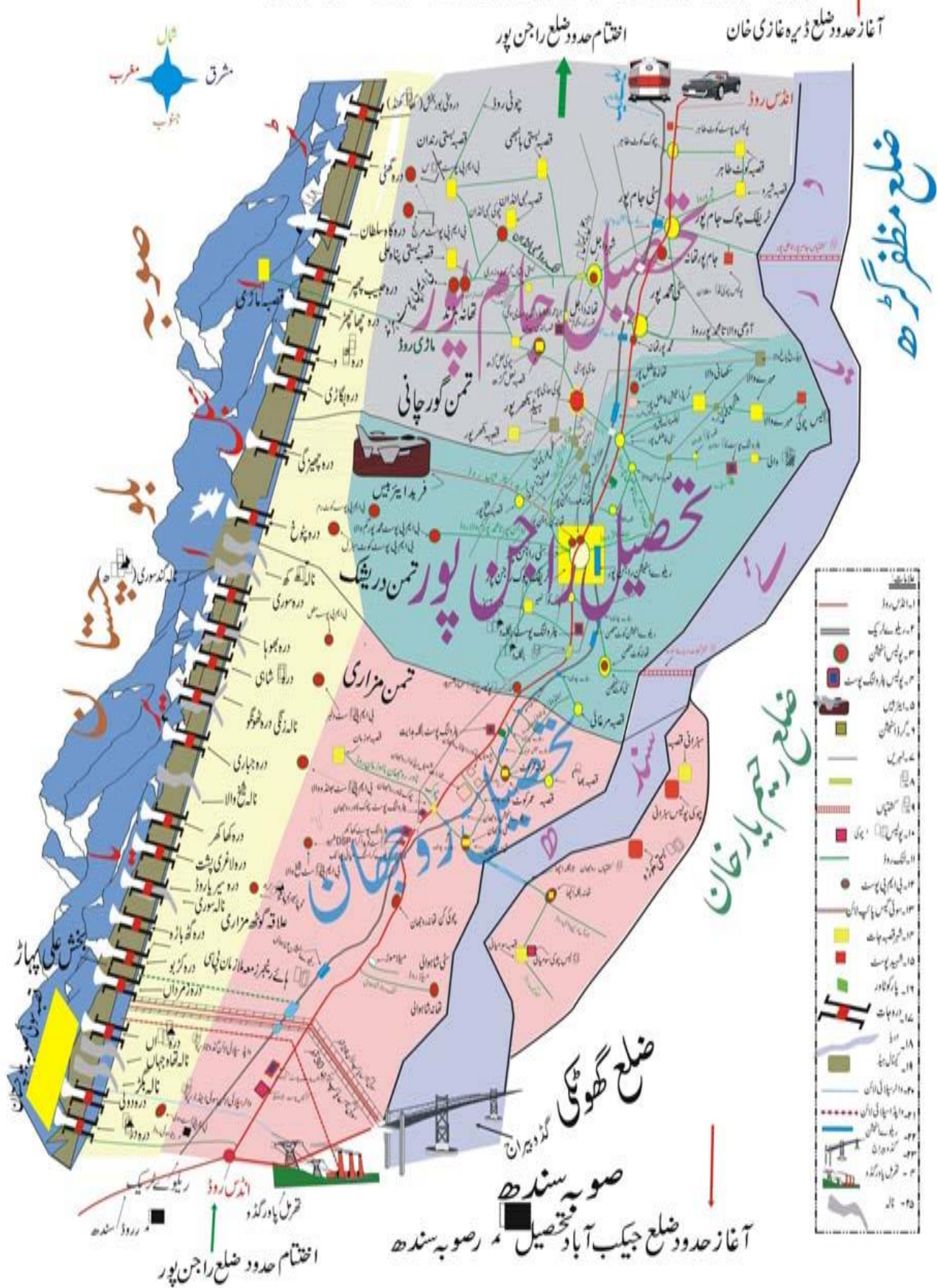

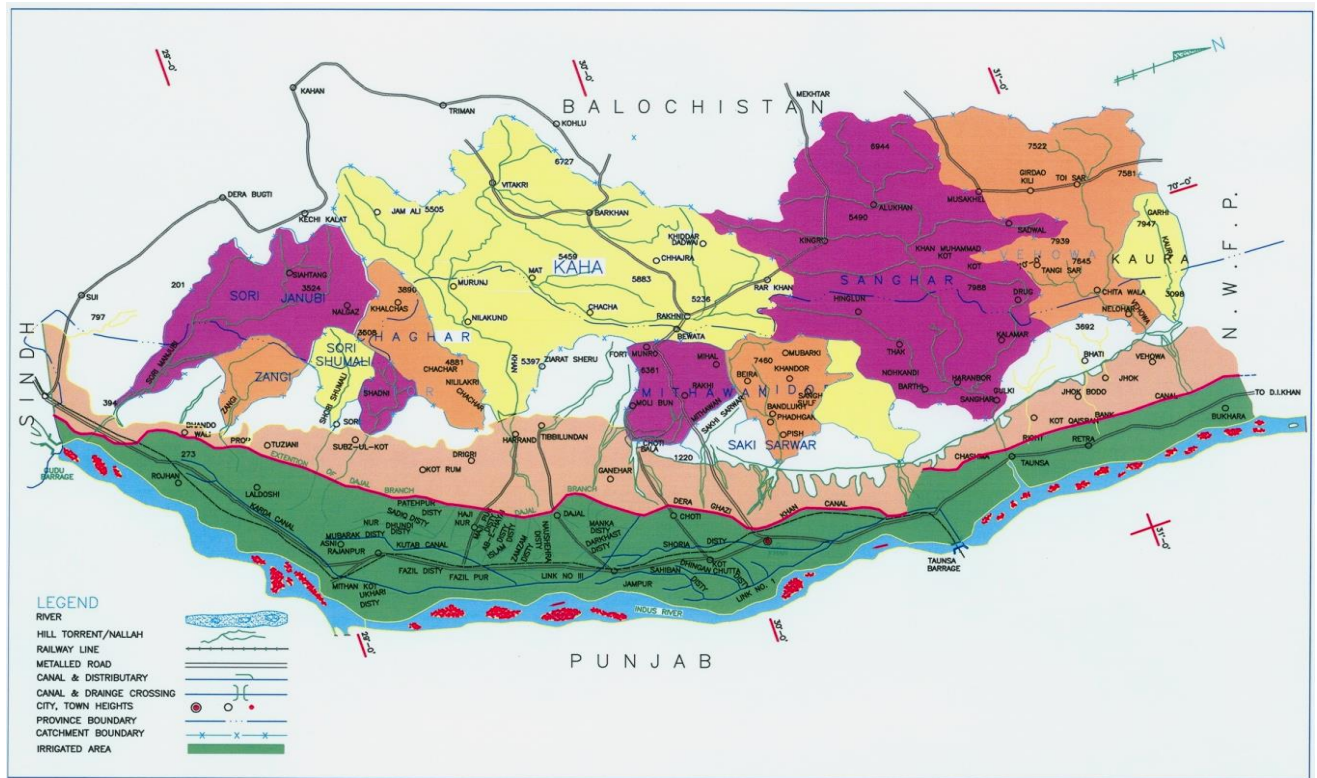
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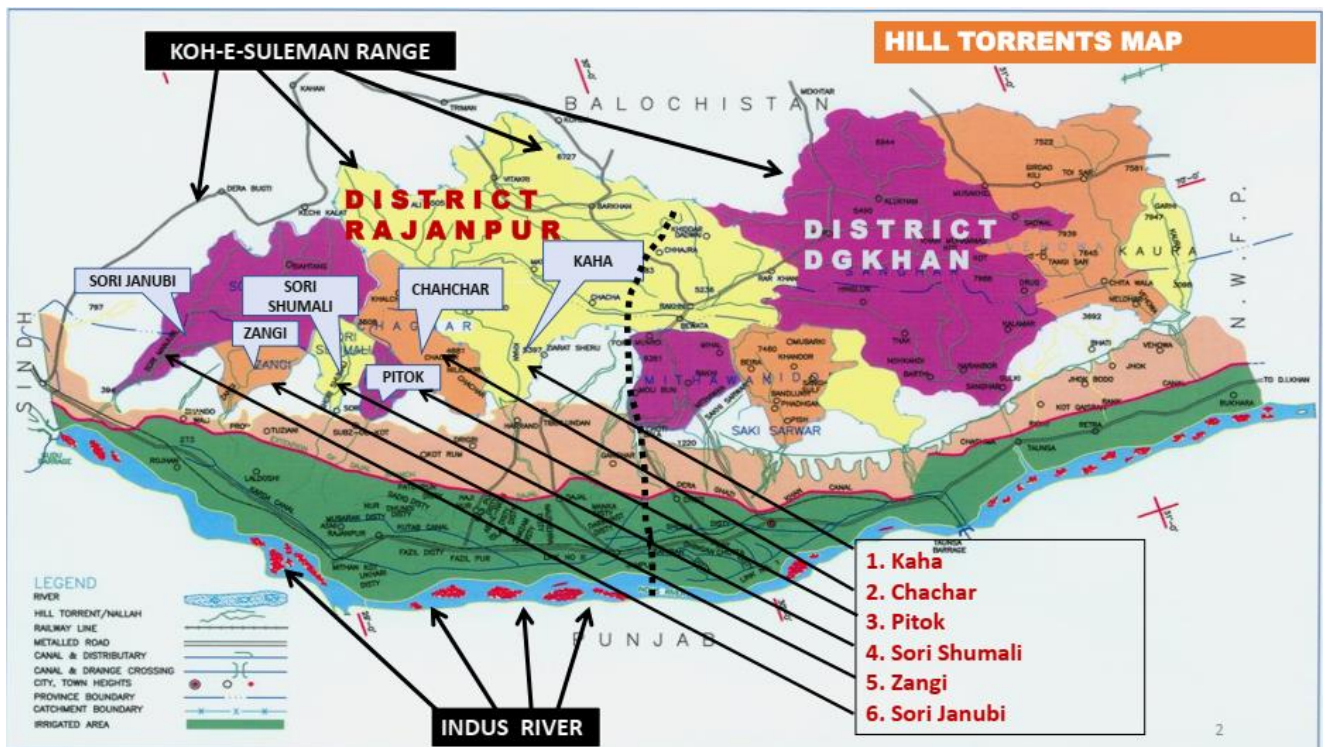
MAP OF DISTRICT RAJANPUR



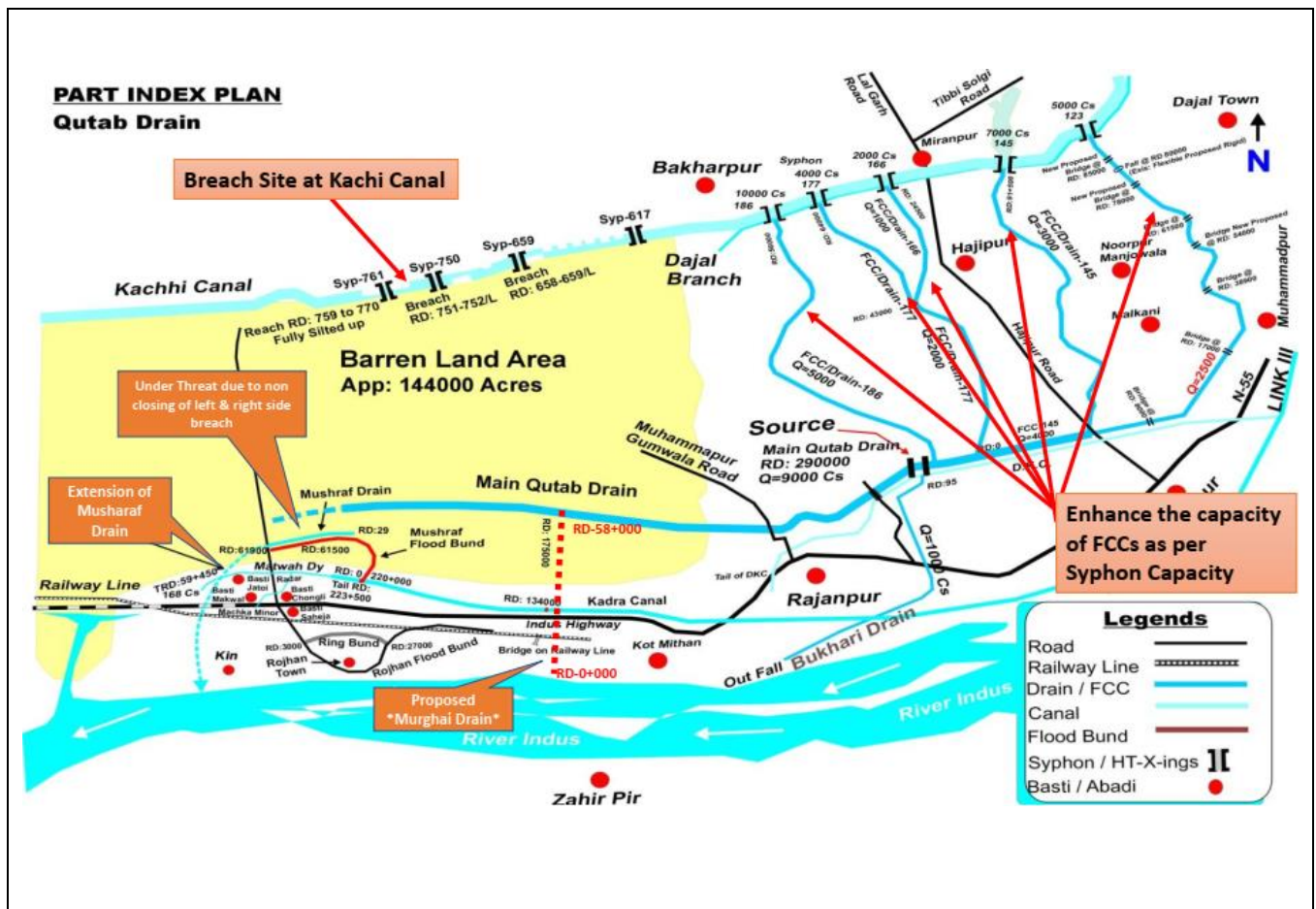
Riverine Map



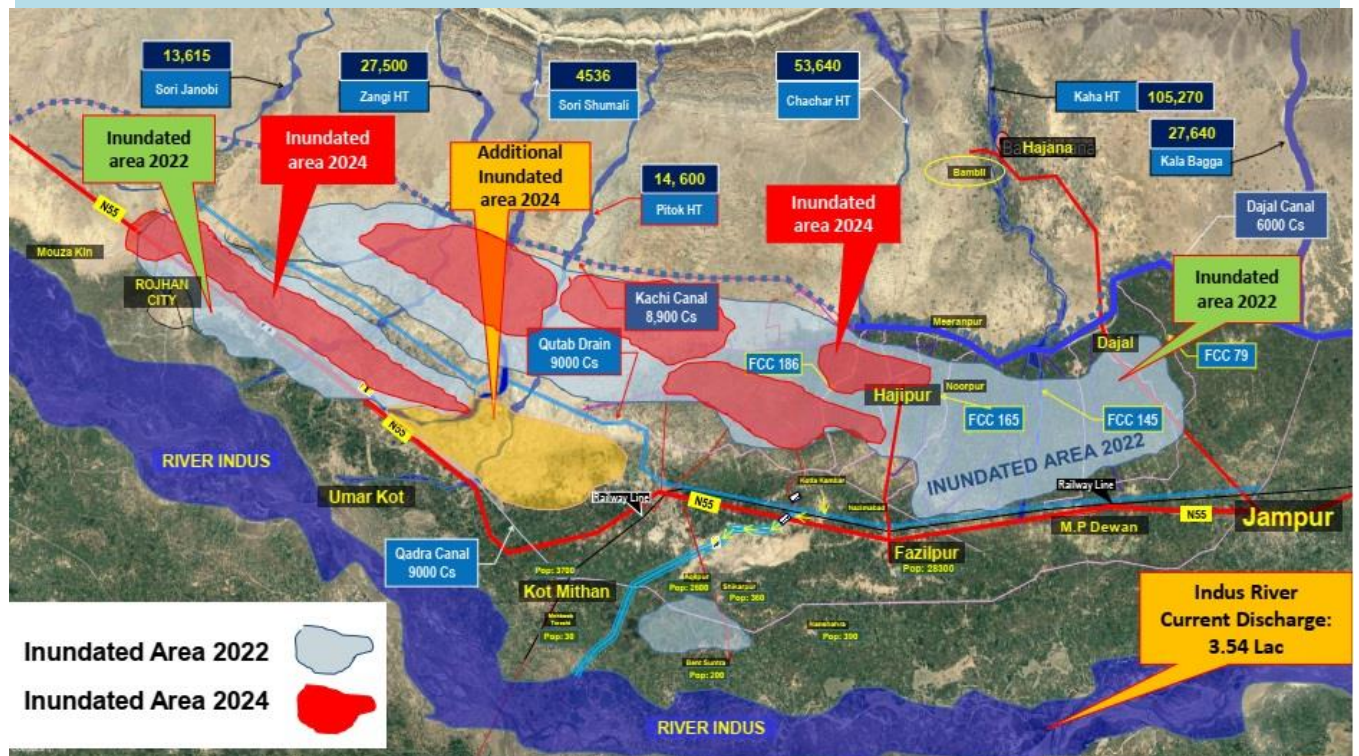
Hill Torrent

FLOOD HISTORY

District Rajanpur is vulnerable to two types of floods i.e Hill Torrents from western side & Riverine Flood from Eastern side of the district.

Hill Torrents:

The Hill Torrents originate from catchment area of Suleman Mountains ranges with maximum capacity of one Lac cusecs & enter through various darras i.e **KAHA, CHACHAR, SORI** etc and pose threat to major towns. i.e Dajal, Hajipur, Son Wah, Lalgarrh, Chak Shaheed, Chak Patiat, Asni & Shah Wali in all tehsils of District Rajanpur. This rain water enters the settled areas and causes huge damages to crops, land, canal irrigation system and local population.

Riverine Flood:

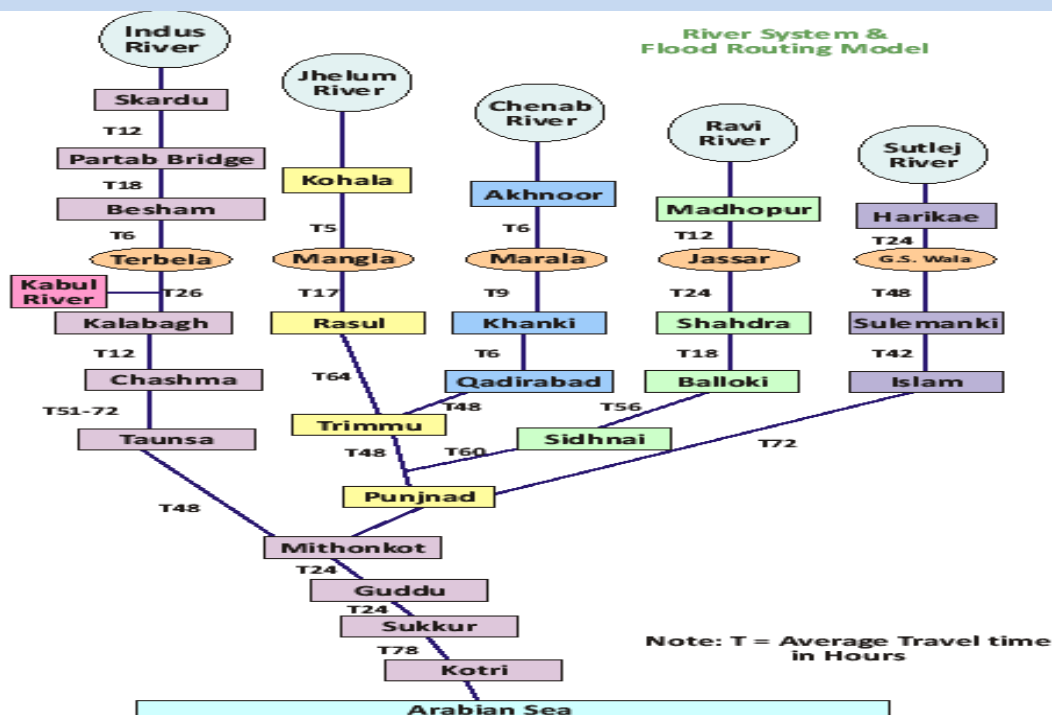
During Monsoon season, the discharge in Indus River increases and excessive flood water results in inundation. It causes huge loss to the crops, livestock and local population in the adjoining area of River Indus. Major towns exposed to the River Indus is Kotla Mughlan, Bait Sountra, Mehraywala, kotla Androon, Noshehra, Kot Mithan, Umer kot and Rojhan in all tehsils of District Rajanpur.

Qadra Canal, Dajal Branch & Kachhi Canal is affected by both types of floods.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO ALL CONCERNED:-

1. All damage equipments should be repaired before rainy and monsoon season.
2. Leave during flood season may not be granted to deputed staff.
3. Relief camps sites should be earmarked in advance by Assistant Commissioners.
4. Arrangements of food and medicines should be made for flood affected persons well before the monsoon season.
5. Responsible teams of agriculture and livestock departments may be constituted for vaccinations of cattle in case of flood.
6. joint survey of protection bunds of river and canals also be carried out by Revenue and Irrigations Department

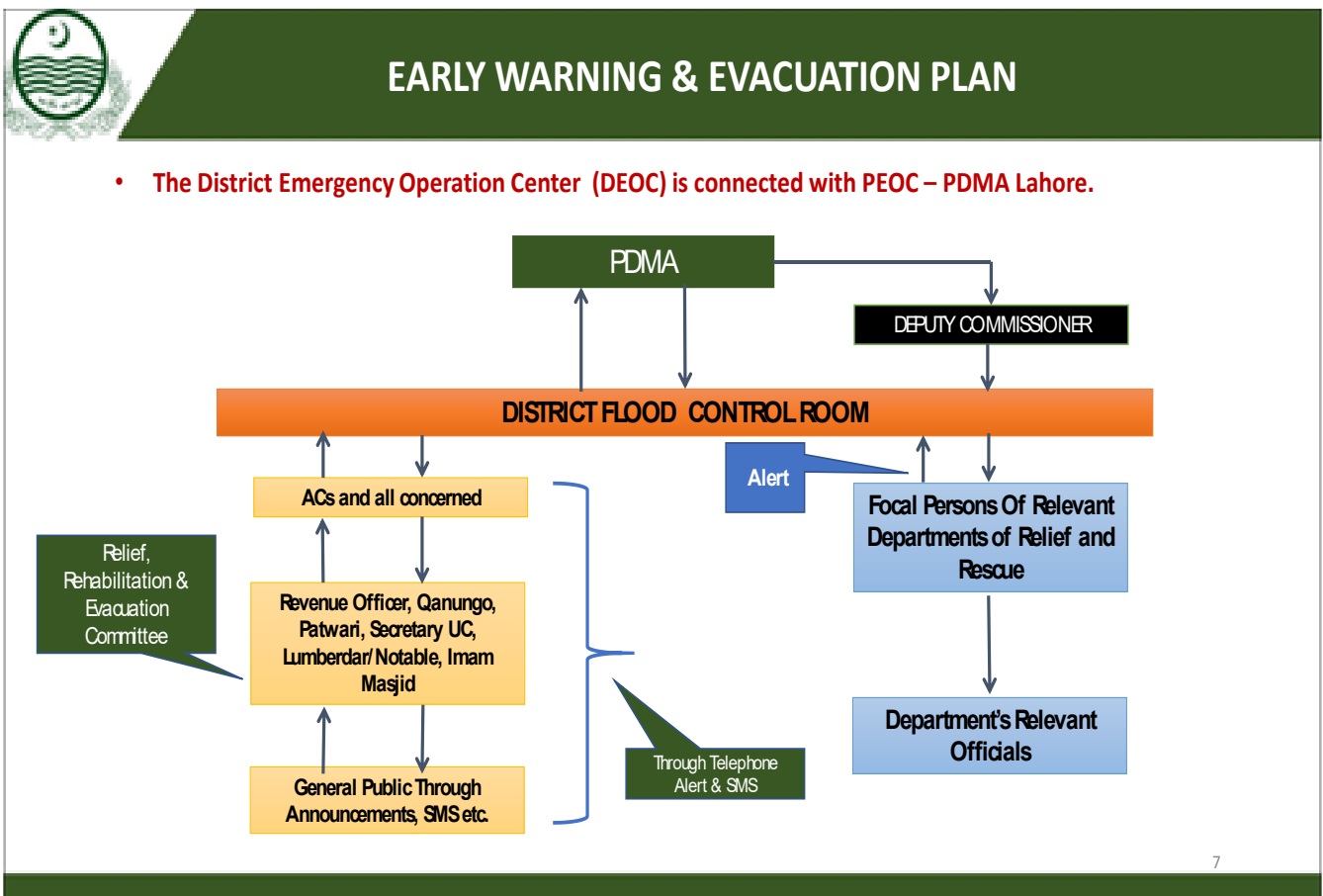

He will ensure that sufficient stock of POL is reserved at each petrol pump during flood season and this reserve stock will not be sold out to any private vehicle without permission of Assistant Commissioners concerned.

Emergency & Disaster:

- An emergency and a disaster are two different situations:
- ***An Emergency is a Situation in which the Community is Capable of Coping with it.***
It is a situation generated by the real or imminent occurrence of an event that requires immediate attention and use of resources at one's disposal.
- ***A Disaster is a Situation in which the Community is Incapable of Coping with it.*** It is a natural or human-caused event which creates intense negative impacts on people, goods, services and/or the environment, exceeding the affected community's

capability to respond; therefore the community seeks the assistance of government and international agencies.

DISASTER ASSISTANCE AND RESPONSE TEAM (DART)

The main departments who perform duties during the flood are Irrigation, Revenue, Police, Health, Livestock, Rescue 1122, Agriculture and Civil Defence. These departments will perform their duties according to the nature of their job in flood area. However elite teams are constituted which consist of officers/officials of Revenue and other line departments for efficient performance during disaster. This team is named as “**Disaster Assistance and Response Team.**” Expected flood area has been divided into sectors and the **DART** of each sector will be responsible for all kind of Pre, Mid and Post Flood activities. Detail of **DART** is as under:

Flood area of district will be divided into 03 sectors & 15 sub-sectors for easy control & monitoring of flood situation. Assistant Commissioners of concerned Tehsil will be overall Incharge of all sectors.

PROVISION OF SERVICES AT RELIEF CAMPS

1. Cooked Food:

Cooked food will be provided for flood affectees by the Government through Revenue staff, Social Welfare Department, NGOs and philanthropist may also contribute. Sweet water will also be made available to flood affectees through water tankers by Municipal Committees/Union Councils.

2. Provision of Wheat Flour:

The District Food Controller will be responsible to keep & reserve sufficient stock of wheat at Jampur, Fazilpur, Rajanpur & Rojhan grain store to cater for the requirement of affected people with the approval of Government.

Flour mills earmarked for the purpose by DFC.

- a. Mubarak Flour Mill, Indus Highway Road, Rajanpur.
- b. Dreshak Flour Mill, Kotla Naseer, Rajanpur
- c. Jampur Flour Mill, Dajal Road, Jampur.

3. Medical Aid:

The Chief Executive Officer (District Health Authority), Rajanpur will establish temporary medical centers/ first aid centers at relief camps. He will deploy his staff and ensure medical supplies to the flood affected people. If necessary, the Chief Executive Officer (DHA) would establish temporary dispensaries duly equipped with sufficient stock of medicine. The Chief Executive Officer (DHA) would also be responsible for taking preventive measures against epidemics. The following medicines will be ensured to be provided at relief camps.

- Anti Snake Venom
- Anti Rabbits Vaccine
- Anti Malarial Medicines
- Anti Biotic Medicines
- Pain Killers
- Medicine For Skin Diseases
- Water Purification Tablets
- ORS
- All Type of Drips
- Other Medicines on Requirement

4. Fodder For Cattle:

The Additional Director (Livestock) would make necessary arrangements for stock of Bhoosa and other dry fodder for the cattle evacuated from the flood affected areas in collaboration with the Deputy Director, Agriculture, and Divisional Forest Officer Rajanpur.

Veterinary Medicine:

Additional Director (Livestock) will arrange sufficient veterinary medicines for cattle diseases at the camps for treatment of livestock of flood affected areas.

5. Vaccination

Vaccination facility will be provided to the livestock farmers in the flood affected areas.

ESTABLISHMENT OF WAREHOUSE

The Circle Incharge Cooperative Department shall depute necessary staff round the clock for maintaining proper record of all goods.

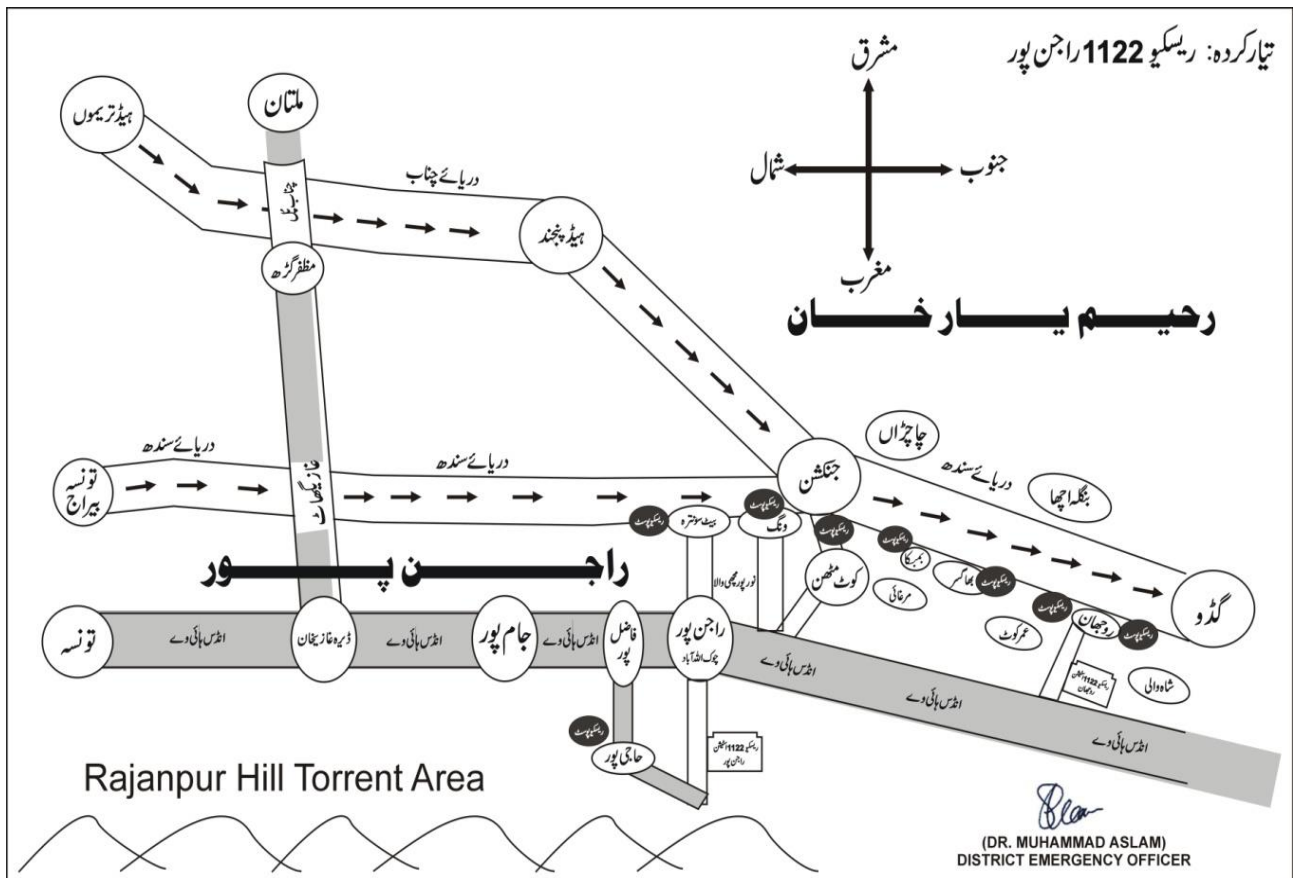
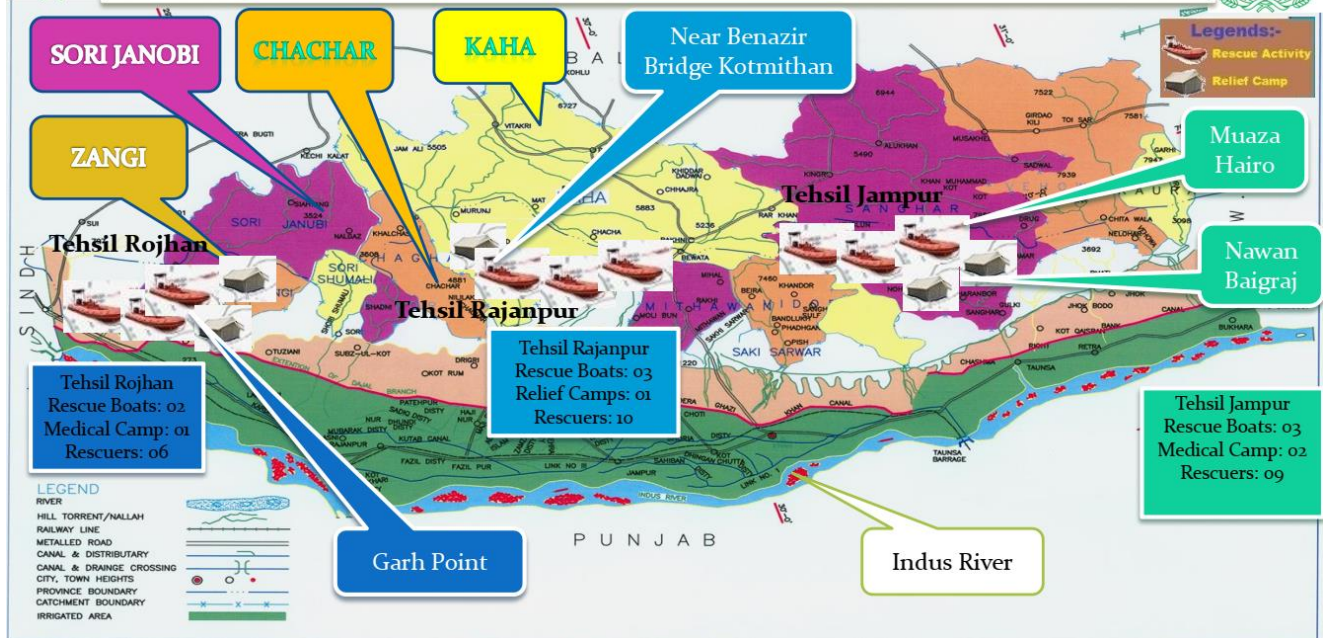

3. The Head Master of respective school will be declared as Incharge of relief camp. He will look after the flood affectees of the camp regarding provision of food, health facilities and others in collaboration with local administration.

SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT:

1. Mobilization of philanthropist, Donors to provide relief goods to flood affectees i.e cooked food and dry ration.
2. Mobilization of NGOs to take part in flood activities.
3. Coordination with District Administration.

POLICE:

1. The District Police Officer, Rajanpur will direct all SDPOs & SHOs to assist the Assistant Commissioners and all the Sector & Sub-Sector Officers.
2. All the SHOs shall make early arrangements for the communication of flood information to likely flood affected villages falling in their jurisdiction by adopting quickest means.
3. All SHOs shall provide full assistance to the Assistant Commissioners in the District Rajanpur and Sector/Sub Sector Officers who have to perform duty for flood control and flood relief measures.

ARMY:

The Deputy Commissioner & District Police Officer, Rajanpur will have close contact with the army authorities at the following Nos. Immediate army assistance, if required in case of flood emergency, would be obtained to provide necessary relief to flood affected people which DC & DPO will decide.

Two Army companies and two Rangers companies will be requisitioned in case of flood.

NGOs COORDINATION & SUPPORT

A separate wing for coordination with INGOs & NGOs has been established. Ms. Shazia Nawaz, Deputy Director Social Welfare, Rajanpur is coordinator for this purpose.

She will:

- Coordinate with INGOs & NGOs & guide them regarding specific area of relief work.
- Organize & coordinate the emergency relief goods & supplies.
- Allocate different geographic areas to different NGOs for emergency relief works.
- Keep contacts with the field establishments of different NGOs already operating in District Rajanpur?

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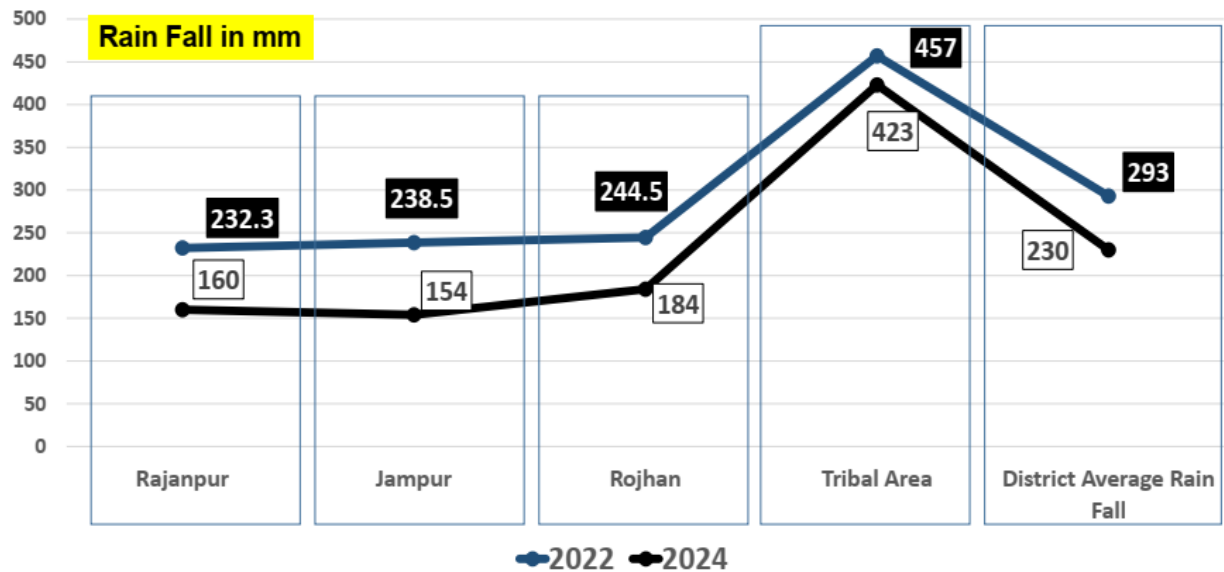

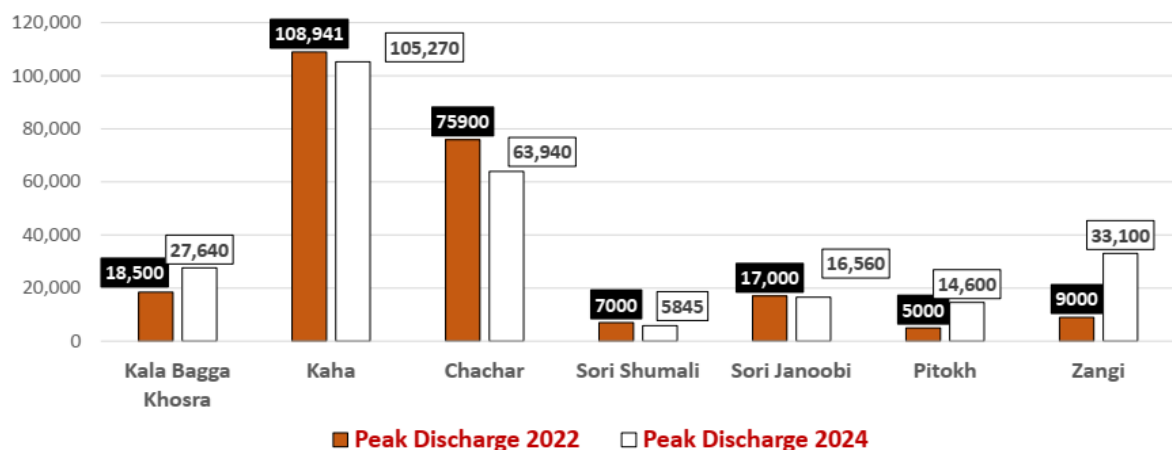


COMPARISON RAINFALL (2022 & 2024) DISTRICT RAJANPUR



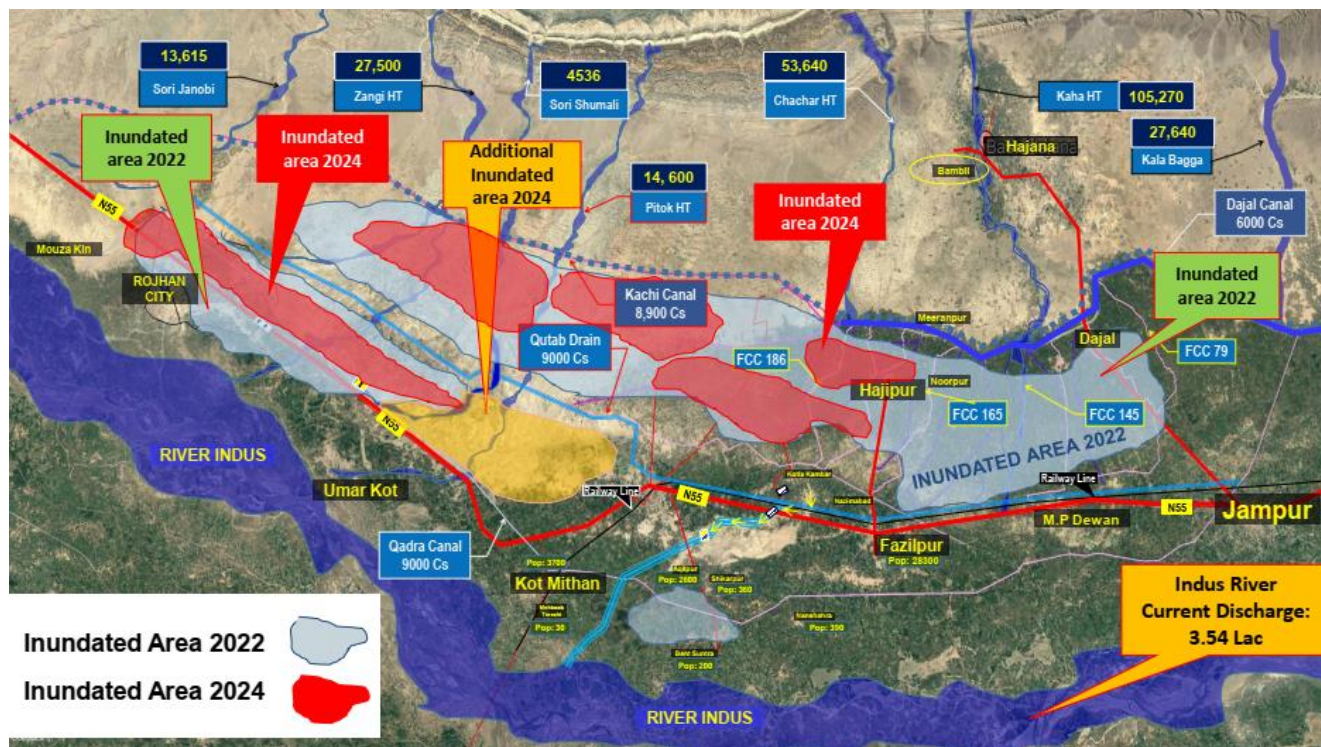
COMPARISON OF DISCHARGES

In the flood of 2022, there was a flow of 240,186 cusecs of water. In the current year, 2024, the flow has increased to 268,110 cusecs, representing an increase of 27,924 cusecs. However, due to the effective and proactive management of the District Administration under the supervision of the Deputy Commissioner and Chairman of the DDMA, Rajanpur, the losses and damages reported this year are significantly lower than those in 2022. The entire team of the District Administration deserves commendation for their efforts.

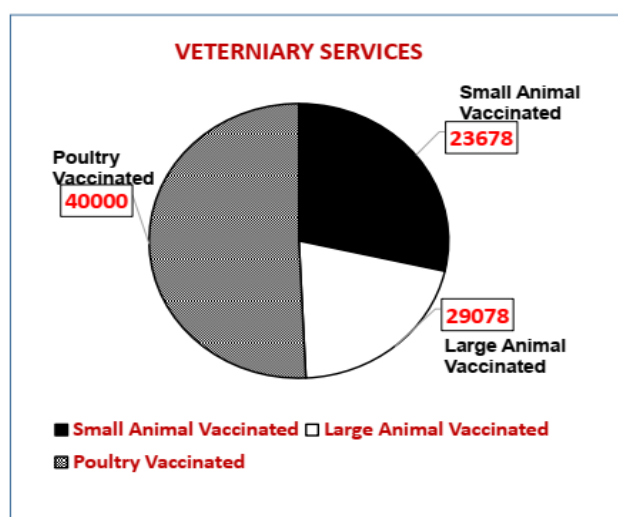
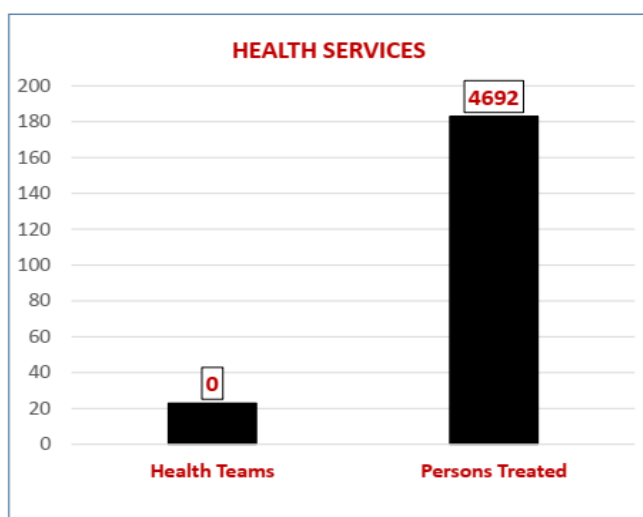
