

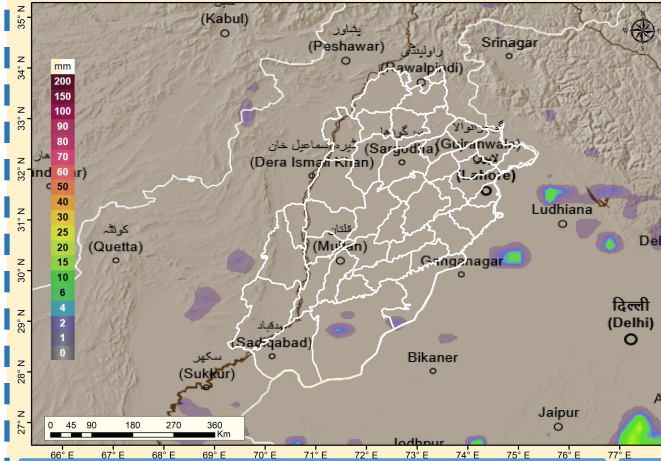

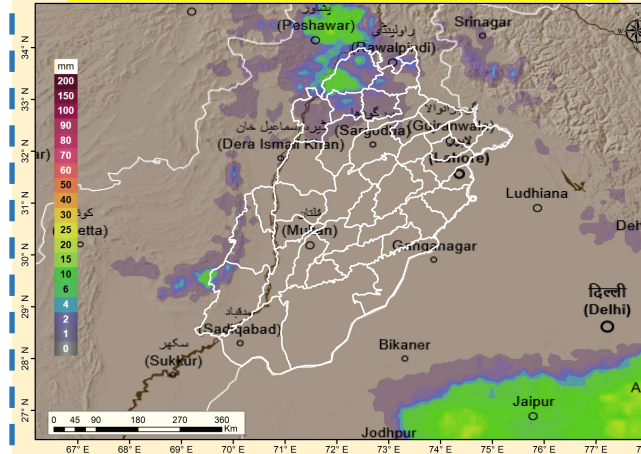
WEEKLY RAINFALL OUTLOOK (1st Octoberto 7th October)

RETREAT OF MONSOON 2025 FROM PAKISTAN

According to Met office, **monsoon 2025 has been retrieved from most parts of the country.** No significant weather is expected in most parts of the country in coming days. **Hot and dry weather is expected in flood affected areas of Punjab** and Sindh during the next week. The night time temperature in upper parts of the country are likely to remain moderately be comfortable during the next week, while hot weather is expected in most plain areas of the country during day time.

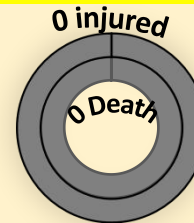
