





WEATHER SITUATION



WEATHER FORECAST (24 HOURS)


Sunday (Night):

Light rain/snowfall is likely in Murree, Galliyat and surrounding.

Mainly cold and partly cloudy weather is expected in most districts of the province






Thermal Anomalies in Chiniot, RY Khan and Rawalpindi
