



DISTRICTS WITH HIGHEST AQI





6 HOURLY AQI (LAST 24 HOURS) (DISTRICTS WITH HIGHEST AQI)




THERMAL ANOMALIES

NEXT 24 HOURS FORECASTED AQI



Light rain/ drizzle is likely (on Friday) in Sialkot, Narowal, Gujranwala, Lahore, Sheikhupura and surroundings. **Light to moderate fog/smog (in patches)** is likely in Narowal, Mangla, Sheikhupura, Gujranwala, Lahore, Sahiwal, Faisalabad, Jhang, Okara, Multan, Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, Rahimyar Khan, DG Khan and surrounding areas. However, **Air quality** may likely remain **Very Unhealthy/Unhealthy, especially for vulnerable/sensitive groups**. Limiting outdoor activities is recommended.

RELIEF COMMISSIONER PUNJAB'S ORDER REGARDING SMOG


Relief Commissioner Punjab in exercise of powers conferred under Section 4(2)(h) of "The Punjab National Calamities (Prevention & Relief) Act, 1958", has issued order that there shall be a **COMPLETE BAN** on the following activities in the territorial limits of the province of the Punjab:

- **Burning of any type of crop residue.**
- **Vehicles emitting visible smoke** and pollutants falling into inadmissible limits.
- **All industries working without emission control system** contributing deterioration in Air Quality Index.
- **All stone crushers operating without wet scrubbers.**
- **Burning of all types of solid waste, tyres, rubber and plastics.**
- **Sale and use of all types of sub-standard fuels.**
- **All types of encroachments or parking** which cause **hindrance in the smooth flow of traffic** on public roads including footpaths.
- **All types of activities** without proper safeguard which contribute in **generating fugitive dust.**
- **Uncovered and open dumping/storage of construction material.**
- **Uncovered transportation of construction material** like sand, mud and cement.
- **Any unauthorized activity** which may cause pollution.




Minimum Temperature recorded (Till 0800 HRS, 26 December, 2024)

WEATHER FORECAST (24 HOURS)

- **Cold and dry weather (Thursday, Friday)** is expected in most districts of the province, while **very cold/partly cloudy weather with light rain/light snow may occur during evening/night of Friday** in Murree, Galiyat and surroundings during evening/night.
- However **light rain/ drizzle is likely (on Friday)** in Sialkot, Narowal, Gujranwala, Lahore, Sheikhupura and surroundings.
- **Light to moderate fog/smog (in patches)** is likely in Narowal, Mangla, Sheikhupura, Gujranwala, Lahore, Sahiwal, Faisalabad, Jhang, Okara, Multan, Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, Rahimyar Khan, DG Khan and surrounding areas during morning/night **(Thursday, Friday)**.
