

- Bahawalnagar = 38.0 °C


Maximum Rainfall (mm) recorded Last 24 Hours (till 0800 HRS)

Scattered thunder storm rain is expected over the upper catchments of rivers Sutlej, Ravi and Chenab from 18th September

WEATHER FORECAST (NEXT 24 HOURS) (Divisions and upper catchments of rivers wise)

Mainly dry weather is expected over the most parts of the country. However, **isolated thunder storm rain of light intensity** is expected over the upper catchments of river Indus along with Rawalpindi division.

WEATHER FORECAST (NEXT 48 HOURS)

No significant change is expected over the most parts of the Punjab. However, **scattered thunder storm rain of moderate intensity** is expected over the upper catchments of rivers Sutlej, Ravi and Chenab.

HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION AT 1200 PST


All the Rivers, Hill torrents and Nullahs in Punjab are flowing at normal levels.

FLOOD SITUATION OUTLOOK (18th Sep, 2024 to 24th Sep, 2024)


Flows are likely to increase in rivers Sutlej, Ravi and Chenab from 19th September

CASUALTIES REPORTED FROM 30.06.2024 TO 17.09.2024 (1300 HRS)




