EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Multan's history ways back 5000 BC. It was ruled by various ancient empires i.e. Indo-Greek Kingdom, Kushan Empire, Gupta Empire, White Huns, Kushano-Hephthalites and Shah Kingdom. During Muslim era, Dehli Sultnate and Mughal Empire also ruled here. British came here in 1849 and established system of Administration and Transportation Network. It is a center of Islamic teachings and many Sufi Saints established their schools to spread Islam in Sub-Continent. CDG Multan was created in 2005.

AIM AND OBJECTIVES

The plan is aimed to manage emergencies by putting in place requisite mitigation measures and a well-coordinated and integrated response at district level.

The main objectives of the plan include:

- To develop a plan of action for the District Disaster Management Authority and other district stakeholders to set priorities and provide directions for disaster management;
- To define the roles of various stakeholders in disaster management in all the phases pre, during and after disaster;
- To raise awareness of stakeholders about disaster risks and the requirements for disaster management;
- To introduce coordination mechanism for immediate response and rehabilitation at district level;
- To enhance the effectiveness and timeliness of emergency response through the clarification of goals, strategies, roles and responsibilities;
- To strengthen response coordination between government departments and humanitarian organizations (UN agencies, I/NGOs);




DISTRICT BASELINE/REFERENCE MAP

Powers and functions of District Disaster Management Authority under NDM Act 2010:

The District Authority shall be as the district planning, coordinating and implementing body for disaster management and take all measures for the purposes of disaster management in the district in accordance with the guidelines laid down by the National Authority and the Provincial Authority.

Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing provisions, the District Authority may:

- a) prepare a disaster management plan including district response plan for the district;
- b) coordinate and monitor the implementation of the National Policy, Provincial Policy, National plan, Provincial Plan and District Plan;
- c) ensure that the areas in the district vulnerable to disasters are identified and measures for the prevention of disasters and the mitigation of its effects are undertaken by the departments of the Government at the district level as well as by the local authorities;
- d) ensure that the guidelines for prevention, mitigation, preparedness and response measures as laid down by the National Authority and the Provincial Authority are followed by all departments of the Government at the district level and the local authorities in the district;
- e) give directions to different authorities at the district level and local authorities to take such other measures for the prevention or mitigation of disasters as may be necessary;
- f) lay down guidelines for preparation of disaster management plans by the departments of the Government at the districts level and local authorities in the district;
- g) monitor the implementation of disaster management plans prepared by the departments of the Government at the district level;
- h) lay down guidelines to be followed by the departments of the Government at the district level;
- i) organize and coordinate specialized training programs for different levels of officers, employees and voluntary rescue workers in the district;
- j) facilitate community training and awareness programs for prevention of disaster or mitigation with the support of local authorities, governmental and non-governmental organizations;
- k) set up, maintain, review and upgrade the mechanism for early warnings and dissemination of proper information to public;
- l) prepare, review and update district level response plan and guidelines;
- m) coordinate with, and give guidelines to, local authorities in the district to ensure that pre-disaster and post-disaster management activities in the district are carried out promptly and effectively;
- n) review development plans prepared by the departments of the Government at the district level, statutory authorities or local authorities with a view to make necessary provisions therein for prevention of disaster or mitigation;
- o) identify buildings and places which could, in the event of disaster situation be used as relief centers or camps and make arrangements for water supply and sanitation in such buildings or places;
- p) establish stockpiles of relief and rescue materials or ensure preparedness to make such materials available at a short notice;
- q) provide information to the Provincial Authority relating to different aspects of disaster management;
- r) Encourage the involvement of non-governmental organizations and voluntary social-welfare institutions working at the grass root level in the district for disaster management.
- s) ensure communication systems are in order and disaster management drills are carried out periodically; and
- t) perform such other functions as the Provincial Government or Provincial Authority may assign to it or as it deems necessary for disaster management in the district.

District Plan:

- a) There shall be a plan for disaster management for every district of the province.
- b) The District Plan shall be prepared by the District Authority having regard to the National Plan and the Provincial Plan.
- c) The District Plan shall be reviewed and updated annually.

Additional Powers of District Authority:

For the purpose of assisting, protecting or providing relief to the community, in response to any disaster, the District Authority may:

- a) Directions for the release and use of resources available with any department of the Government and the local authority in the district;
- b) Control and restrict vehicular traffic to, from and within, the vulnerable or affected areas;

- c) control and restrict entry of any person into, his movement within and departure from, a vulnerable or affected area;
- d) Remove debris, conduct search and carry out rescue operations;
- e) Provide shelter, food, drinking water and essential provisions, healthcare and services;
- f) Establish emergency communication system in the affected area;
- g) Make arrangements for the disposal of the unclaimed dead bodies;
- h) Direct any department of the Government of the Province or any authority or body under the Government at the district level to take such measures as are necessary in its opinion;
- i) Require experts and consultants in the relevant fields to advise and assist as it may deem necessary;
- j) Procure exclusive preferential use of amenities from any authority or person;
- k) Construct temporary bridges or other necessary structures and demolish structures which may be hazardous to public or aggravate the effects of the disaster;
- l) Ensure that the non-governmental organizations carry out their activities in an equitable and non-discriminatory manner; and
- m) Take such other steps as may be required or warranted to be taken in such a situation.

Revenue Department (Functions and Responsibilities)

In case of any disaster or calamity the head of the revenue department in the district i.e. the DCO/DC should ensure that the following measures and steps have been taken:

- Taking everyone on board is perhaps the most important thing to do. Regular meetings of DDMA should be held to clearly highlight the roles and duties of DPOs, EDOs, XENs etc.
- Pre-flood meeting should be held and duties of all concerned officers and departments should be clearly defined and assigned.
- A district disaster management plan should be prepared using the set template and updated regarding any disaster or emergency that may strike the district.
- A focal person for the disaster or calamity should be nominated and his/her number should be communicated to all concerned departments.
- Proper stock taking should be done regarding available stocks of food and rations. Similarly, stock regarding machinery and equipment should also be taken and inventories should be prepared. Out of order machinery should be repaired or replaced.
- Committees should be formed and constituted which will deal with various functions during a flood or emergency. Purchasing of food items, food, and machinery should all be done through committees.
- Identification of Low lying, medium and high vulnerability levels with flood level
- In case of evacuation the district administration should be very clear about the places where the relief camps or shelters will be established. Teams should be formulated which will look after these camps and will be in-charge for provision of tents, food, water and maintaining general law and order. Provision of cooked food is also to be ensured.
- Proper ware houses and stores should be made available for storing of aid and donated items that may be received from authorities such as PDMA, WFP etc. A committee should be constituted to look after the record of all the items in the store.
- Proper crop surveys/ Girdawaris should be conducted through the revenue officials so that crop damage assessment can be made after disaster or flood affects the district. These surveys will also help in determining the identity of the true owners as well.
- Post damage assessment should be carried out by joint teams constituted of patwaris, teachers, and agriculture field assistants. Technology should be involved and android sets should be used to gather accurate data.
- Round the clock active control rooms should be set up and the numbers be circulated to all concerned. The control rooms should be equipped with wireless, telephones and computers. All info gathered or received should be conveyed to the concerned. The control room should have representatives of concerned departments such as police, health, 1122, and revenue.
- Early warning is critical in saving lives. The local revenue officials along with local police should be deployed to warn the people against the oncoming disaster and to urge them to vacate the disaster-prone areas and villages. Loudspeakers, mosque speakers and word of mouth should be used. Banners and posters can also be used.
- Data collection is of prime importance and the senior network administrator should be declared as the focal person for collection of relevant information such as number of casualties, damages to infrastructure, injured, perished livestock etc. for onward submission to PDMA etc.
- Mock exercises should be carried out along with all concerned departments specially 1122, Police, civil defence and Pakistan army regarding the action plan during any emergency or flood. This will give a fair idea about the preparedness of the district.

- Availability of vehicles should be ensured for use during any emergency especially off-road vehicles like jeeps.
- Suitable locations should be identified for accommodating armed forces like the Pakistan army. Normally schools, colleges or stadiums are allocated for the armed forces

Checklist for Revenue Department:

- Survey of entire District (Preparation of Village level information by Patwari)
- Identification of Low lying, medium and high: vulnerability levels with flood level
- Liaison of Patwari with Lumberdars of their respective villages
- Contacts of all revenue staff posted near river belts and their output in flood prone areas
- List of Lumberdars with their contacts, volunteer from low lying settlements with contact numbers
- Prepare list of vulnerable villages and make an estimate of likely affected population in such villages in the event of flood
- Name and contact numbers of private boat owners and operators Announcement of Flood Warning at settlement level – Patwari responsible Forced evacuation with police
- Rapid assessment for relief goods and ration provision Coordination and reporting
- Carry out survey of entire flood affected areas to assess losses in collaboration with Agriculture, Livestock and Education Department
- Conduct crop damaged/ house damaged surveys

Tehsil / Town Municipal Administration (TMA)

- Tehsil / Town Municipal Administration (TMA) plays an important role of providing municipal services in the district including clean drinking water, sanitation facilities, maintenance of parks and removal of encroachment etc.
- Tehsil / Town Municipal Administration TMA will provide assistance to the District Government for setting up and management of relief camps/ operations.
- TMAs are responsible for provision & restoration of water and sanitation facilities in their municipalities besides disposal of waste or rain water/sewerage.
- TMAs are equipped with trucks, water bowsers, tractors, dewatering sets, bulldozers, loaders and dump trucks. All of this equipment is utilized to restore proper sanitary facilities, ensure the delivery of clean water and remove debris or excess water.
- TMAs sanitary workers can be employed for cleaning relief camps, or other such areas which has been affected by any disaster.
- TMAs employ de-watering sets to remove excess water. All TMAs are required to ensure the maintenance of all dewatering sets prior to the monsoon season. The TMA maintains a list of all the choking points where rainy water accumulates as a result of heavy storms which can cause urban flooding.
- TMA should ensure supply of clean drinking in overhead reservoirs and ensure supply to the affected areas or relief camps through water bowsers. Clean drinking water is a major issue and requirement during any disaster.
- In case of any disaster that requires people to be relocated, the TMA under the concerned Administrator i.e ADC/AC will assist in the migration of the affected people.
- During the relief effort and subsequent rehabilitation effort the, the local TMAs manpower can be effectively used for the distribution of food and essential commodities among evacuated people or any other relief activity such as provision of cash compensation.

District Disaster Management Authority (DDMA)

- DDMA's are created under the NDM Act 2010 under Chapter IV Section 18 and the law defines their composition and also outlines their functions, duties and powers.
- District Disaster Management Authorities are the first line of defense and the implementing arm of the government policy and plans. Within the district there are three to four key players/departments that have to put up a joint and coordinated effort in order to fight with and handle any disaster under the leadership and coordination of the DC. The office of the DC fully supported by the CPO and line departments such as Health, Agriculture, Livestock, Civil Defence, 1122, TMAs and the Revenue Department form the main disaster management team within any given district. This plan is an effort to highlight their sets of responsibilities followed by the role of provincial departments.
- All district administrations had prepared a detailed contingency plan to face any disaster or hazard specially floods which until recently have become an annual affair for some districts.

- The district administration will divide the area as per district division with the Assistant Commissioner as in charge of his/her tehsil. All disaster related activities in a said tehsil will be coordinated through the concerned AC and the TMAs.
- On receipt of a flood warning, immediate warning will be conveyed to all the concerned officers. Immediate action will be taken in each sector / sub sector for evacuation of the population from risk prone areas to safer places or to Relief Camps. An Assistant Commissioner will ensure that announcements are made through loudspeakers of the mosques utilizing the services of the Revenue department. Each Patwari will inform the Lumbardar, Headmaster of the School, Imam Masjid and councillors to make announcements etc.
- The tactical operations would be headed by the Additional District Collector (ADC). The ADC would be responsible for coordinating and supervising the disaster control and relief measures in the district.
- Provincial government had notified the following composition of DDMA's for whole of the province:
 - i. **Deputy Commissioner (Chairperson)**
 - ii. Mayor of Municipal Corporation
 - iii. Chairman District Council
 - iv. City Police Officer
 - v. Two Elected Representatives to be nominated by the Chair
 - vi. Representative of Pak Army
 - vii. Two Representatives of NGOs/Civil Society to be nominated by the Chair
 - viii. Chief Executive Officer (Health)
 - ix. Chief Executive Officer (Education)
 - x. Additional Director Livestock
 - xi. Deputy Director Agriculture (Extension)
 - xii. District Food Controller
 - xiii. SP/DSP Special Branch
 - xiv. Executive Engineer, Irrigation
 - xv. Executive Engineer, Public Health
 - xvi. Executive Engineer, Highways
 - xvii. Executive Engineer, Buildings
 - xviii. District Emergency Officer, Rescue 1122 (Secretary)
 - xix. Representative of Red Crescent
 - xx. All Chief Officers Municipal Corporation/committees/District Council
 - xxi. Federal Government Officers which the DDMA's decide to co-op as per powers delegated under section 20 & 22 of NDM Act 2010.
- District Governments must establish a Disaster / Flood control room at the DCO's office, the numbers of which will be circulated to all concerned. The Disaster / Flood Control Room has to maintain updated information regarding the threat of disaster and statistics post disaster. The centre will maintain a regular communication with the Flood Forecasting Division or the dam authorities up stream in case of a flood.
- The District Government would immediately mobilize the equipment needed to tackle the challenges created by a disaster. The District Governments will provide a comprehensive list of flood fighting equipment to PDMA as part of their flood contingency plans.
- Chief Executive Officer (Health) will ensure the availability of adequate medicines for treatment of common issues, particularly for snake and dog bite cases and general vaccines at each relief camp.
- EDO (Agriculture) and DO Livestock would arrange fodder and feed supplement for livestock and animals displaced.
- District Regional Transport Authorities (DRTA) in all 36 districts of Punjab are managed by Secretaries who would coordinate with local transporters to arrange for arranging transport required for evacuation of people from affected areas. In case of shortfall in transport in a particular district, the adjoining district would mobilize the transporters in his district to assist with the evacuation of people.

Role of Rescue 1122 in districts during disaster

- The immediate evacuation of people from the disaster prone and vulnerable areas.

- Provision of immediate medical aid during any emergency and at the same time transporting the injured or sick to the nearby hospital through their team of ambulances.
- In flood situations rescuing people from drowning in the strong currents is a specialty of 1122 as it has its own set of divers and boats. Similarly in case of collapsed buildings or structures the 1122 is equipped with heavy machinery to cut through heavy debris.
- Apart from that responsible deployment of fire fighters, cordoning of hazardous areas, provision of first aid and medical treatment, immediate search and rescue of victims and management of the pre-hospital emergency system.
- Rescue 1122 is well trained in setting up medical camps for provision of emergency medical treatment. These camps are setup by Rescue 1122's doctors and paramedic staff.

- Additional Deputy Commissioner (Rev)/District Flood Relief Officer will be overall incharge of DEOC.
- The System Network Administrator (SNA), Multan is the focal person of DEOC.
- All the emergencies will be monitored in DEOC.
- Duty roster is issued by the ADC-R/DEOC Incharge.
- The officials deputed for duty shall be given training by the DEOC Incharge about their role and duties.
- The officers/officials on duty at DEOC, will note each and every complaint received telephonically and through print/electronic media & will take action as per SOPs of the operational manual of DEOC.
- The foregoing arrangements shall also be made on the similar pattern at offices of the Assistant Commissioners officers.

During monsoon season, (in normal situation) Information regarding discharge position of River Chenab and all Nullahs in the District shall be received twice a day, in case of any potential threat or emergency, frequency of information shall be increased. 

Role of Health Department

The public sector health delivery system comprises of four tiers and as such will continue to provide services at these four tiers during and after any disaster:

Outreach and Community Based Activities, which focus on immunization, sanitation, malaria control, maternal and child health, and family planning. Primary care facilities include BHUs, RHCs. THQs and DHQs provide inpatient and outpatient care. Tertiary care hospitals located in the major cities for more specialized care.

In case of any disaster or calamity the health department will ensure that the following measures are in place;

- To provide first aid to the injured people and arrange evacuation of patients for further assistance.
- Medical camps and mobile health teams should be arranged for prevention and control of communicable diseases, immunization and provision of essential drugs.
- Health department would make a roster of all medical officers and paramedics that would be deployed to these camps and teams.
- Drugs and other medical equipment should be available at all these camps and with mobile teams. The medicine should be for relevant flood related issues, **particularly Anti-snake venom, Anti-rabies.**
- The shelters or relief camps established by the district administration should have medical centres with ambulances and special facilities for women and children.
- An emergency control room will be established in the office of Directorate General Health Services and a representative of this emergency control room would be designated to PDMA's control room.
- A list of essential medicines would be prepared by the health department and it would ensure that medicines and other resources are present in sufficient stocks in hospitals in disaster hit areas.
- Medical colleges may be involved to create Emergency Response teams
- Health department would also coordinate with international organizations such as WHO and UNICEF.
- Extensive disease surveillances in the disaster hit areas should be carried out warnings if needed be issued through the Disease Early Warning System.
- Medical teams and paramedic staff should be mobilized and deployed for rapid assessment and quick response in the affected areas.
- A contingency plan will be prepared and submitted regarding preparedness for any disaster or calamity.
- The National Disaster Management Authority has designated WHO as the key organization that will fill the gaps in the supply of medicines, rapid diagnostic kits, and vaccinations etc.
- The department would employ female health workers in emergency areas specially, for spreading awareness regarding health risks in a disaster and for any vaccination or immunization programme that may be needed during any emergency.
- A Health and Nutrition Cluster for overall management and oversight of Health department's disaster response would be formed at the Directorate General Health office.
- In case the medicine stocks or even the infrastructure is damaged due to floods, the department would draw up a plan for early recovery of health infrastructure and service delivery.

- Provision of immediate medical aid during any emergency and at the same time transporting the injured or sick to the nearby hospital through their team of ambulances.

- Apart from that responsible deployment of fire fighters, cordoning of hazardous areas, provision of first aid and medical treatment, immediate search and rescue of victims and management of the pre-hospital emergency system.

Civil-Military Coordination Mechanism

To meet the flood situation successfully, Army shall be deployed along banks of River Chenab upon formal requisition of by the DC on request of ADC Revenue and District Emergency Officer, Punjab Emergency Service Department, Multan. 02 Army Units are likely to be deployed for relief operation in case of any emergency; Army will establish Control Center at Headquarters 111 Independent Infantry Brigade, Westridge Multan. This Center will assist the Civilian Authorities in relief operations and restoration of services in the areas of emergency.

Volunteer Network

E.g. how many registered volunteers, how to activate them, who will coordinate with them etc.

There are 210 volunteers registered with the Civil Defense. Civil Defence Officer remains continuous in touch with the volunteer by means of their participation in different training programs conducted for their capacity buildings and in different events (National & International). In case of disaster already designated Team Leader is contacted first, who subsequently disseminate the same information to all team members for coordinated response.




2. Hazards

- Experience has shown that abnormal heavy rains in catchment areas result in flash floods in in the city of Multan caused damages in 2001, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2014 and 2015. Though the flood water recedes within a period of 3-8 hours, it causes considerable damage in the city area. Local drains from Old Multan City like, Ghanta Ghar, Bohar and Haram Gates and Cantonment area also fall in it which further aggravates the situation, especially when these drains cannot find their way into Nullah which is already in flood, causing inundation of surrounding low-lying areas (back water effect).
Flash Flood urban flood due to heavy monsoon rains is being planned every year for medium and high risk. The potential sites/vulnerable areas have been pointed out across the board.
Mainly heavy rainfall during monsoon season is the main triggering factor for urban flash flooding along with contributing factors of throwing of garbage in the main stream as well as in tributaries of nearby vulnerable areas.



Alertness Levels

Following four levels alertness have been established:

EARLY WARNING

Flood Forecasting and Early Warning System

Flood Forecasting and Early Warning System should be announced by Irrigation Department, Patwaris and through announcement in loud speakers of masjid. Master control Room which is controlled by Met office issues forecast information to District Emergency Operation Center (DEOC). Rescue 1122 is looking after Flood control Room and that disseminate area on alerts to residents living in vulnerable areas.

District Emergency Control Room disseminates immunity flood information to residents of low-lying areas by blowing risers which are installed along River Chenab. District Control Room also plays role coordination & Communication along all stakeholders.

After receiving information of pre alert through District Flood control Room, all the relevant stakeholders are part on high alert and their team start deployment in highly vulnerable low-lying areas.

DISTRICT EMERGENCY OPERATION CENTER (DEOC)

A Central Control Centre has been established at Kalma Chowk Rescue 1122 building with landline # 061-9200357, under the command of Deputy Commissioner & with the assistance of District Emergency Officer, Rescue 1122. This Control Room shall be the source of dissemination of information to the concerned departments and will also act as Operation Centre for coordinating all response activities. All the concerned departments / emergency service.

RESCUE STRATEGY

- i. Strategic Command will be done by the Deputy Commissioner being the Chairman of District Disaster Management Authority (DDMA) and District Emergency Board (DEB)
- ii. The main focus of strategic command will be to establish the priorities and strategy for managing the flood situation and to supply the resources to deal with it.
- iii. Strategic Command has established a clear and unambiguous command structure based upon the experiences of previous years, Geographical Condition of District, unpredicted Climatic changes, resources held and future challenges.
- iv. A key function of Strategic Command will be to pre-deploy rescue and flood management Resources to District and Tehsil level Rescue Teams.
- v. Joint meetings of DDMA and DEB will be held before start of Flood season to review the preparation for the flood season, identify the resource gap/short comings and ensure timely completion/procurements.

HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE

Damages and loss data due to flash flooding and river flooding shall be collected from concerned Assistant Commissioners, and communicated to Additional Deputy Commissioner (R), Multan, which is then forwarded to Deputy Commissioner, Multan for onward of submission to Board of Revenue Punjab.

The Priority needs of affected people flood and earthquake (food, shelter, health etc.) is determined by taking recommendations from concerned stakeholders like Health Department, Education Department, Rescue 1122, Civil Defence, Building Department and Revenue Department of Multan.

The affected population due to flood or earthquake shall be shifted to the designated relief camps by Rescue 1122, Civil Defense and Volunteers.

Food and Health assistance will be provided by the Revenue Department and Health Department. Similarly, the need of rehabilitation of affected victims is assessed and evaluated by these.

PDMA has already issued the standardization of different packages/kits for food and tentage needs of affected victims. Whole of the activity regarding humanitarian assistance and monitoring is supervised by Additional District Collector in consultation with all relevant stakeholders in order to avoid duplication of resources and identification of gaps.

All the affected victims are shifted to the already designated relief camps in school. No separate camps are established as the flood emergency in Multan is of flash flood nature.

Multan District has sufficient capacity in terms of provision of food, shelter, medicine to cater maximum number of victims for more than even three months' time

As for as humanitarian strategy regarding protection, gender, age, environment and other cross cutting issues or concerned, the administration of Multan has taken diligent steps which are as follows:

- a. Issuance of early warning by Rescue 1122, Multan.
- b. Rescue and Shifting of Victims to hospitals and Relief Camps by Rescue 1122 and Civil Defense Volunteers.
- c. Establishment of relief camps in predestinated schools and relief camps established by District Administration.
- d. Humanitarian assistance of the victims by involving Health, Education and Revenue Department.
- e. Foolproof coordination and communication among all stakeholders through pre-alert warning issued by Rescue 1122.

DEPARTMENTWISE OPERATIONAL PLANS

Disaster Management Services

I. Health Department Service

- The CEO (Health) shall be the incharge of these Services.
- ❖ Functions
- He shall cause to be prepared flood contingency plan pertaining to health department by 31st March every year.
- The CEO (Health) shall purchase complete emergency medicine by 30th April every year. All flood emergency related medicines shall be purchased in sufficient quantity.
- The DHO shall notify Health & Nutrition Coordination Committee.
- The Health & Nutrition coordination committee shall hold meetings on weekly basis.
- The CEO (Health) and DHO shall arrange deficient stock of logistics supplies till 15th June. (Tents, Medicine stock)
- The CEO (Health) will nominate NGOs / CBOs who shall be helpful during flood till 2nd Week of April.
- The CEO (Health) and DO (H) shall ensure the supply of logistics and medicine stock at designated points till 20th June of every year.
- The CEO (Health) and DHO shall arrange orientation training of Medical Officers and paramedical staff about flood relief camps and disease reporting till 2nd week of June.
- The CEO (Health) shall review all these preparations till 04th week of June.
- On 1st July District Epidemic Response Team (DERT) will be activated by the DHO.
- From 1st July disease reporting shall be done on weekly basis.
- When flood emergency shall be declared, Mode of reporting shall be changed over to daily basis.
- Vaccination of Children EPF focal person
- Dengue control and Surveillance CDCO
- Distribution of Aqua Tab. L.H.W, L.H.S AND SHNS.
- Distribution of Mosquito Nets CDCO.
- Hospitalization of serious cases.
- Establishment of emergency dispensaries for first and medical care to those suffering injuries or illness as a consequence of disaster.
- Organization of mobile medical teams to cover remote areas or points where access is difficult.
- Adoption of preventive and curative measures to prevent occurrence and to stop spread of epidemics & other disease.
- Assistance in maintaining sanitary conditions in the disaster area.

II. WELFARE SERVICES

The ADC (G) shall be the incharge of these Services.

- ❖ Functions
- Co-ordinate with other Disaster Services and with aid giving agencies, including acceptance and distribution of donations in kind.
- To give aid and alleviate the miseries of the persons affected from the catastrophe and to look after the welfare of affected.
- Make an immediate survey of the disaster area and make a list of victims, individuals and families.
- Provide food and other basic necessities to victims on individual or family basis during the emergency period.
- Establish immediate Emergency Mass Feeding.
- Assist in the evacuation of population from danger zones in order to shift them to safer places.
- Establish, administer and supervise Relief Centers in schools, Municipal Buildings, tents, etc as a temporary shelter to homeless victims.
- Record the hospitalized, the dead, the injured and missing persons.
- Attend to Local and International Welfare inquiries about persons in disaster areas.
- Help disaster victims in establishing contacts with relatives and friends outside the affected area.
- Refer cases of victims, individuals and families to appropriate agencies for rehabilitation etc.
- Answer inquiries as to whereabouts of missing persons.
- Assist in location of family members of victims, facilitate reunion of dislocated families.
- Provide useful knowledge and skills to victims to help them in their return to normal living.
- Arrange activities to meet the diverse needs of disaster victims.

III. SECURITY SERVICES

- These services shall be under the direct charge of the City Police Officer, Multan in order to maintain peace and order and protect life and property in the disaster area.
- The Assistant Commissioner and DSP shall assist him in his task at Tehsil level.
- There shall also be a Liaison Officer from the Army included in these Services.

❖ **Functions**

- Establish security post at the temp. Relief camp.
- Maintain peace and order
- Enforce Law & Order.
- Apprehend/Arrest law violators
- Protect evacuated inhabitants and stocks of resources.
- Facilitate disaster operations by controlling the movement of the individuals.
- Handling the bodies of deceased persons.
- Detect and prevent disaster.
- Carry out initial rescue and survey operations
- Assist in saving lives and property
- To establish temporary Police Check Posts at the vulnerable points to stop the cuts / breaches on banks of Canals.
- He will direct traffic and plan alternative road connection.

IV. TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

- The Secretary RTA shall be the Head of these services;

❖ **Functions**

- This cell, in addition to the existing Transport shall also requisition vehicles from other Departments and public sector.
- Ensure adequate supply of POL for all transport in use of all departments especially the emergency response services.
- Manage, direct and control all available transportation facilities and ensures their appropriate and efficient utilization in the disaster area.
- All requests are to be forwarded to the transportation service in the following cases:
 - Evacuation from the area under threat.
 - Transportation of the affected population from the temporary relief camps to the permanent relief camps established in the school buildings.
- Prepare list of persons to be contacted for provision of Transport.
- Constitute Teams to bring transport in line.
- Tehsil wise acquisition & utilization of the transport.

V. AGRICULTURE DEPARTMENT SERVICES

- The Deputy Director (Agriculture) shall be the incharge of these Services.

❖ **Functions**

- Survey of pre and post flood of cultivation land
- They shall help the Irrigation Department in the supply of earth moving machinery for bund protections.
- Supply of seed for sowing of crops.
- Assist farmers on preparation and sowing of crops.
- Provide fertilizers and agricultural implements on loan basis.

VI. LIVE STOCK & DAIRY SERVICES

- The AD (Livestock) shall be the incharge of these services:

❖ **Functions**

- The AD (Live Stock) shall start pre-flood vaccination w.e.f 1st May every year throughout the district that shall continue up-to 15th May every year.
- Vaccination against H.S., Foot & Mouth, Etero Toxemia, pleuropneumonia and N.D.
- The AD (Live Stock) shall issue duty roster to this effect by 31st March every year.
- Rescue live stock in coordination with other departments.
- Establish veterinary camps.
- Arrange all necessary medicine
- Treatment of Animals
- Provision of fodder and Wanda

VII. CIVIL DEFENCE SERVICES

- The Civil Defence Officer shall be the incharge of these Services helped by 400 volunteers.
- ❖ **Functions**
- He shall issue duty roster assigning duties of volunteers in case of flood emergency.
- He shall ensure issuance of flood warning through his volunteers in case of likelihood of flood.
- He shall arrange training of the volunteers with a special focus on warning, rescue and relief activities pertaining to flood emergency in the month of April every year.
- The volunteers shall also be imparted first Aid Training including artificial respiration, treatment of snake biting and emergency method of rescue.
- He shall conduct search and sweeping through Bomb Disposal Squad in case of any suspicion.

VIII. COMMUNICATION SERVICES

- The City Police Officer shall supervise the communication system at the district level.
- ❖ **Functions**
- They shall ensure that all the telephone connections and wireless sets are in working order during emergency period.
- It shall also connect strategic points with the nearest telephone exchange or through wireless connection.
- Director Telephones Multan shall ensure that the telephone numbers of important departments are always in working condition especially those given in attached List.

IX. ENGINEERING (MECHANICAL) SERVICES

The Assistant Agriculture Engineer shall be incharge of these services:

- ❖ **Functions**
- Provide machines and material for repair of bulldozers and tractors working on bunds.
- Establish workshop near the vulnerable points.
- The bulldozers of Agriculture Department shall be utilized for the strengthening of canal banks and to improve the flow of water through siphons.

X. FOOD SERVICES

- The District Food Controller shall be Incharge of these Services.
- He shall be assisted by his Assistant Food Controllers.
- ❖ **Functions**
- He shall ensure that adequate stock of Aata is available in the district.
- He shall prepare a plan for special ration depots at the strategic places.
- He shall organize mobile depots.

VIII. FOREST DEPARTMENT

The Divisional Forest Officer shall be the incharge of these services.

- ❖ **Functions**
- Shall provide "ABKALANI" material and assist the patrolling of bunds. He shall provide places for flood affected cattle-heads.

X. INFORMATION SERVICES

The District Information Officer shall be the incharge of these services.

- ❖ **Functions**
- He shall ensure that news media and the public receive correct information and warning messages.
- He shall plan and arrange the visits of newsmen to the flood affected areas in district Multan.

XI. IRRIGATION & POWER SERVICES

This department consists of the following members:

- The Chief Engineer, Irrigation
- The XEN, Shujabad Canal
- The XEN, Multan Canal

- ❖ **Functions**
- The department shall supervise, direct and control bund protection activities,
- Desilting of all syphons and inlets of Head Muhammad Wala & Sher Shah Bridges
- It shall also control various canals in the district.

XII. WAPDA-POWER SUPPLY SERVICES

The Superintending Engineer, MEPCO Multan shall be the incharge of these services, assisted by his XENs in the districts.

❖ **Functions**

- He shall make lighting arrangements on the bunds for night patrol and protection activities.
- He shall also ensure orderly and regular power supply throughout the district in disaster emergency.
- He shall also establish emergency control room with telephone and mobile staff and shall work round the clock.

XIII. WATER & SANITATION AUTHORITY (WASA)

The Managing Director will be the incharge of these services within its respective jurisdiction.

❖ **Functions**

- Establish emergency flood center of their organization with staff working round the clock.
- They shall keep the dewatering set-in working condition.
- Drain stagnant water from low lying areas.
- Keeping all disposal station at working condition.
- They shall further desilt the sewerage and open drains to help the drainage of flood and rain water from the affected area.
- They shall keep in hand adequate stores of spare parts, etc. for repair of necessary machinery and equipment.

XIII. METROPOLITAN CORPORATION SERVICES

Chief Officer will be the incharge of these services within its respective area.

❖ **Functions**

- Establish emergency flood center of their organization with staff working round the clock.
- They shall keep the dewatering set-in working condition.
- Drain stagnant water from low lying areas.
- Provide food and other basic necessities.
- They shall conduct survey of dangerous buildings.
- They shall further desilt the sewerage and open drains to help the drainage of flood and rain water from the affected area.
- The District Officer (I&S) shall provide potable water in affected areas and in relief camps.
- The District Officer (I&S) shall keep in hand adequate stores of spare parts, etc. for repair of necessary machinery and equipment.
- He shall also ensure that adequate supplies are available for chlorination of drinking water.

XIV. TEHSIL COUNCIL SERVICES

Chief Officer will be the incharge of these services within tehsil.

❖ **Functions**

- Establish emergency flood center of their organization with staff working round the clock.
- They shall keep the dewatering set-in working condition.
- Drain stagnant water from low lying areas.
- Provide food and other basic necessities.
- They shall conduct survey of dangerous buildings.
- They shall further desilt the sewerage and open drains to help the drainage of flood and rain water from the affected area.
- The Municipal Officer (I&S) shall provide potable water in affected areas and in relief camps.
- The Municipal Officer (I&S) shall keep in hand adequate stores of spare parts, etc. for repair of necessary machinery and equipment.
- He shall also ensure that adequate supplies are available for chlorination of drinking water.

XV. MUNICIPAL COMMITTEE'S SERVICES

Chief Officers shall be the incharge of these services within their respective tehsils.

❖ **Functions**

- Establish emergency flood center of their organization with staff working round the clock.
- They shall keep the dewatering set-in working condition.
- Drain stagnant water from low lying areas.
- Provide food and other basic necessities.

- They shall conduct survey of dangerous buildings.
- They shall further desilt the sewerage and open drains to help the drainage of flood and rain water from the affected area.
- The Municipal Officer (I&S) shall provide potable water in affected areas and in relief camps.
- The Municipal Officer (I&S) shall keep in hand adequate stores of spare parts, etc. for repair of necessary machinery and equipment.
- He shall also ensure that adequate supplies are available for chlorination of drinking water.

XVI. ARMY SERVICES

The ADC (G) shall be the Liaison Offices of Civil Administration for liaison with the Army. The 104 Brigade shall nominate Liaison Officer for liaison with the Civil Administration. If help of the Army is required, they shall assist in rescue and evacuation operations, as also provide transport and communication facilities and assist the Irrigation authorities in bund protection.

XVII. XEN HIGHWAYS

He will depute staff at important bridges and roads for maintenance.

He will arrange machinery for repair of breaches in roads for provision of relief and during evacuation,

He will arrange desilting in culverts and water ways on provincial and district roads

XVIII. DISTRICT NAZIR

District Nazir to keep account of expenditure of field operations during emergency and to cater to funds authorised by DDMA.

ANNEX XII: CAMP MANAGEMENT SOPS

- Camps would be established in areas accessible by metalled roads so that provision of essential facilities is not difficult
- Basic facilities such as food, clean drinking water, health, hygiene and sanitation should be available at these shelters.
- Proper registration mechanism should be in place to differentiate between those actually affected and cunning opportunists
- Proper security system should be in place in coordination with the local police as the presence of police always acts as deterrence for criminals who may be attracted to such places.
- Emergency medical care should be available as well as a proper firefighting system as fire out breaks are common in such tents
- Proper camp management should be announced and notified and there should be a complaint cell as well
- A proper distribution mechanism should be in place to ensure that the needy get what they deserve.
- Scattered camps should be catered for and encouraged to join the main camp.
- At times shallow hand pumps are not safe for drinking as the water underground has been affected. In such cases clean medicated water should be provided through water bowsers.
- Vector control is an essential part of the camp management and steps should be taken to remove rats, snakes and mosquitoes etc.
- Un-accompanied and missing children shall be placed separately with proper care and fulfilment of their physical and psycho-social needs.
- Needs of women as per local and cultural environment shall be considered for establishing separate relief camps for ladies with provision of proper security and light arrangements.

ANNEX XV: LIST OF BASIC TERMS

Acceptable risk

The level of loss a society or community considers it can live with and for which it does not need to invest in mitigation

Biological hazard

Biological vectors, micro-organisms, toxins and bioactive substances, which may cause the loss of life or injury, property damage, social and economic disruption or environmental degradation.

Capacity

A combination of all the strengths and resources available within a community, society or organization that can reduce the level of risk, or the effects of a disaster.

Capacity may include physical, institutional, social or economic means as well as skilled personnel or collective attributes such as leadership and management. Capacity may also be described as capability.

Capacity building

Efforts aimed to develop human skills or societal infrastructure within a community or organization needed to reduce the level of risk. In extended understanding, capacity building also includes development of institutional, financial, political and other resources, at different levels of the society.

Climate change

The climate of a place or region is changed if over an extended period (typically decades or longer) there is a statistically significant change in measurements of either the mean temperature or variability of the climate for that region.

Coping capacity

The means by which people or organizations use available resources and abilities to face a disaster. In general, this involves managing resources, both in normal times as well as during crises or adverse conditions.

Disaster

A serious disruption of the functioning of a community or society causing widespread human, material, economic or environmental losses which exceed the ability of the affected community or society to cope using its own resources. It results from the combination of hazards, conditions of vulnerability and insufficient capacity to reduce the potential negative consequences of risk.

Disaster risk management (DRM)

The comprehensive approach to reduce the adverse impacts of a disaster. DRM encompasses all actions taken before, during, and after the disasters. It includes activities on mitigation, preparedness, emergency response, recovery, rehabilitation, and reconstruction.

Disaster risk reduction/disaster reduction

The measures aimed to minimize vulnerabilities and disaster risks throughout a society, to avoid (prevention) or to limit (mitigation and preparedness) the adverse impacts of hazards, within the broad context of sustainable development.

Early warning

The provision of timely and effective information, through identified institutions, to communities and individuals so that they could take action to reduce their risks and prepare for effective response.

Emergency management

The management and deployment of resources for dealing with all aspects of emergencies, in particularly preparedness, response and rehabilitation

Forecast

Estimate of the occurrence of a future event (UNESCO, WMO). This term is used with different meanings in different disciplines.

Geological hazard

Natural earth processes that may cause the loss of life or injury, property damage, social and economic disruption or environmental degradation. For example, earthquakes, tsunamis, volcanic activity and emissions, landslides, rockslides, rock falls or avalanches, surface collapses, expansive soils and debris or mud flows.
