

Maximum Temperatures recorded (24 hours) (Till 1700 HRS, 3rd October)

- Sahiwal = 38.5 °C


Maximum Rainfall (mm) recorded Last 24 Hours

RAINFALL OUTLOOK (5th Oct, 2024 to 11th Oct, 2024)

Scattered wind thunder storm rain of moderate intensity is expected over the upper catchments of all major rivers during the period

WEATHER FORECAST (24 HOURS) (Divisions and upper catchments of rivers wise)

Mainly dry weather is expected over the most parts of the Punjab. However, **isolated thunder storm rain of light intensity** is expected over the upper catchments of Indus river along with Rawalpindi division.

WEATHER OUTLOOK (NEXT 48 HOURS)

Isolated thunder storm with light to moderate rainfall is expected over the upper catchments of all major rivers along with Rawalpindi, Sargodha and gujranwala divisions

WEATHER ADVISORY

RAIN-WIND/THUNDERSTORM PREDICTED IN UPPER PARTS FROM 5th OCTOBER TO 8th OCTOBER, 2024

Rain-wind/thunder storms (with isolated hailstorm) are expected in Rawalpindi, Murree, Galliyat, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Lahore, Kasur, Okara, Sheikhupura, Sialkot, Narowal, Hafizabad, Wazirabad, Khushab, Sargodha, Mianwali, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Chiniot, Faisalabad **during 5th , 7th and 8th October with occasional gaps,** while **rain-wind/thunder storm** in Sahiwal, Pakpattan, Dera Ghazi Khan, Layyah and Bhakkar from **6th to 8th October with occasional gaps.**

HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION AT 1200 PST


All the Rivers, Hill torrents and Nullahs in Punjab are flowing at normal levels.

FLOOD SITUATION OUTLOOK (5th Oct, 2024 to 11th Oct, 2024)



CASUALTIES REPORTED FROM 30.06.2024 TO 04.10.2024 (1800 HRS)




LOSS/DAMAGES REPORTED IN LAST 24 HOURS TILL 1800 HRS
