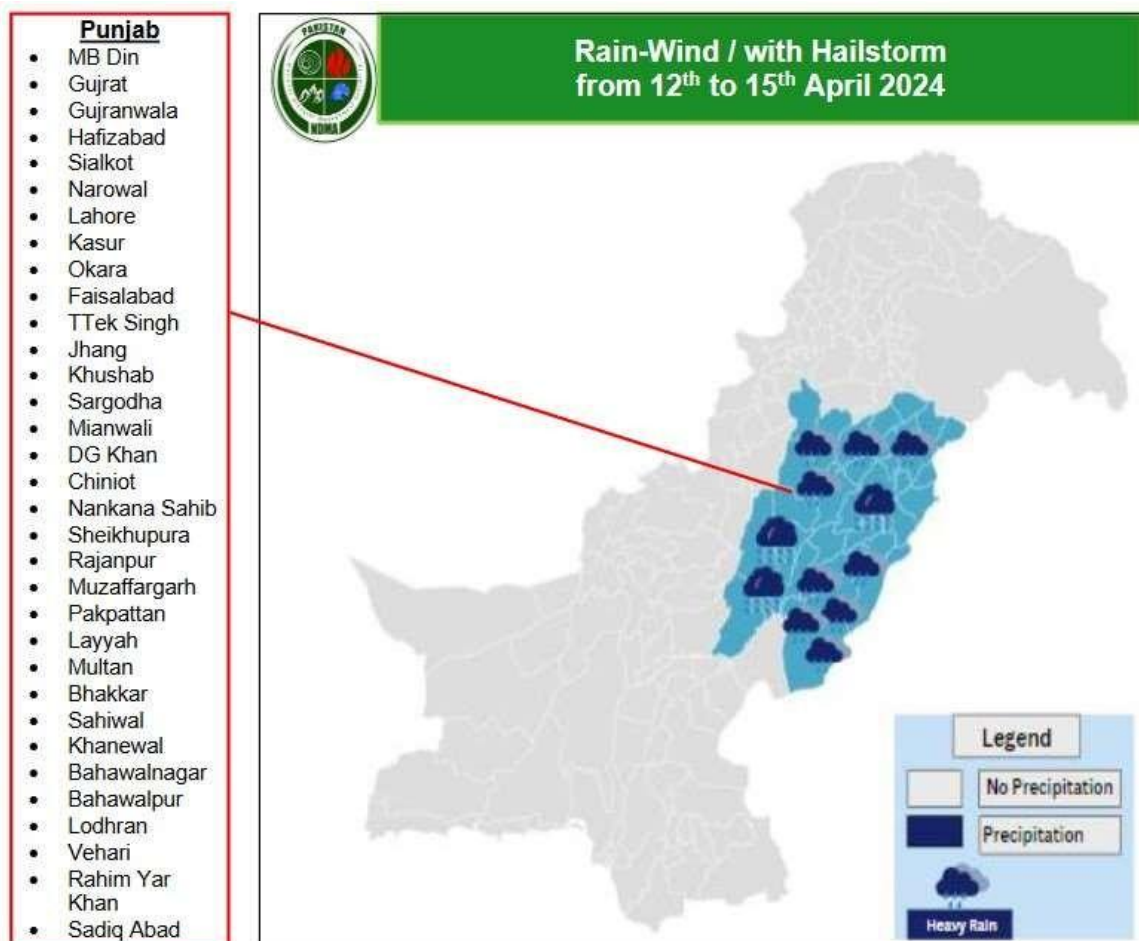

SUBJECT: RAIN WITH WIND/THUNDERSTORM PREDICTED FROM 10TH APRIL TO 15TH APRIL (WITH OCCASIONAL GAPS)

REFERENCE:

- i. Weather advisory vide Pakistan Meteorological Department letter no. NWFC-5 (10A)/2017/71, dated April 8, 2024. (copy enclosed)
 - ii. NDMA Weather Advisory letter no. F.2 (E)/2024-NDMA (MW/Weather Advisory-XXXI) dated 08th April 2024. (copy enclosed)
2. Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) informed that **rain-wind/thunderstorm** is expected in Murree, Galliyat, Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal **on 10th and then 12th (evening/night) to 15th April**, with occasional gaps while Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Sialkot, Narowal, Lahore, Kasur, Okara, Faisalabad, Toba Tek Singh, Jhang, Khushab, Sargodha, Mianwali, Dera Ghazi Khan, Rajanpur, Bhakkar, Layyah, Multan, Pakpattan, Sahiwal, Kot Addu, Muzaffargarh, Rahim Yar Khan, Sadiqabad, Khanpur, Bahawalpur and Bahawalnagar with occasional gaps **from 12th (evening/night) to 15th April**. Isolated windstorm/hailstorm is also expected **from 13th to 15th April**.



3. Under the influence of this weather system, following are likely impacts:
 - i. Snowfall may disrupt roads in Murree, Galliyat, and surrounding during the forecast period.
 - ii. Landslides / mudslides may lead to potential road blockages due to isolated rain spell.
 - iii. Heavy rainfall may cause flash flooding in local nullahs.
 - iv. Farmers are advised to remain extra cautious and plan agricultural activity accordingly during the spell.
4. In view of above, it is once again reiterated that all the DDMA's / Field formations are requested to maintain high level of preparedness and ensuring the following measures:-
 - a. Ensure round-the-clock monitoring of the situation through EOCs with regular feedback to DEOCs and PEOC.
 - b. DDMA/ District Administration are advised to relocate families to safe sites and shelters from mud houses in order to prevent casualties.
Forewarn travelers / visitors about risks posed from flooding / landslides and likely snowfall over mountains in vulnerable locations and provide guidance and assistance in case of emergencies through local administration, police and rescue services.
 - c. Ensure that in places where there is a high risk of urban floods, flash flooding, hill torrents and landslides - emergency services, personnel and equipment (such as Rescue 1122, Fire Brigade, Ambulance and Civil Defense, among others) are available.
 - d. Preplace necessary emergency equipment at vulnerable / strategic locations to expedite response efforts and complete stocking / replenishment of stocks.
 - e. NH&MP and Traffic Police to coordinate with Law Enforcement Agencies to

manage and redirect traffic from affected areas to safer areas, to prevent congestion and facilitate emergency response efforts.

- f. NHA / Line Departments to conduct regular inspections of critical infrastructure, such as bridges and roads, to identify and address any vulnerability that may lead to structural damage during heavy rainfall.
- g. PMD / FFD / DDMA's to proactively monitor nullahs / storm water drains, to ensure their proper functioning and prevent blockages that may lead to inundation.
- h. Ensure widespread circulation of alerts and advisories, especially in local languages, to raise awareness and sensitize travelers / tourists and local communities in at-risk / vulnerable areas.
- i. Coordinate with relevant departments to secure loose structures such as electrical poles, solar panels, hoardings and under-construction buildings to mitigate potential damages from dust-wind / thunderstorms.
- j. Conduct mass public awareness campaigns to educate residents and travelers in vulnerable areas about the risks of flash flooding / landslides / avalanche / blizzard and take precautionary measures.
- k. Advise general public to seek shelter in safe areas, such as sturdy buildings or underground structures during dust-wind / hail-thunderstorms and avoid objects that pose a risk of falling / being struck by lightning.
- l. Strengthen coordination among all relevant departments and agencies to facilitate timely sharing of information and resources during emergency situations.
- m. Establish reliable communication channels with local communities to provide timely updates, instructions and emergency contact information.
- n. Advise farmers to take necessary mitigative and precautionary measures to safeguard their crops through timely harvesting, safe storage or any other precaution from adverse effects of dust-wind-thunderstorms / hailstorms and likely drop in temperatures.
- o. Share daily / routine updates with PDMA Punjab in case of any eventuality.

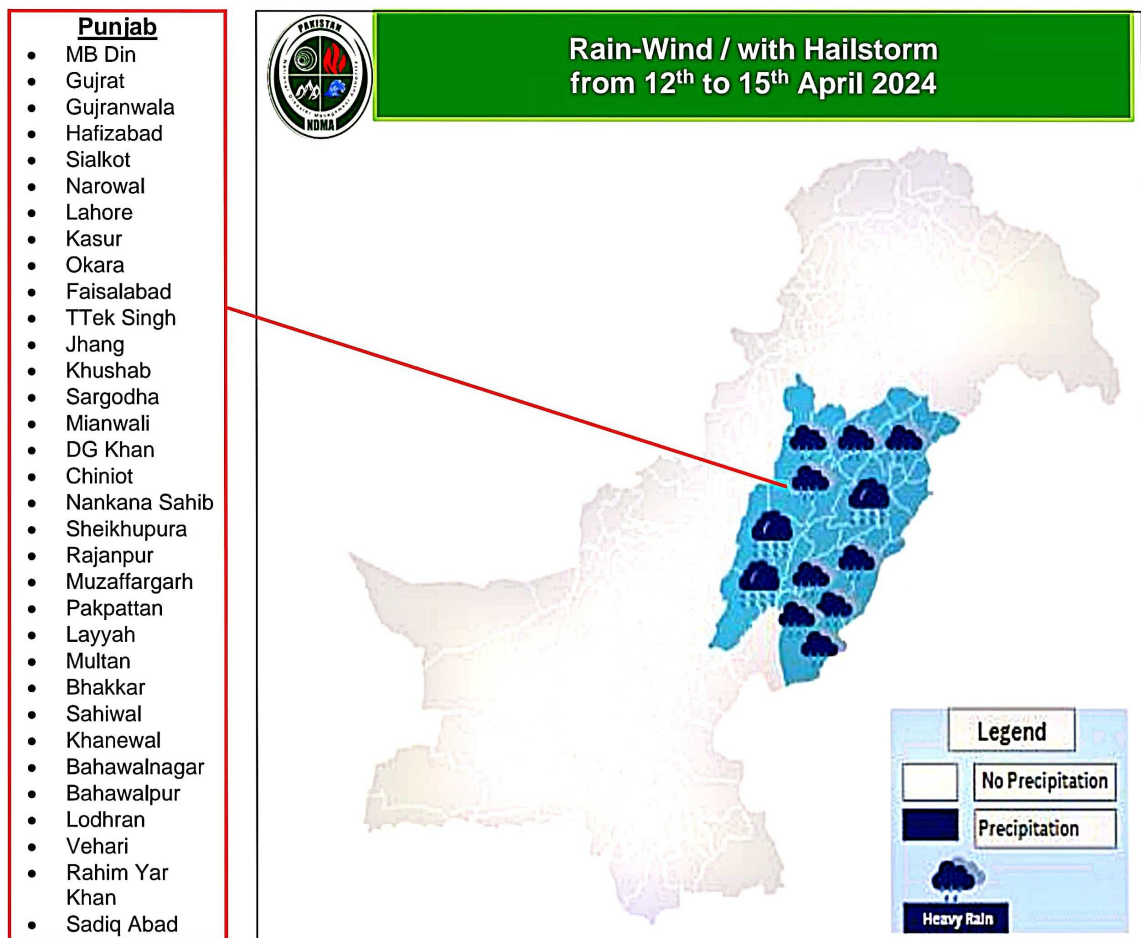

Subject: **Rain with Wind / Thunderstorms from 10-15 April with Occasional Gaps**

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) (Press Release at **Annex-A**) have forecasted that a **westerly wave** is entering from **10th April** and likely to grip most parts of the country until **15th April**. Under the influence, **Rain / Windstorms / Thunderstorms along with Isolated Heavy Falls and Hailstorms with Occasional Gaps** is expected in following areas of the country: -



2. Under the influence of this weather system, following are likely impacts: -

a. **KP, GB, Galiyat, Murree and State of AJ&K**

- (1) **Rainfall / Thunderstorms** may **disrupt roads** during the forecasted period.
- (2) **Tourists** are advised to **remain cautious** during the spell and check weather updates before traveling.
- (3) **Electricity** / other **utility services** may **get disrupted**.
- (4) **Heavy Rainfall** may generate **flash flooding** in local nullahs / streams and river tributaries.

- (5) **Landslides, mudslides**, may lead to potential **road blockages** in Upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Galiyat, Murree, Gilgit Baltistan and State of AJ&K.
- (6) **Windstorms / Hailstorms** may damage crops, loose structures, etc.
- (7) **Farmers** are advised to remain **extra cautious** and plan agricultural activity accordingly during the spell.
- (8) **Temperatures** are likely to **drop** during the spell.

b. **Balochistan**

- (1) **Heavy rainfall** may cause **flash flooding** in local nullahs.
- (2) **Hill torrents** are expected in Sulaiman and the Kirthar Range.
- (3) **Landslides / mudslides** may lead to potential **road blockages** due to isolated rain spell.
- (4) **Windstorms / Hailstorms** may damage crops, loose structures, etc.
- (5) **Electricity** / other **utility services** may **get disrupted**.
- (6) **Farmers** are advised to remain **extra cautious** and plan agricultural activity accordingly during the spell.

c. **Punjab / Sindh / Islamabad Capital Territory**

- (1) **Hill torrents** are expected in DG Khan and Rajanpur.
- (2) **Heavy Rainfall** may generate **flash flooding** in local nullahs / streams and river tributaries.
- (3) **Windstorms / Hailstorms** may damage crops, loose structures, etc.
- (4) **Electricity** / other **utility services** may **get disrupted**.
- (5) **Farmers** are advised to remain **extra cautious** and plan agricultural activity accordingly during the spell.
- (6) **Tourists** are advised to **remain cautious** during the spell and check weather updates before traveling.
- (7) **Temperatures** are likely to **drop** during the spell.

3. All PDMAs / GBDMA / SDMA and ICT Administration, NHA, NH&MP, FWO, Rescue 1122, Dam Authorities, Line Departments, Ministries and Federal Agencies are required to undertake measures as per respective mandates. However, following is to be ensured by all concerned, in addition to measures deemed appropriate as per on ground situation / requirements: -

- a. Ensure **round-the-clock monitoring** of the situation through EOCs with **regular feedback** to PEOCs and NEOC.
- b. DDMA/ **District Administration** are advised to **relocate families** to **safe sites** and **shelters** from **mud houses** in order to prevent casualties.
- c. **Forewarn travelers / visitors** about risks posed from flooding / landslides and likely snowfall over mountains in vulnerable locations and **provide guidance and assistance** in case of emergencies through local administration, police and rescue services.
- d. Ensure that in places where there is a high risk of urban floods, flash flooding, hill torrents and landslides - **emergency services, personnel and equipment** (such as Rescue 1122, Fire Brigade, Ambulance and Civil Defense, among others) are **available**.
- e. **Preplace necessary emergency equipment** at vulnerable / strategic locations to expedite response efforts and **complete stocking** / replenishment of stocks.
- f. NH&MP and Traffic Police to **coordinate** with **Law Enforcement Agencies** to **manage** and **redirect traffic** from affected areas to safer areas, to prevent congestion and facilitate emergency response efforts.
- g. NHA / Line Departments to conduct **regular inspections of critical infrastructure**, such as bridges and roads, to **identify and address any vulnerability** that may lead to structural damage during heavy rainfall.
- h. PMD / FFD / PDMA's / PIDs to **proactively monitor nullahs / storm water drains**, to ensure their proper functioning and prevent blockages that may lead to inundation.
- i. Ensure widespread **circulation of alerts and advisories**, especially in local languages, to **raise awareness** and **sensitize travelers / tourists** and local communities in at-risk / vulnerable areas.
- j. **Coordinate with relevant departments** to secure loose structures such as electrical poles, solar panels, hoardings and under-construction buildings to **mitigate potential damages** from dust-wind / thunderstorms.
- k. Conduct **mass public awareness campaigns** to educate residents and travelers in vulnerable areas about the risks of flash flooding / landslides / avalanche / blizzard and take precautionary measures.
- l. **Advise general public** to **seek shelter** in safe areas, such as sturdy buildings or underground structures during dust-wind / hail-thunderstorms and avoid objects that pose a risk of falling / being struck by lightning.
- m. **Strengthen coordination** among all **relevant departments** and agencies to facilitate timely **sharing of information** and resources during emergency situations.

- n. **Establish reliable communication channels** with local communities to provide timely updates, instructions and emergency contact information.
 - o. **Advise farmers** to take **necessary mitigative** and **precautionary measures** to safeguard their crops through timely harvesting, safe storage or any other precaution from adverse effects of dust-wind-thunderstorms / hailstorms and likely drop in temperatures.
 - p. **Share** daily / routine **updates** with NDMA in case of any eventuality.

Rain with Wind/Thunderstorm predicted from 10th to 15th April (with occasional gaps)

Met Office informed that a westerly wave is likely to enter upper parts of the country from 10th April followed by another strong westerly wave on 12th April that may grip most parts of the country on 13th April and persist till 15th April. Under the influence of this weather system:

Khyber Pakhtunkhwa: Rain-windstorm/thunderstorm is expected in Chitral, Dir, Swat, Abbottabad, Manshra, Haripur, Kohistan, Shangla, Buner and Malakand from **10th to 15th April** with occasional gaps while, Waziristan, Kohat, Lakki Marwat, Bannu, Dera Ismail Khan, Bajaur, Mohmand, Karak, Khyber, Peshawar, Charsadda, Nowshera, Swabi, Mardan and Kurram with occasional gaps from **12th to 15th April**. **Isolated heavy fall and hailstorm is also expected from 13th to 15th April.**

Gilgit-Baltistan/Kashmir: Rain-wind/thunderstorm (snowfall over high mountains) is expected in Gilgit-Baltistan (Diamir, Astore, Ghizer, Skardu, Hunza, Gilgit, Ghanche, Shigar), Kashmir (Neelum valley, Muzaffarabad, Rawalakot, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Haveli, Sudhanoti, Kotli, Bhimber, Mirpur) with occasional gaps from **10th to 15th April**. **Isolated heavy fall and hailstorm is also expected from 13th to 15th April.**

Punjab/Islamabad: Rain-wind/thunderstorm is expected in Murree, Galliat, Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal on **10th and then 12th (evening/night) to 15th April**, with occasional gaps while Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Sialkot, Narowal, Lahore, Kasur, Okara, Faisalabad, Toba Tek Singh, Jhang, Khushab, Sargodha, Mianwali, Dera Ghazi Khan, Rajanpur, Bhakkar, Layyah, Multan, Pakpattan, Sahiwal, Kot Addu, Muzaffargarh, Rahim Yar Khan, Sadiqabad, Khanpur, Bahawalpur and Bahawalnagar with occasional gaps from **12th (evening/night) to 15th April**. **Isolated windstorm/hailstorm is also expected from 13th to 15th April.**

Balochistan: Rain-wind/thunderstorm (with isolated heavy falls) is expected in Zhob, Sherani, Barkhan, Musakhel, Kohlu, Sibbi, Jhal Magsi, Loralai, Ziarat, Quetta, Chaman, Pishin, Qila Abdullah, Qila Saifullah, Kalat, Lasbella, Khuzdar, Chagi, Panjgur, Gawadar and Kech from **12th to 14th April**.

Sindh: Rain-wind/thunderstorm is expected in Sukkur, Jacobabad, Kashmore, Larkana, Dadu, Qambar Shahdad Kot, Jamshoro and Sanghar on **13th & 14th April**. However, isolated rain-wind/thunderstorm is also expected in Karachi, Hyderabad during the period.

Possible Impacts and advises:

- Heavy rainfall may generate flash flooding in local nullahs/Streams of Dir, Swat, Chitral, Kohistan, Manshra, Tributaries of Kabul River, Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir from 13th to 15th April
- Possibility of landslides in Upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Murree, Galiyat, Kashmir and Gilgit Baltistan and may affect the vulnerable locations from 13th to 15th April.
- Windstorm/hailstorm and lightning may damage standing crops, loose structures like electric poles, vehicles and solar panels etc during the period.
- Farmers especially in wheat harvested areas are advised to manage their crops according to weather conditions.
- Tourists are advised to avoid unnecessary traveling during the wet period.
- Temperatures are likely to drop during the wet spell.

Note: All concerned authorities are advised to remain "ALERT" and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward situation during the forecast period.

گت پختہ خواہ: 10 سے 15 اپریل کے دوران گلگت بلتستان (دیاسیر، استور، غدر، اسکردو، ہنزہ، گلگت، گانچھے، شکر، کشمیر (دوہی نیلم، مظفر آباد، راولا کوٹ، پونچھ، ڈیپال، پٹن، جویلی، سدھوتی، کوٹلی، جمشیر، میر پور) میں تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ وقفے وقفے سے بارش اور بلند و بالا پہاڑوں پر بریلی کا امکان۔ 13 سے 15 اپریل کے دوران چتر مقبالت پر موسلا دھار بارش اور ڈالہ ہادی کی بھی توقع۔

پنجاب اسلام آباد: 10 اپریل اور 12 (شام لاند) سے 15 اپریل کے دوران مری، گیات، اسلام آباد اور اوپنڈی، انک اور پٹوال میں وقفے وقفے سے جبکہ 12 (شام لاند) سے 15 اپریل کے دوران جلم، منڈی بہاؤالدین، گجرات، گوجرانوالہ، حافظ آباد، سیالکوٹ، نارووال، لاہور، قصور، اوکاڑہ، فیصل آباد، ٹوبہ ٹیک سنگھ، چنگ، خوشاب، سرگودھا، میانوالی، ڈیرہ غازی خان، راجن پور، بکسر، ایب، ملتان، پاکپتن، ساہیوال، کوٹ اوو، مظفر گڑھ، رحیم یار خان، صادق آباد، خان پور، بہاولپور اور بہاولنگر میں وقفے وقفے سے آندھی / بجڑ پلنے اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان۔ 13 سے 15 اپریل کے دوران بعض اضلاع میں چھٹا پلنے اور وادی کی بھی توقع۔

بلوچستان: 12 سے 14 اپریل کے دوران ڈوب، شیرانی، بارکھان، موئی خیل، کولہ، سی، جھل گسی، لورالائی، زارت، کوئٹہ، چمن، پشین، قلعہ عبداللہ، قلعہ سیف اللہ، سیپل، قلات، خضدار، چاغی، چگور، گوبور اور کچ میں آندھی / بجڑ پلنے اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش اور بعض مقبالت پر تیز / موسلا دھار بارش کا امکان۔

سندھ: 13 اور 14 اپریل کے دوران سکھر، جیکب آباد، کٹہ، مور، لاڑکانہ، دادو، قمبر شہد کوٹ، جامشورو اور ساکنڈ میں تیز ہواؤں آندھی اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان۔ اس دوران کراچی اور حیدرآباد میں بھی آندھی / بجڑ پلنے اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کی توقع۔

تفصیلات کے لیے:

- 10 سے 15 اپریل کے دوران تیز موسلا دھار بارش کے باعث ہائیڈرو پاور کے لیے متعدد علاقوں میں خطرات کا اندیشہ۔
- 13 سے 15 اپریل کے دوران تیز ہواؤں کے باعث ہائیڈرو پاور کے لیے خطرات کا اندیشہ۔
- آندھی / بجڑ پلنے اور گرج چمک کے باعث کئی اضلاع میں بجلی کا بند ہونا۔
- کسان حراستی اضلاع میں موسمیاتی صورتحال کے مطابق ضروری اقدامات کر رہے ہیں۔
- سیاحات 13 سے 15 اپریل کے دوران غیر ضروری سفر سے اجتناب کریں۔
- بارش کے دوران درجہ حرارت میں کمی کا امکان۔
