



Maximum Rainfall (mm) recorded Last 24 Hours



WEATHER ADVISORY

RAIN-WIND/THUNDERSTORM PREDICTED IN UPPER PARTS FROM 5th OCTOBER TO 8th OCTOBER, 2024

Rain-wind/thunder storms (with isolated hailstorm) are expected in Rawalpindi, Murree, Galliyat, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Lahore, Kasur, Okara, Sheikhpura, Sialkot, Narowal, Hafizabad, Wazirabad, Khushab, Sargodha, Mianwali, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Chiniot, Faisalabad during 5th, 7th and 8th October with occasional gaps, while rain-wind/thunder storm in Sahiwal, Pakpattan, Dera Ghazi Khan, Layyah and Bhakkar from 6th to 8th October with occasional gaps.





CASUALTIES REPORTED FROM 30.06.2024 TO 05.10.2024 (1400 HRS)




LOSS/DAMAGES REPORTED IN LAST 24 HOURS TILL 1400 HRS
