



DISTRICTS WITH HIGHEST AQI





401 & above	Hazardous



LAST 24 HOURS FOG / RIME




THERMAL ANOMALIES

SMOG & FOG FORECAST (NEXT 24 HOURS)

NEXT 24 HOURS FORECASTED AQI



Moderate to dense fog (in Patches) is likely in Sialkot, Narowal, Gujranwala, Mangla, Jhelum, Lahore, Sheikhupura, Kasur, Okara and Sahiwal, while **shallow to moderate fog is likely at isolated places** in Faisalabad, Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, Rahimyar Khan, Multan, D G Khan and surroundings **during morning/night hours.** However, **Air quality** may likely remain **Unhealthy, especially for vulnerable/sensitive groups.** Limiting outdoor activities is recommended.

ACTIONS AGAINST SMOG (STUBBLE BURNING)

RELIEF COMMISSIONER PUNJAB'S ORDER REGARDING SMOG

Relief Commissioner Punjab in exercise of powers conferred under Section 4(2)(h) of "**The Punjab National Calamities (Prevention & Relief) Act, 1958**", has issued order that there shall be a **COMPLETE BAN** on the following activities in the territorial limits of the province of the Punjab:

- **Burning** of any type of **crop residue**.
- **Vehicles emitting visible smoke** and pollutants falling into inadmissible limits.
- **All industries working without emission control system** contributing deterioration in Air Quality Index.
- **All stone crushers operating without wet scrubbers**.
- **Burning** of all types of **solid waste, tyres, rubber and plastics**.
- **Sale and use** of all types of **sub-standard fuels**.
- **All types of encroachments or parking** which cause **hindrance in the smooth flow of traffic** on public roads including footpaths.
- **All types of activities** without proper safeguard which contribute in **generating fugitive dust**.
- **Uncovered and open dumping/storage of construction material**.
- **Uncovered transportation of construction material** like sand, mud and cement.
- **Any unauthorized activity** which may **cause pollution**.

WEATHER FORECAST (24 HOURS)

- **Mainly cold and dry weather** is expected in most districts of the province, while **very cold** in Murree, Galliyat and surroundings.
- **Moderate to dense fog (in Patches)** is likely in Sialkot, Narowal, Gujranwala, Mangla, Jhelum, Lahore, Sheikhupura, Kasur, Okara and Sahiwal, while **shallow to moderate fog is likely at isolated places** in Faisalabad, Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, Rahimyar Khan, Multan, D G Khan and surroundings **during morning/night hours**.
- **Frost is likely to occur at isolated places** in Pothohar region and upper Punjab during morning hours.
- **Gusty winds are expected** in southern districts **during afternoon**.
