Maximum Rainfall (mm) recorded Last 24 Hours (till 0800 HRS)


No significant rainfall has been recorded over the past 24 hours in Punjab

RAINFALL OUTLOOK

(22nd Sep, 2024 to 28th Sep, 2024)
 Scattered thunder storm rain of moderate intensity is expected over the upper catchments of all major rivers from 26th September. Northerly wind patterns are likely to become more dominant over the upper parts of the country, creating favorable conditions for the withdrawal of monsoon winds from the northern half in the coming days. However, the influence of the westerly wave is expected to continue.

HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION AT 1200 PST

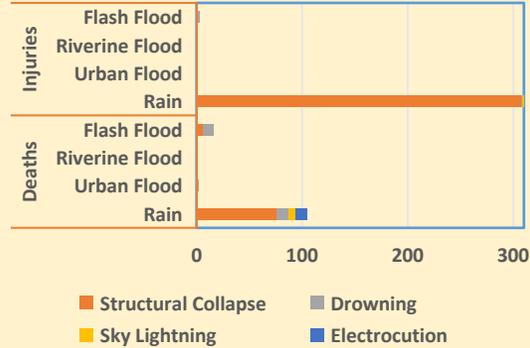
All the Rivers, Hill torrents and Nullahs in Punjab are flowing at normal levels.

FLOOD SITUATION OUTLOOK (22nd Sep, 2024 to 28th Sep, 2024)



CASUALTIES REPORTED FROM 30.06.2024 TO 21.09.2024 (1300 HRS)



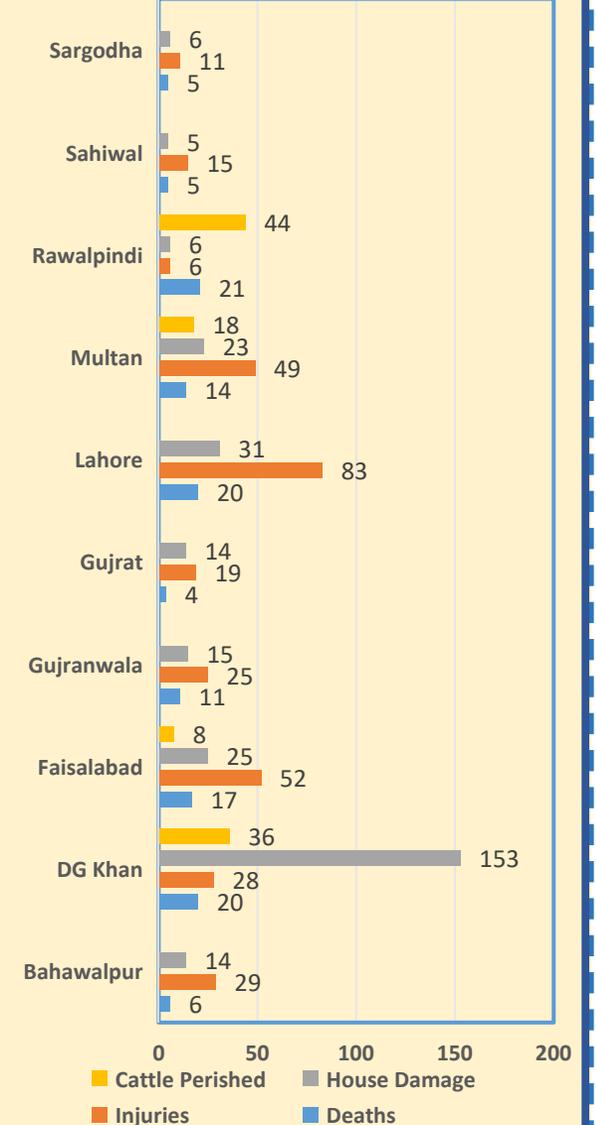
