





#### DISTRICTS WITH HIGHEST AQI







#### 6 HOURLY AQI (LAST 24 HOURS) (DISTRICTS WITH HIGHEST AQI)




#### THERMAL ANOMALIES

### SMOG FORECAST (NEXT 24 HOURS)


#### NEXT 24 HOURS FORECASTED AQI



Smog/fog (in patches) is likely to increase in Sialkot, Narowal, Gujranwala, Jhelum, Lahore, Sheikhupura, Kasur, Okara, Hafizabad, Toba Tek Singh, Jhang, Faisalabad, Bahawalpur, Multan, Khanewal, Rahim Yar Khan and Dera Ghazi Khan and surrounding areas during morning/night.

Air quality will likely remain hazardous to unhealthy, reducing visibility and posing health risks, especially for vulnerable groups. Limiting outdoor activities is recommended.

### SMOG FORECAST (NOVEMBER, 2024)



Low to moderate SMOG levels are expected in mid-November, with a projected rise to moderate to high levels as the month progresses.

#### Highly Vulnerable Districts

Lahore, Sheikhupura, Faisalabad, Kasur, Gujranwala

#### Moderately Vulnerable Districts

Multan, Muzaffargarh, Okara, Sahiwal, Chiniot, Mandi Bahauddin, Hafizabad, Khushab, Jhang

#### Precautionary Measures:

- Wear Masks when going outside to reduce inhalation of smog particles
- Drive less or use public transport to minimize emissions contributing to smog
- Ventilate your house using exhaust fans to reduce indoor air pollution buildup.




## AQI STATUS OVER THE LAST 10 DAYS IN DISTRICTS WITH THE HIGHEST AQI LEVELS


