




WEATHER ADVISORY




WEATHER SITUATION

LAST 24 HOURS




NEXT 24 HOURS

DISTRICTS WITH HIGHEST AQI







6 HOURLY AQI (LAST 24 HOURS) (DISTRICTS WITH HIGHEST AQI)




LAST 24 HOURS FOG / RIME

Moderate to dense fog is likely in Sialkot, Narowal, Gujranwala, Mangla, Jhelum, Rawalpindi, Lahore, Sheikhupura, Kasur, Okara, Sahiwal, Sargodha, Toba Tek Singh, Hafizabad, Faisalabad, Jhang, Bhakkar, Layyah, Multan, Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, Khanewal, Khanpur, Rahim Yar Khan, DG Khan and surroundings areas.

However, Air quality may likely remain Unhealthy, especially for vulnerable/sensitive groups. Limiting outdoor activities is recommended.
