







RAIN-WIND/THUNDERSTORM PREDICTED IN UPPER PARTS FROM 5th OCTOBER TO 8th OCTOBER, 2024

Rain-wind/thunder storms (with isolated hailstorm) are expected in Rawalpindi, Murree, Galliyat, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Lahore, Kasur, Okara, Sheikhupura, Sialkot, Narowal, Hafizabad, Wazirabad, Khushab, Sargodha, Mianwali, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Chiniot, Faisalabad **during 7th and 8th October with occasional gaps**, while **rain-wind/thunder storm** in Sahiwal, Pakpattan, Dera Ghazi Khan, Layyah and Bhakkar from **6th to 8th October with occasional gaps**.

HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION AT 1200 PST


All the Rivers, Hill torrents and Nullahs in Punjab are flowing at normal levels.

FLOOD SITUATION OUTLOOK (7th Oct, 2024 to 13th Oct, 2024)



CASUALTIES REPORTED FROM 30.06.2024 TO 06.10.2024 (1330 HRS)




LOSS/DAMAGES REPORTED IN LAST 24 HOURS TILL 1330 HRS
