SUBJECT: DUST-THUNDERSTORM/RAIN PREDICTED IN UPPER PARTS WITH OCCASIONAL GAPS FROM 10TH (EVENING) TO 12TH MAY

Met office (**vide Letter No. NWFC-5(10A)/2017/167**) has informed that fresh westerly wave is likely to approach northwestern parts of the country on **10th May** and likely to persist in upper parts till **12th May (night)**. Under the influence of this weather system:

- **Dust-thunderstorm/rain** is expected in **Murree, Galiyat, Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Khushab, Joharabad, Sargodha, Mianwali, Faisalabad, Sahiwal, Jhang, Lahore, Sheikhupura, Okara, Gujranwala, Sialkot, Narowal** from **10th (evening) to 12th May with** occasional gaps.
- **Dust-thunderstorm and rain** are likely to bring relief from hot weather in upper parts while **very hot weather condition** is expected to continue in **southern parts of Punjab**

2. Possible Impacts:

- **Windstorm and lightning may damage weak structures (electric poles, bill boards, solar panels etc.) during the forecast period.**
- **Farmers are advised to manage their crops in accordance with the duststorm and rain, especially during wheat harvesting.**
- **Tourists and travelers are advised to remain cautious and avoid unnecessary travelling during the forecast period.**

3. In order to maintain high level of preparedness and mitigation of the disaster all the District administrations and line departments are requested to ensure the following measures:

- i. Ensure **sufficient staffing round-the-clock in DEOCs** for effective coordination and response.
- ii. **Coordinate** with PDMA and all relevant departments to ensure **a unified prompt response.**
- iii. Ensure accurate and timely dissemination of **information on safety measures and evacuation plans** through **electronic and social media.**
- iv. Motorway Police shall ensure regular traffic advisories, timely updates on road conditions, and guidance to travelers for safe travel.
- v. Deploy **additional staff** and resources to high-risk areas.

- vi. Stay **alert Rescue 1122** and ensure pre-position search and rescue teams (DRF) along with necessary equipment
 - vii. Generate **Situation Reports (SITREPS)** to cover any major incidents/developments on regular basis.
 - viii. Ensure **data collection and reporting** for post-flood analysis and improvements.
4. Keeping in view the possibility of hailstorm, following are the safety tips for general public:
- a. Seek Immediate Shelter. Move indoors or take refuge in a strong building or a covered vehicle as soon as hail begins.
 - b. Stay Away from Windows. Hailstones can break window glass; remain in a secure room away from windows and glass doors.
 - c. Protect Your Head and Neck. If you are outdoors, use a bag, jacket, helmet, or any available object to shield yourself from injury.
 - d. Park Safely While Driving. Pull over at a safe location such as under a bridge or covered area and remain inside the vehicle with your seatbelt fastened.
 - e. Avoid Driving During Intense Hail. Heavy hail can severely reduce visibility and make roads slippery and dangerous.
 - f. Stay Updated on Weather Conditions. Regularly monitor weather advisories through radio, television, mobile alerts, or reliable weather applications.
 - g. Secure Vehicles and Outdoor Assets. If time permits, cover vehicles, livestock, and outdoor equipment with tarpaulins, blankets, or other protective materials.

Dust-thunderstorm/rain predicted in upper parts with occasional gaps from 10th (evening) to 12th May

Met office predicted that a fresh westerly wave is likely to approach northwestern parts of the country on 10th May and likely to persist in upper parts till 12th May (night). Under the influence of this weather system:

- **Dust-thunderstorm/rain** is expected in **Kyber Pakhtunkhwa** (Chitral, Dir, Swat, Kalam, Shangla, Buner, Kohistan, Malakand, Battagram, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Balakot, Haripur, Swabi, Mardan, Nowshera, Charsadda, Peshawar, Bajaur, Mohmand, Orakzai, Khyber, Kohat, Kurram, Hangu, Karak), **Punjab/Islamabad** (Murree, Galiyat, Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Khushab, Joharabad, Sargodha, Mianwali, Faisalabad, Sahiwal, Jhang, Lahore, Sheikhpura, Okara, Gujranwala, Sialkot, Narowal) from **10th (evening) to 12th May** with occasional gaps. While rain-wind/thunderstorm is expected in **Gilgit Baltistan** (Diamir, Astore, Ghizer, Skardu, Hunza, Gilgit, Guaniche, Shigar), **Kashmir** (Neelum valley, Muzaffarabad, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Haveli, Sudhanoti, Kotli, Bhimber, Mirpur) from **11th to 13th May** with occasional gaps.
- Dust-thunderstorm and rain are likely to bring relief from hot weather in upper parts while very hot weather condition is expected to continue in southern parts (south Punjab, Sindh, and parts of Baluchistan).

Possible Impacts and advises:

- **Windstorm and lightning may damage weak structures (electric poles, bill boards, solar panels etc.) during the forecast period.**
- **Farmers are advised to manage their crops in accordance with the duststorm and rain, especially during wheat harvesting.**
- **Landslides may occur in vulnerable areas of upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir during the forecast period.**
- **Tourists and travelers are advised to remain cautious and avoid unnecessary travelling during the forecast period.**

Note: All concerned authorities are advised to remain “Vigilant” and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward situation during the forecast period.

پریس ریلیز

10 (شام) سے 12 مئی کے دوران ملک کے بالائی علاقوں میں وقفے وقفے سے آندھی اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کی پیشگوئی

محکمہ موسمیات کی پیشگوئی کے مطابق ایک مغربی ہواؤں کا سلسلہ 10 مئی کو ملک کے شمال مغربی علاقوں میں داخل ہونے کا امکان ہے اور یہ 12 مئی (رات) تک بالائی علاقوں میں برقرار رہنے کی توقع ہے۔ اس موسمی نظام کے زیر اثر:

- 10 (شام) سے 12 مئی کے دوران خیبر پختونخواہ: (پتڑال، دیر، سوات، کالام، شانگلہ، بونیر، کوہستان، ملاکنڈ، بنگرام، مانسہرہ، ایبٹ آباد، بالا کوٹ، ہری پور، صوابی، مردان، نوشہرہ، چارسدہ، پشاور، ہاجوڑ، مہمند، اورکزئی، خیبر، کوہاٹ، کرم، ہنگو اور کرک)، پنجاب/اسلام آباد: (مری، گلیات، اسلام آباد/راولپنڈی، انک، چکوال، جہلم، خوشاب، جوہر آباد، سرگودھا، میانوالی، فیصل آباد، ساہیوال، جھنگ، لاہور، شیخوپورہ، اوکاڑہ، گوجرانوالہ، سیالکوٹ اور نارووال) میں وقفے وقفے سے تیز ہواؤں/آندھی اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان ہے۔ جبکہ 11 سے 13 مئی کے دوران گلگت بلتستان: (دیامر، استور، غدر، اسکردو، ہنزہ، گلگت، گانچھے اور شگر)، کشمیر: (وادی نیلم، مظفر آباد، پونچھ، ہٹیاں، باغ، حویلی، سدھوتی، کوٹلی، بھمبر اور میرپور) میں وقفے وقفے سے تیز ہواؤں/آندھی اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان ہے۔

- بالائی علاقوں میں آندھی/تیز ہواؤں اور بارش سے گرم موسم کی شدت میں کمی کی توقع ہے۔ جبکہ جنوبی علاقوں (جنوبی پنجاب، سندھ اور بلوچستان کے بعض علاقوں) میں موسم شدید گرم رہنے کا امکان۔

مکمل اثرات اور احتیاطی تدابیر:

- اس دوران تیز ہواؤں اور آسمانی بجلی کرنے کے باعث کمزور ڈھانچوں (بجلی کے سبب، بل بورڈز، سولر پینلز وغیرہ) کو نقصان پہنچنے کا خطرہ ہے۔
- کاشتکار حضرات کو ہدایت کی جاتی ہے کہ وہ گرد آلود ہواؤں/آندھی اور بارش کے پیش نظر بالخصوص گندم کی کٹائی کے دوران اپنی فصلوں کی دیکھ بھال موسمی حالات کے مطابق کریں۔
- پیشگوئی کے دوران بالائی خیبر پختونخوا، گلگت بلتستان اور کشمیر کے پہاڑی علاقوں میں لینڈ سلائیڈنگ کا خطرہ۔
- اس دوران سیاحوں اور مسافروں کو محتاط رہنے اور غیر ضروری سفر سے اجتناب کی ہدایت۔
