



Maximum Rainfall (mm) recorded Last 24 Hours (till 0800 HRS)



HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION AT 1200 PST

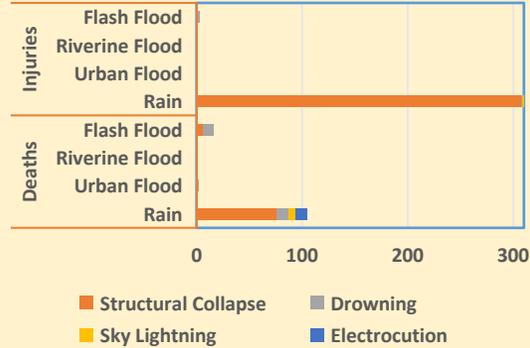
All the Rivers, Hill torrents and Nullahs in Punjab are flowing at normal levels.

FLOOD SITUATION OUTLOOK (27th Sep, 2024 to 3rd Oct, 2024)



CASUALTIES REPORTED FROM 30.06.2024 TO 26.09.2024 (1330 HRS)



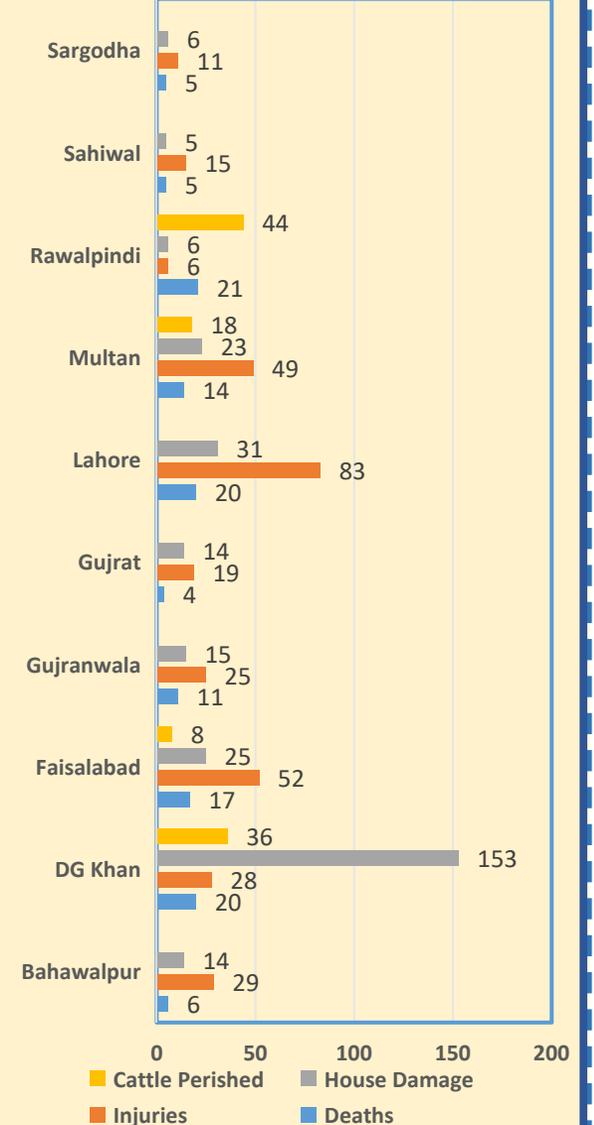
