

- Noor pur thal = 39.0 °C


Maximum Rainfall (mm) recorded Last 24 Hours (till 0800 HRS)

RAINFALL OUTLOOK (20th Sep, 2024 to 26th Sep, 2024)

No flood generating rainfall is expected over the upper catchment of all major rivers. **Monsoon activity** is likely to rebuild significantly **at the end of September.**

WEATHER FORECAST (NEXT 24 HOURS) (Divisions and upper catchments of rivers wise)

Mainly dry weather is expected over the most parts of the country. However, **isolated thunder storm rain of light intensity** is expected over the upper catchments of rivers Sutlej, Ravi and Chenab along with Gujranwala, Lahore and Bahawalpur divisions.

HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION AT 1200 PST


All the Rivers, Hill torrents and Nullahs in Punjab are flowing at normal levels.

FLOOD SITUATION OUTLOOK (20th Sep, 2024 to 26th Sep, 2024)


Slight increase is expected in the flows of Rivers Sutlej, Ravi and Chenab

CASUALTIES REPORTED FROM 30.06.2024 TO 19.09.2024 (1600 HRS)



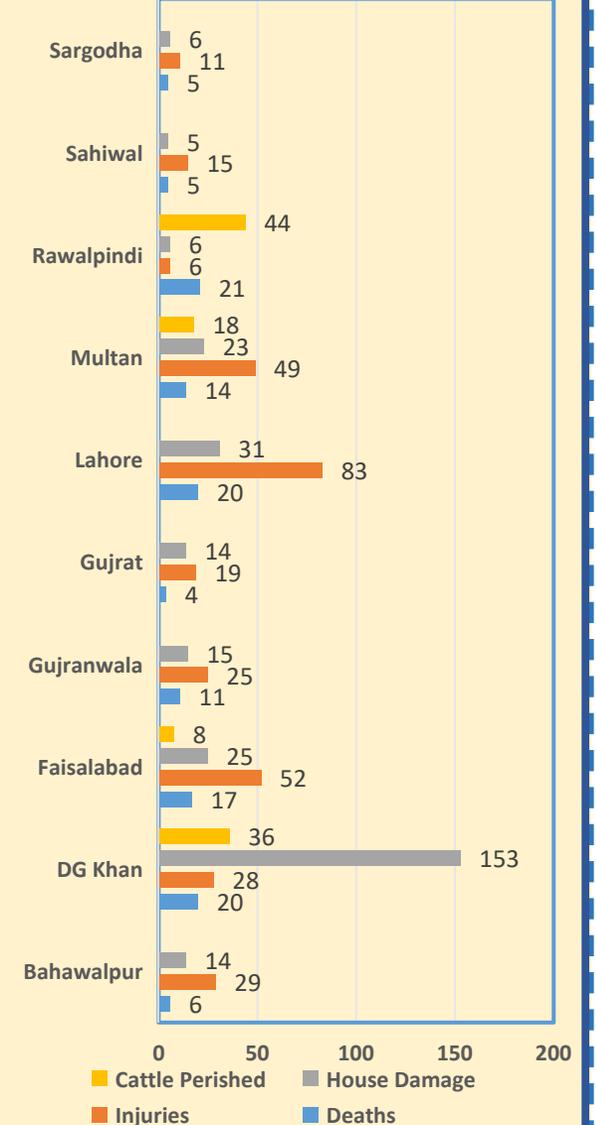
