




WEATHER ADVISORY



LAST 24 HOURS



DISTRICTS WITH HIGHEST AQI








Thermal Anomalies in Rahim Yar Khan

Dense fog is likely in Sialkot, Narowal, Gujranwala, Mangla, Jhelum, Rawalpindi, Lahore, Sheikhupura, Kasur, Okara, Sahiwal, Sargodha, Toba Tek Singh, Hafizabad, Faisalabad, Jhang, Bhakkar, Layyah, Multan, Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, Khanewal, Khanpur, Rahim Yar Khan, DG Khan and surroundings areas during morning and night times.

However, **Air quality** may likely remain **Unhealthy, especially for vulnerable/sensitive groups**. Limiting outdoor activities is recommended.
