



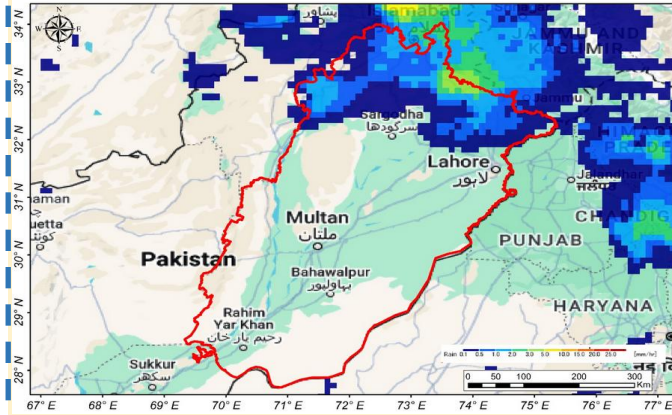

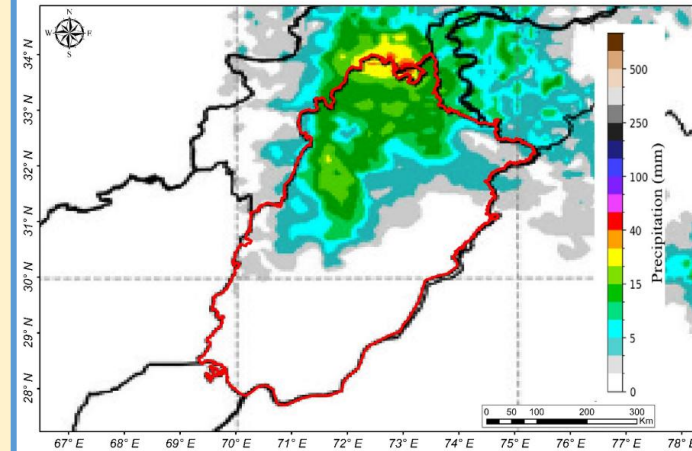

HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION AT 1200 PST

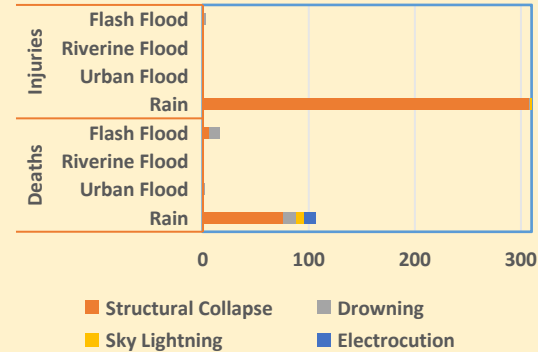
All the Rivers, Hill torrents and Nullahs in Punjab are flowing at normal levels.

FLOOD SITUATION OUTLOOK (28th Sep, 2024 to 4th Oct, 2024)

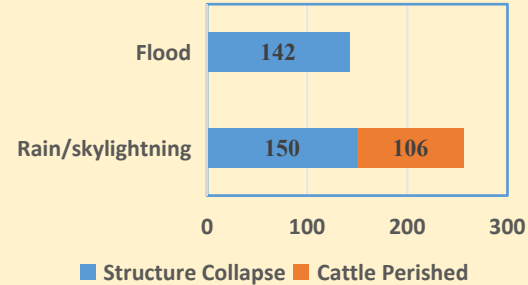

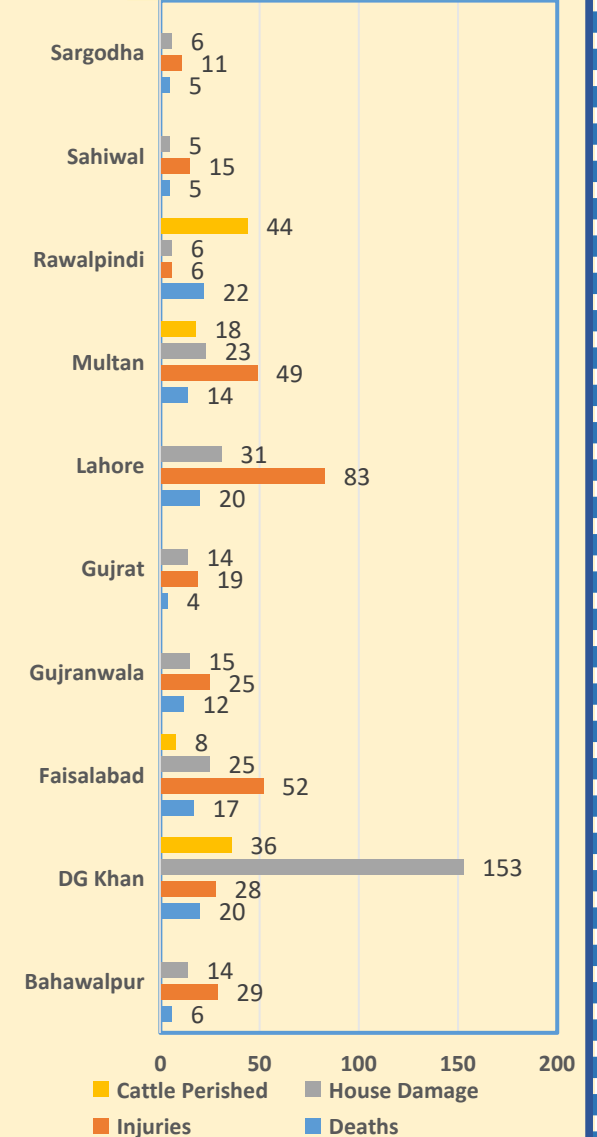
