**WEATHER OUTLOOK**

**WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24 HOURS:**

Scattered fairly widespread thunderstorm/ rain of moderate intensity with isolated heavy falls is expected over the upper catchments of Rivers Indus and Jhelum along with Rawalpindi, Multan, Bahawalpur and DG Khan Divisions. Isolated thunderstorm/ rain of moderate intensity is expected over the upper catchments of Rivers Chenab, Ravi and Sutlej along with rest of the Punjab.

**WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR Further 24-HOURS:**

**(ALERT):** Fairly-widespread thunderstorm/ rain of Moderate to heavy intensity with isolated very heavy falls is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with Rawalpindi, Multan, Bahawalpur and D.G.Khan Divisions. Scattered thunderstorm/ rain of moderate intensity with isolated heavy falls is expected over Gujranwala, Sargodha, Lahore, Faisalabad and Sahiwal Divisions.
