




## WEATHER ADVISORY



LAST 24 HOURS




### LAST 24 HOURS FOG / RIME

### NEXT 24 HOURS FORECASTED AQI



**Dense fog is likely** in Lahore, Sheikhpura, Kasur, Okara, Sahiwal, Sargodha, Toba Tek Singh, Mandi Bahauddin, Hafizabad, Faisalabad, Jhang, Bhakkar, Layyah, Multan, Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, Khanewal, Khanpur, Rahim Yar Khan, DG Khan and surroundings areas.

However, **Air quality** may likely remain **Very Unhealthy/Unhealthy, especially for vulnerable/sensitive groups**. Limiting outdoor activities is recommended.
