expected over the upper catchments of rivers Chenab and Ravi along with Lahore division.

HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION AT 1200 PST


- The water flow in Nullah Basanter (Narowal) is in low flood level (1441 cusecs), at 1200 Low level range: 700-4700 cusecs
- All other Rivers, Hill torrents and Nullahs in Punjab are flowing at normal levels.

FLOOD SITUATION OUTLOOK (14th Sep, 2024 to 20th Sep, 2024)


No significant flood situation is expected in any of the major rivers

CASUALTIES REPORTED FROM 30.06.2024 TO 13.09.2024 (1400 HRS)




