





No rainfall has been recorded in Punjab during the last 24 hours (till 0800 HRS)


RAINFALL OUTLOOK

WEATHER FORECAST (24 HOURS) (Divisions and upper catchments of rivers wise)

Scattered wind thunder storm/rain of moderate intensity is expected over the upper catchments of all major rivers along with Rawalpindi, Sargodha and D G Khan divisions.

Isolated wind thunder storm/rain of light to moderate intensity is expected over Gujranwala, Lahore, Faisalabad and Multan divisions.

WEATHER ADVISORY

RAIN-WIND/THUNDERSTORM PREDICTED IN UPPER PARTS FROM 5th OCTOBER TO 8th OCTOBER, 2024

Rain-wind/thunder storms (with isolated hailstorm) are expected in Rawalpindi, Murree, Galliyat, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Lahore, Kasur, Okara, Sheikhpura, Sialkot, Narowal, Hafizabad, Wazirabad, Khushab, Sargodha, Mianwali, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Chiniot, Faisalabad during 7th and 8th October with occasional gaps, while rain-wind/thunder storm in Sahiwal, Pakpattan, Dera Ghazi Khan, Layyah and Bhakkar from 6th to 8th October with occasional gaps.

HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION AT 1200 PST


All the Rivers, Hill torrents and Nullahs in Punjab are flowing at normal levels.



CASUALTIES REPORTED FROM 30.06.2024 TO 07.10.2024 (1930 HRS)




LOSS/DAMAGES REPORTED IN LAST 24 HOURS TILL 1930 HRS
