



Maximum Rainfall (mm) recorded (till 0200 HRS)



Moderate Monsoon activity is likely to continue over the upper catchment of all the Major rivers

Weather Forecast (Next 24 Hours)

Scattered thunderstorm rain of moderate intensity with **isolated HEAVY FALLS** is expected over the upper catchments of all major rivers in Punjab (except Bahawalpur Division).
Scattered to widespread thunderstorm rain of moderate intensity with **isolated HEAVY FALL and one or two VERY HEAVY FALLS** is expected over Bahawalpur Division.

No High Flood situation is expected


HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION AT 0000 PST

The water flow at **Tarbela and Kalabagh** is at a **low flood level**, whereas at **Chashma and Taunsa**, it is at a **Medium flood level**. All other major rivers in Punjab are flowing at normal levels.

Structural Collapse Sky-Lightening Drowning Electrocutation


TOTAL LOSS/DAMAGES COUNTS FROM 30.06.2024 to 6.08.2024 (0200 HRS)

- Deaths = 55
- Injuries = 141
- House damages = 72
- Cattle perished = 39

GUIDELINES FOR DDMA's

- Activate control rooms on 24/7 mode, well managed & equipped
- Municipalities / WASAs of Low-lying areas need to be vigilant and keep de-watering and pumping stations ready
- Arrange alternate source of power to keep pumping station operational in case of electricity failure
- Municipalities / WASAs to remove any obstacle in the flow of sewer
- DDMA's to issue early warning to the residents of Low-lying areas
