

STRATEGIC SUMMARY

Disaster Management Plan of District Sialkot has been prepared keeping in view historical occurrences of disasters incidents. Flood has been most frequent incident with few instances of Tornados & Fire incidents. Incidents of earth quakes have also increased in recent past raising alarm for all stake holders.

In Sialkot flood season normally include period from July to October. First flood contingency plan was prepared in 1975 & it has been revised about every year. Sialkot experienced highest flood levels in year 2014 and the same are taken as bench Mark.

This plan covers measures for pre, during & post phases of disaster, gives snap shot of available resources & mechanism for their efficient & effective utilization under close coordination of all stake holders.





ESTABLISHMENT OF CONTROL ROOM

- The District Flood Control Room shall be established on 15th of June every year in the office of the Additional Deputy Commissioner (R), Sialkot who shall be the District Flood Relief Officer.
- It shall be supplied 2 land line Telephones with numbers 052 9250011 & 052 9250466, Wireless set, Fax Machine, Photocopy Machine, Television and Computer with Printer & internet facility.
- It shall be functional 24 hours. Duty roster shall be issued before 15th of June every year by the District Flood Relief Officer.
- The officials deputed for duty shall be given training by the DEO and DFRO about their role and duties on 1st June every year.
- The foregoing arrangements shall also be made on the similar pattern at offices of the Assistant Commissioners officers who shall be Tehsil Flood Relief Officers.
- Wireless Sets shall be Installed/ fitted at Headmarala and Ura (Nullah Aik) for uninterrupted flow of information.
- In normal situation Information regarding discharge position of River Chenab and all Nullahs in the District shall be received twice a day.
- In case of any potential threat or emergency, frequency of information shall be increased.
- The following departments shall also establish their Departmental Flood Control Rooms on the similar pattern.
 - District Council
 - Municipal Corporation/Committees Sialkot, Pasrur, Daska & Sambrial
 - District Police
 - Rescue 1122
 - Irrigation XEN (s) Marala & Pasrur link Divisions.

Functions and Responsibilities.

- I. Prepare a disaster management plan including district response plan for the province.
- II. Co-ordinate and monitor the implementation of the National Policy, Provincial Policy, National Plan, Provincial Plan and District Plan.
- III. Ensure that areas in the district vulnerable to disasters are identified and measures for the prevention of disasters and mitigation of its effects are undertaken by the departments of the Government at the district level as well as by the Local Authorities.
- IV. Ensure that the guidelines for prevention, mitigation, preparedness and response measures as laid down by the National Authority and Provincial Authority are followed by all departments of the government at the district level and local authorities in the District.

Disaster Management Coordination Centre/Control Room (functions and responsibilities)

The Following would be the Mechanism:

- I. The control room is the nodal center in terms of disaster management.
- II. To monitor, coordinate and implement the actions for disaster management.
- III. To ensure an information system on a routine basis from the District Heads of Departments on the vulnerability of various blocks and villages.
- IV. To make arrangements for dissemination of information to all vulnerable places.
- V. To report the ground situation and the action taken by the District Administration.
- VI. To have a list of all personnel and trained persons who could be contacted at any time.
- VII. To organize post disaster evaluation.
- VIII. To develop liaison with the operation center. Site operation center is the center in the disaster site to be set up
- IX. Coordinating among response and rescue department for timely rescue and reporting to Govt. / PDMA for additional rescues.
- X. To organize post disaster evaluation.

Civil-Military Coordination Mechanism

The ADC (G) will coordinate with Army Units for any possible assistance needed for disaster response under approval from the DC/Chairman DDMA.

PREPAREDNESS

I. Identification of areas likely to be affected

All AC's shall identify the areas that were affected during the last flood as well as that are likely to be affected and send lists about all such areas to District Flood Relief Officer before 30 April.

The following areas, which had been affected during previous floods, are likely to be affected.

I. Tehsil Sialkot a) River Chenab

River Chenab enters in District Sialkot at Akhnor and Rivers Manawar Tavi and Jammu Tavi contribute their water few kilometers upstream Marala Barrage. The flood water passing through Marala Barrage affects the downstream areas on south eastern side of the river mostly comprising the area of tehsil sambrial. However, at the joining point of Jammu Tavi flood water also affects areas of sikka, Bella, Gangwal, Papeen, and Wadran Bella upstream Marala Barraege.

Nadala enclave, where River Chenab and Munawar Tawi converge, many villages including Nadala, Machola, Bhak \ lial, Hial Minhasan, Simbli Rai, Salepur, Bhatwal, Maheel, Jhumian Dallalan, Ikramabad, Khoonjpur, Beli and Rasulpur are affected.

b) River Jammu Tavi:-

Villages across the LMB of Chaprar area, the whole of Bajwat area and areas along LMB downstream Saipur Bridge and Saidpur-Bajwat Road on northern side of the bridge etc.

C) Nullah Aik

Though the Irrigation Department has constructed three protection bunds namely Mally Chak, Hajipura and Nekapura Bunds to save the city. Nullah Aik overflows at many points. This water affects syedanwali, Raipur, Gopal Pur, Rasul Pur, Lalokay in southern side affects the villages Daburji Arayan, Shafi Da Bhatta, Lakhon Pur, Chhawani Sulehrian, Kotli Hernarayan, Praag Pur, Kot Mandian wala, Gunna Khurd, Hamza Ghus, Nawann Pin, Alhilal Colony, Pakki Kotli and Sadra Badra after t he nullah Aik entering into the city overflow at Naka pura and contributes to the flood water overflowing from pindi Arayan and affects the above-mentioned villages. It overflows at Arazi Yaqus and affects the villages Arazi Yaqus, Daburji Mallyian. It overflows at Kotli Ameer Ali and affects Miani and Butter.

In northern Side Nullah Aik overflow at the point of Aalo Chak and affects the villages of Aalo Chak and Areas of city. It over flow at the point of Bogrra and affects the area of Fateh Garh, industrial Ara and Adjining Areas. It overflows at shatab Garha and affects the villages of Gaunjianwali Rohail Garrha, Dhuuny, Laodhray, Kohr wali, Dogranwali, Adalat Garrah, Dhattal Khurd, Jalyai wali, Neeram and Dul cheek ay.

d) Palkhu Nullah

Nullah Palkhu also spills over during rainy season and affects villages Nawanpind, Jhatta, Kapoorwali, Chiiti Skeikhan, Jaurian, Bhagwal Awan, Kotli Tailian, Ghansarpur and some portion of Kotli Loharan (West), Kotli Mughlan, Baqar Pur and Kot Karim Bakhsh.

e) Nullah Bhaid

Nullah Bhaid is a narrow channel passing East-West through the middle of the city Sialkot. It has a very limited capacity for flow of water. Heavy rains in the sub-urban areas on the eastern side of the city as well as in the city cause it to overflow. It results in flood in the adjoining areas. It affected the following areas in flood 2014. It over flow near lungrianwali and affects the villages of lungrianwali and Kakey wali. It also affect the lorry Adda Road, Khawja Safder Road, Khadim Ali Road, Model Town, Kotli Behram, Iqbal Town, Miana Pura, Pakka Garha, Mag Town, Murad Pur and Malkay Kalan.

II. Tehsil Daska

Area between River Chenab and UCC and low-lying area on the eastern side of Marala Ravi Link gets flooded due to stoppage of water by high embankments of Marala Ravi Link. A total area of about 39,100 acres is affected.

a) At village Uddowar and Pandorian, water is stopped due to non-existence of siphons. This water accumulates mainly due to rains.

III. Tehsi Sambrial

a) At Pasia and Umakay, bank of UCC block the water, which gradually accumulates and inundates vast area. One of the existing siphons has been plugged on technical grounds while the other is working.

b) Overflow in Nullah Palkhu and river Chenab inundates Majra Kalan, Majra Khurd, Kaulokey, Umerkey, Thatha Moosa, Kartarpur, Randhir, Hussain Pur, Pir Kot, Duburji Chanda Singh, Kishan Garh, Mast Garh, Kot Dina, Kot Malian, Kot Inayat Sahianwala etc villages in Tehsil Sambrial.

IV. Tehsil Pasrur

Area affected in Pasrur Tehsil spreads over both sides of Daik Nullah as also some areas on eastern side of M.R. Link, Totaling about 4940 acres.

- Village situated in bed and on bank of Daik Nullah is usually affected. They include Khalil Pur, Kishanpur, Kot Virk, Haft Hanjlies, Kang, Kassowal, Bagh, Begampur, Bhikhikay, Mian Cheema and Makhanpur.
- Mohallah Kot Kuba, Grain Market, Mohallah Bahadur Pura and Normal School in Pasrur city. Ban Bajwa and Adamkay Nagra near M.R. Link are affected where canal had to be cut in the past in order to save village inhabitants.

- Area lying across M.R. Link near Bhalial is also threatened.
- Total acreage likely to be affected in Sialkot district comes to 74,040.

V. Communication Systems Likely To Be Affected

- vi. Saidpur-Phuklian Road by Nullah Daik, near Chak Khoja.
- vii. Pasrur-Chawinda Road by Hassri & Daik Nullahs near Lappaywali/ Mattike.
- viii. Pasrur-Daska Road by Hassri & Daik Nullahs near Kotli Bawa Faqir Chand.

b) Railway Lines

- i. Railway line between Sialkot & Gunna Kalan stations Jodhay Wali.
- ii. Railway Line between Alhar Chawinda stations Chawinda.
- iii. Railway line between Chawinda and Pasrur stations Malopatial.




- On receipt of warning, they will convey it to the local population through the revenue Field staff.

RESCUE STRATEGY

- i. Strategic Command will be done by the Deputy Commissioner being the Chairman of District Disaster Management Authority (DDMA) and District Emergency Board (DEB)
- ii. The main focus of strategic command will be to establish the priorities and strategy for managing the flood situation and to supply the resources to deal with it.
- iii. Strategic Command has established a clear and unambiguous command structure based upon the experiences of previous years, Geographical Condition of District, unprecited Climatic changes, resources held and future challenges.
- vi. A key function of Strategic Command will be to predeploy rescue and flood management Resources to District and Tehsil level Rescue Teams.
- v. Joint meetings of DDMA and DEB shall be held before start of Flood seaon to review the preparation for the flood season, identifiy the resource gap/short comings and ensure timely completeion/procurements.

HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE

- * All concern department will provide damages / loss reports
- * DDMA shall prioritize need.
- * Rescue 1122, Civil defence, MCs and Health Department will provide help in the respective areas of responsibility.
- * DDMA will be facilitating & monitoring the humanitarian assatant.
- * All correspondence will be made through DC in coordination with all departments in the District.
- * 22 relief camps will be established by the district aministration with coordination of local administration



DEPARTMENTWISE OPERATIONAL PLANS

Disaster Management Services

I. Health Department Service

- The CEO (Health) shall be the incharge of these Services.

❖ Functions

- He shall cause to be prepared flood contingency plan pertaining to health department by 31st March every year.
- The CEO (Health) shall purchase complete emergency medicine by 30th April every year. All flood emergency related medicines shall be purchased in sufficient quantity.
- The DHO shall notify Health & Nutrition Coordination Committee comprising;
 - ❖ DHO Sialkot
 - ❖ DDHO Health Sialkot,
 - ❖ DDHO Health Daska,
 - ❖ DDHO Health Pasrur,
 - ❖ DDHO Health Sambrial,
 - ❖ CDCO,
 - ❖ DSV,
 - ❖ DSI,
 - ❖ Director DHDC,
 - ❖ IRMNCH Programme,
 - ❖ UNO
- The Health & Nutrition coordination committee shall hold meetings on weekly basis.
- The CEO (Health) and DHO shall arrange deficient stock of logistics supplies till 15th June. (Tents, Medicine stock)
- The CEO (Health) will nominate NGOs / CBOs who shall be helpful during flood till 2nd Week of April.
- The CEO (Health) and DO (H) shall ensure the supply of logistics and medicine stock at designated points till 20th June of every year.
- The CEO (Health) and DHO shall arrange orientation training of Medical Officers and paramedical staff about flood relief camps and disease reporting till 2nd well of June.
- The CEO (Health) shall review all these preparations till 04th week of June.

- Answer inquiries as to whereabouts of missing persons.
- Assist in location of family members of victims, facilitate reunion of dislocated families.
- Provide useful knowledge and skills to victims to help them in their return to normal living.
- Arrange activities to meet the diverse needs of disaster victims.

III. SECURITY SERVICES

- These services shall be under the direct charge of the District Police Officer, Sialkot in order to maintain peace and order and protect life and property in the disaster area.
- The Assistant Commissioner and DSP shall assist him in his task at Tehsil level.
- There shall also be a Liaison Officer from the Army included in these Services.

❖ Functions

- Establish security post at the temp. Relief camp.
- Maintain peace and order
- Enforce Law & Order.
- Apprehend/Arrest law violators
- Protect evacuated inhabitants and stocks of resources.
- Facilitate disaster operations by controlling the movement of the individuals.
- Handling the bodies of deceased persons.
- Detect and prevent disaster.
- Carry out initial rescue and survey operations
- Assist in saving lives and property
- To establish temporary Police Check Posts at the vulnerable points to stop the cuts / breaches on the left banks of Canals as given below: -
 - Jhatta on M.R. Link
 - Ganjianwali on M.R. Link
 - Ban Bajwa on M.R. Link
 - R.D 30-31 Daska on B.R.B
 - R.D 84-85 Veerwala on B.R.B
- He will direct traffic and plan alternative road connection.

IV. TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

- The Secretary RTA shall be the Head of these services;

❖ Functions

- This cell, in addition to the existing Transport shall also requisition vehicles from other Departments and public sector.
- Ensure adequate supply of POL for all transport in use of all departments especially the emergency response services.
- Manage, direct and control all available transportation facilities and ensures their appropriate and efficient utilization in the disaster area.
- All requests are to be forwarded to the transportation service in the following cases:
 - Evacuation from the area under threat.
 - Transportation of the affected population from the temporary relief camps to the permanent relief camps established in the school buildings.
- Prepare list of persons to be contacted for provision of Transport.
- Constitute Teams to bring transport in line.
- Tehsil wise acquisition & utilization of the transport.

V. Agriculture Department Services

- The Deputy Director (Agriculture) shall be the incharge of these Services.

❖ Functions

- They shall help the Irrigation Department in the supply of earth moving machinery for bund protections.
- Supply of seed for sowing of crops.
- Assist farmers on preparation and sowing of crops.
- Provide fertilizers and agricultural implements on loan basis.

VI. Live Stock & Dairy Department Services

- The AD (Live stock) shall be the incharge of these services:

❖ Functions

- The AD (Live Stock) shall start pre-flood vaccination w.e.f 1st May every year throughout the District that shall continue upto 15th May every year.
- Vaccination against H.S., Foot & Mouth, Entro Toxemia, pleuropneumonia and N.D.
- The AD (Live Stock) shall issue duty roster to this effect by 31st March every year.
- Rescue live stock in coordination with other departments.
- Establish veterinary camps.

- Arrange all necessary medicine
- Treatment of Animals
- Provision of fodder and Wanda

VII. Civil Defence Services

- The Civil Defence Officer shall be the incharge of these Services helped by 400 volunteers.

❖ Functions

- He shall issue duty roster assigning duties of volunteers in case of flood emergency.
- He shall ensure issuance of flood warning through his volunteers in case of likelihood of flood.
- He shall arrange training of the volunteers with a special focus on warning, rescue and relief activities pertaining to flood emergency in the month of April every year.
- The volunteers shall also be imparted first Aid Training including artificial respiration, treatment of snake biting and emergency method of rescue.
- He shall conduct search and sweeping through Bomb Disposal Squad in case of any suspicion.

VIII. Communication Department Services

- The District Police Officer shall supervise the communication system at the District level.

❖ Functions

- They shall ensure that all the telephone connections and wireless sets are in working order during emergency period.
- It shall also connect strategic points with the nearest telephone exchange or through wireless connection.
- Director Telephones Sialkot shall ensure that the telephone numbers of important departments are always in working condition especially those given in attached List.

IX. Engineering Department (Mechanical) Services

The Assistant Agriculture Engineer shall be incharge of these services:

❖ Functions

- Provide machines and material for repair of bulldozers and tractors working on bunds.
- Establish workshop near the vulnerable points.
- The bulldozers of Agriculture Department shall be utilized for the strengthening of canal banks and to improve the flow of water through siphons.

X. Food Department Services

- The District Food Controller shall be Incharge of these Services.

- He shall be assisted by his Assistant Food Controllers.

❖ **Functions**

- He shall ensure that adequate stock of Aata is available in the District.
- He shall prepare a plan for special ration depots at the strategic places.
- He shall organize mobile depots.

VIII. Forest Department

The Divisional Forest Officer shall be the incharge of these services.

❖ **Functions**

- Shall provide "ABKALANI" material and assist the patrolling of bunds. He shall provide places for flood affected cattle-heads.

X. Information Department Services

The District Information Officer shall be the incharge of these services.

❖ **Functions**

- He shall ensure that news media and the public receive correct information and warning messages.
- He shall plan and arrange the visits of newsmen to the flood affected areas in district Sialkot.

XI. Irrigation & Power Department Services

This department consists of the following members:

- Executive Engineer, Marala Barrage.
- Executive Engineer, Pasrur Link Division
- Executive Engineer, U.C.C Gujranwala
- Executive Engineer, Drainage Division, Lahore
- Executive Engineer, Bund Division Lahore.

❖ **Functions**

- The department shall supervise, direct and control bund protection activities,
- Desilting of all syphons and inlets of UCC and MR Link.
- It shall also control various canals in the District.
- The XEN Pasrur Link division shall establish two emergency depots on the bank of Nullah Aik containing sand bags, poles etc. to cover the breach in the right bund of Aik.
- He shall further deploy staff on nullah Aik, M.R. Link and UCC to keep vigilance and to act in case of emergency especially at sites of possible breaches.

- He shall also be responsible for the breach through escape channel at the both side bank of the M.R Link to save the structures of the canal.

XII. WAPDA Services

the Superintending Engineer, WAPDA, Sialkot shall be the incharge of these services, assisted by his XENs in the districts.

❖ Functions

- He shall make lighting arrangements on the bunds for night patrol and protection activities.
- He shall also ensure orderly and regular power supply throughout the district in disaster emergency.
- He shall also establish emergency control room with telephone and mobile staff and shall work round the clock.

XIII. District Council Services

Chief Officer will be the incharge of these services within its respective area.

❖ Functions

- Establish emergency flood center of their organization with staff working round the clock.
- They shall keep the dewatering set in working condition.
- Drain stagnant water from low lying areas.
- Provide food and other basic necessities.
- They shall conduct survey of dangerous buildings.
- They shall further desilt the sewerage and open drains to help the drainage of flood and rain water from the affected area.
- The Muncipal Officer (I&S) shall provide potable water in affected areas and in relief camps.
- The Muncipal Officer (I&S) shall keep in hand adequate stores of spare parts, etc. for repair of necessary machinery and equipments.
- He shall also ensure that adequate supplies are available for chlorination of drinking water.
-

XIV. Municipal Corporation Services

Chief Officer will be the incharge of these services within their respective tehsil.

❖ Functions

- Establish emergency flood center of their organization with staff working round the clock.
- The Chief Officer MC, Sialkot shall establish two flood emergency centers at following points:
 - Fire Brigade center Kutchery Road Sialkot.
 - Khawaja Safder Memorial Municipal Hospital

- They shall keep the dewatering set in working condition.
- Drain stagnant water from low lying areas.
- Provide food and other basic necessities.
- They shall conduct survey of dangerous buildings.
- They shall further desilt the sewerage and open drains to help the drainage of flood and rain water from the affected area.
- The Municipal Officer (I&S) shall provide potable water in affected areas and in relief camps.
- The Municipal Officer (I&S) shall keep in hand adequate stores of spare parts, etc. for repair of necessary machinery and equipments.
- He shall also ensure that adequate supplies are available for chlorination of drinking water.

XV. Municipal Committees Services

Chief Officers shall be the incharge of these services within their respective tehsils.

❖ Functions

- Establish emergency flood center of their organization with staff working round the clock.
- They shall keep the dewatering set in working condition.
- Drain stagnant water from low lying areas.
- Provide food and other basic necessities.
- They shall conduct survey of dangerous buildings.
- They shall further desilt the sewerage and open drains to help the drainage of flood and rain water from the affected area.
- The Municipal Officer (I&S) shall provide potable water in affected areas and in relief camps.
- The Municipal Officer (I&S) shall keep in hand adequate stores of spare parts, etc. for repair of necessary machinery and equipments.
- He shall also ensure that adequate supplies are available for chlorination of drinking water.

XVI. Army Services

The ADC (G) shall be the Liaison Offices of Civil Administration for liaison with the Army. The 104 Brigade shall nominate Liaison Officer for liaison with the Civil Administration. If help of the Army is required, they shall assist in rescue and evacuation operations, as also provide transport and communication facilities and assist the Irrigation authorities in bund protection.

XVII. XEN HIGHWAYS

He will depute staff at important bridges and roads for maintenance.

He will arrange machinery for repair of breaches in roads for provision of relief and during evacuation,

He will arrange desilting in culverts and water ways on provincial and district roads

XVIII. DISTRICT NAZIR/ADC (REV)

He is requested to keep account of expenditure of field operations during emergency and to cater to funds authorised by DDMA.

BREACHING SECTION OF HEAD MARALA WORKS

As per notification of Irrigation Department, Govt. of Punjab dated 15-07-2017, the SOP for breaching section and all instructions from Federal Flood Commission, the following procedure will be followed;

1. Maintenance and operation of breaching section at Head Marala shall rest with Irrigation Department i.e. XEN Irrigation, Marala Division.
2. Breaching section will be operated on orders of following committee;
 - i. Deputy Commissioner, Sialkot (Convenor)
 - ii. Deputy Commissioner, Gujrat or his representative (in a case area affected falls outside the district in which breaching section is located).
 - iii. Executive Engineer, Irrigation, Marala Division.
 - iv. Executive Engineer, Highway Division, Sialkot.
 - v. Rep. of Pakistan Army not below rank of Lt. Colonel.
3. The decision to operate a breaching section shall be taken by the committee keeping in view the technical advice of the Executive Engineer concerned of the Irrigation Department. In case of any difference of opinion among the members, the final decision shall rest with the Deputy Commissioner, Sialkot.
4. The District Police Officer of Sialkot and Gujrat will deploy sufficient force to clear 01 KM area from both sides of breaching section.
5. The Civil Defence team be deployed to keep people/traffic at safe distance from breaching section.
6. XEN Irrigation will keep 04 number of 4x4 trucks ready for transport of explosives.
7. The explosives will be procured by Irrigation Department and all necessary equipment for breaching section should be kept in stock well in advance.
8. AC Sialkot will keep close liaison with officer incharge of 01 Engineer for logistic support and coordination in case of emergency.
