

RAINFALL OUTLOOK


(23rd Sep, 2024 to 29th Sep, 2024)

Scattered thunder storm rain of moderate intensity is expected over the upper catchments of all major rivers from 26th September.

Northerly wind patterns are likely to become more dominant over the upper parts of the country along with anticyclonic circulation over the border of India and Pakistan, creating favorable conditions for the withdrawal of monsoon winds from the northern half of the country from 23rd September.

However, the influence of the westerly wave is likely to continue.

HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION AT 1200 PST


All the Rivers, Hill torrents and Nullahs in Punjab are flowing at normal levels.

FLOOD SITUATION OUTLOOK (23rd Sep, 2024 to 29th Sep, 2024)


