



DISTRICTS WITH HIGHEST AQI





401 & above	Hazardous



6 HOURLY AQI (LAST 24 HOURS) (DISTRICTS WITH HIGHEST AQI)




THERMAL ANOMALIES

SMOG FORECAST (NEXT 24 HOURS)

NEXT 24 HOURS FORECASTED AQI



Cold and cloudy weather is expected in most districts of the province, while **very cold/cloudy weather with light rain/ light snowfall** may occur at isolated places in Murree, Galiyat and surroundings. **Light rain drizzle** is likely in Sialkot, Narowal, Gujranwala, Lahore and Kasur during the period.

Fog/smog (in patches) is likely at isolated places in Sheikhupura, Sahiwal, Faisalabad, Okara, Multan, Bahawalpur, Rahimyar Khan, D.G.Khan, Bahawalnagar and surroundings. However, **Air quality** may likely remain **Very Unhealthy/Unhealthy, especially for vulnerable/sensitive groups**. Limiting outdoor activities is recommended.

RELIEF COMMISSIONER PUNJAB'S ORDER REGARDING SMOG


Relief Commissioner Punjab in exercise of powers conferred under Section 4(2)(h) of "**The Punjab National Calamities (Prevention & Relief) Act, 1958**", has issued order that there shall be a **COMPLETE BAN** on the following activities in the territorial limits of the province of the Punjab:

- **Burning of any type of crop residue.**
- **Vehicles emitting visible smoke** and pollutants falling into inadmissible limits.
- **All industries working without emission control system** contributing deterioration in Air Quality Index.
- **All stone crushers operating without wet scrubbers.**
- **Burning of all types of solid waste, tyres, rubber and plastics.**
- **Sale and use of all types of sub-standard fuels.**
- **All types of encroachments or parking** which cause **hindrance in the smooth flow of traffic** on public roads including footpaths.
- **All types of activities** without proper safeguard which contribute in **generating fugitive dust.**
- **Uncovered and open dumping/storage of construction material.**
- **Uncovered transportation of construction material** like sand, mud and cement.
- **Any unauthorized activity** which may cause pollution.


