CM SITUATION REPORT



WEATHER ADVISORY

Met office has informed that moist currents are penetrating in northeastern parts of the country and a westerly wave is also likely to approach upper parts on **3rd June**. Under the influence of this weather system:

- **Dust storm/Rain-thunder (isolated heavy falls/hailstorm)** are expected in Murree from **2nd (evening/night) to 5th June with occasional gaps**.
- **Dust storm/Rain-thunder (isolated heavy falls/hailstorm)** are also expected in Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mianwali, Sargodha, Hafizabad, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujranwala, Gujrat, Sialkot, Narowal, Lahore, Faisalabad, Jhang and TT Singh on **3rd (evening/night) and 4th June with occasional gaps**.
- **Dust storm** is also expected in southern Punjab **during the period**.

POSSIBLE IMPACTS AND ADVICE

- **Wind/dust-thunderstorm/hailstorm and lightning** may damage loose structures like electric poles, trees, vehicles and solar panels etc.
- **Farmers** are advised to **manage their crop activities** keeping in view the weather conditions.
- **General Public** is advised to take **precautionary measures** during the weather activity.

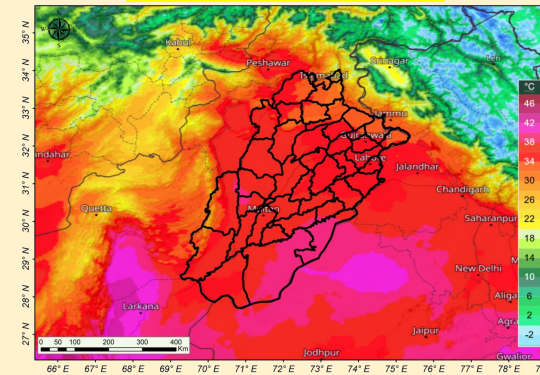
PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES & GUIDELINES FOR DISTRICT ADMINISTRATIONS

- Ensure **sufficient staffing round-the-clock in DEOCs** for effective coordination and response.
- Collect and **share the latest information with PDMA**, line departments, and national authorities.
- Generate **Situation Reports (SITREP)** to cover any major incidents/developments to share with PDMA promptly.
- **Rescue 1122 (Disaster Response Force)** to remain **high alert** and have sufficient emergency response personnel and equipment during the forecasted period.
- Establish a **streamlined and efficient communication system** through phone calls, SMS and announcements to ensure **timely dissemination of weather forecasts, advisories, and alerts** to local community through Patwaris, **Lumberdars**, Noteables and general announcement in Mosques.
- **Share daily / routine updates with PDMA Punjab** in case of any eventuality.

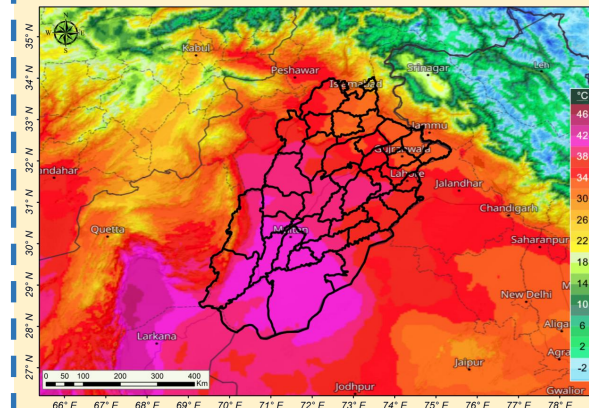

MONDAY (NIGHT)

- Mainly **dry weather** is expected in most districts of the province, while hot in plain areas.
- However, **partly cloudy weather with rain-wind/thunderstorm is likely** in Murree, Galiyat and surroundings.
- **Partly cloudy weather with dust rising winds** is expected in Gujranwala, Sargodha, Faisalabad, Sialkot, Sheikhpura, Potohar region and surrounding areas.

TUESDAY

- Mainly **Hot and dry weather** is expected in most districts of the province, while very hot in plain areas.
- However, **partly cloudy weather with rain-wind/thunderstorm is likely** in Murree, Galiyat, Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Sialkot, Narowal, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Mandi Bahauddin and Lahore.
- **Wind/duststorm** is also expected in Sargodha, Faisalabad, Bahawalnagar, Multan, Sahiwal, Pakpattan, Khanewal, DG Khan and surrounding areas.
