



- Kasur = 4


**RAINFALL OUTLOOK**

### HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION AT 1200 PST

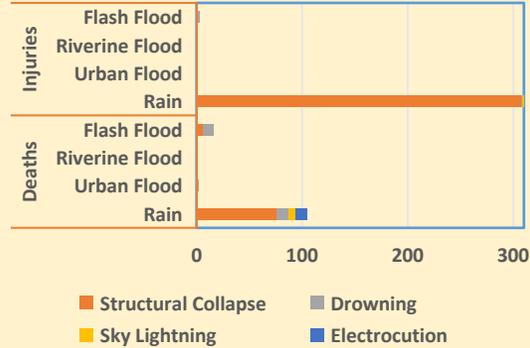
• All the Rivers, Hill torrents and Nullahs in Punjab are flowing at normal levels.

### FLOOD SITUATION OUTLOOK (16th Sep, 2024 to 22nd Sep, 2024)

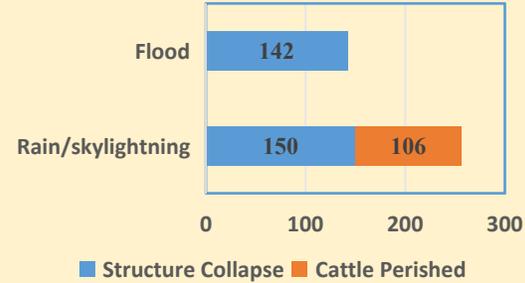
No flood situation is expected in any of the major rivers

### CASUALTIES REPORTED FROM 30.06.2024 TO 15.09.2024 (1430 HRS)



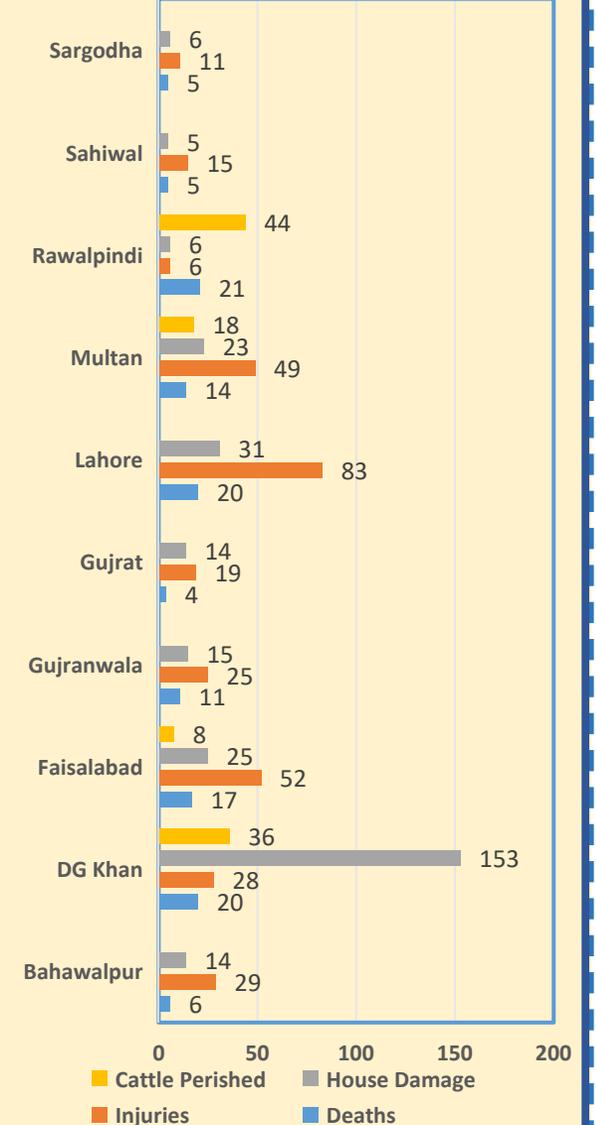
