SUBJECT: MORE RAIN-THUNDERSHOWERS PREDICTED IN THE UPPER AND CENTRAL PART FROM 13TH TO 15TH AUGUST

Met office (vide Letter No. NWFC-5(10A)/2026/07) informed that at monsoon currents are penetrating upper parts of the country. A westerly wave is also affecting upper parts of the country. Under the influence of this weather system:

- **Rain-wind/thundershowers (with few heavyfalls)** is expected in **Northeast Punjab (Murree, Sialkot, Narowal, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Wazirabad, Lahore, Kasur, Sheikhupura, Nankana Sahib)** from **12th (night) to 15th August** with occasional gaps.
- **Rain-wind/thundershowers (with few heavyfalls)** is expected in **Rawalpindi and Pothohar region** from **13th (evening/night) to 15th August** with occasional gaps.
- **Rain-wind/thundershowers** is also expected in **Sargodha, Faisalabad, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Khushab, Layyah, Bhakkar, Noorpurthal, Sahiwal, Pakpattan, Bahawalnagar, Bahawalpur, D.G.Khan** from **12th (night) to 15th August**.

2. Possible Impacts:

- Heavy rains may cause Urban flooding in low lying areas of **Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Gujrat, Sialkot and Lahore** during the forecast period.
- Landslides may occur in vulnerable areas of **Murree and Galliat** during the forecast period.
- Tourists and travelers are advised to remain cautious during the forecast period.
- Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities keeping in view the weather conditions and take care of their livestock as well.

3. In order to maintain high level of preparedness and mitigation of the disaster all the District administrations and line departments are requested to ensure the following measures:

- i. Ensure **sufficient staffing round-the-clock in DEOCs** for effective coordination and response.
- ii. **Coordinate** with PDMA and all relevant departments to ensure **a unified prompt response**.
- iii. Ensure accurate and timely dissemination of **information on safety measures and evacuation plans** through **electronic and social media**.
- iv. Ensure **effective contingency planning** and preparedness measures for **flooding** in Monsoon season 2026.
- v. Ensure timely **desilting and clearance of all the drains** and **pre-placement of heavy earth moving machinery** at choke points to facilitate rapid response.
- vi. Motorway Police shall ensure regular traffic advisories, timely updates on road conditions, and guidance to travelers for safe travel.
- vii. Deploy **additional staff** and resources to high-risk areas.
- viii. Stay **alert Rescue 1122** and ensure pre-position search and rescue teams (DRF) along with necessary equipment
- ix. Generate **Situation Reports (SITREPS)** to cover any major incidents/developments on regular basis.
- x. Ensure **data collection and reporting** for post-flood analysis and improvements.

More rain-thundershowers predicted in upper and central parts from 13th to 15th August

Met office has informed that monsoon currents are penetrating upper parts of the country. A westerly wave is also affecting upper parts of the country. Under the influence of this weather system:

- **Rain-wind/thundershowers (with few heavyfalls)** is expected in **Kashmir** (Neelum valley, Muzaffarabad, Rawalakot, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Haveli, Sudhanoti, Kotli, Bhimber, Mirpur), **Gilgit-Baltistan** (Diamir, Astore, Ghizer, Skardu, Hunza, Gilgit, Ghanche, Shigar), **Upper Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa** (Dir, Chitral, Swat, Kohistan, Malakand, Shangla, Battagram, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Galiyat, Buner, Bajaur, Mohmand, Peshawar, Nowshera, Mardan, Swabi, Haripur, Kurram, Khyber) and **Northeast Punjab** (Murree, Sialkot, Narowal, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Wazirabad, Lahore, Kasur, Sheikhupura, Nankana Sahib) from **12th (night) to 15th August** with occasional gaps.
- **Rain-wind/thundershowers (with few heavyfalls)** is expected in **Islamabad/Rawalpindi and Pothohar region** from **13th (evening/night) to 15th August** with occasional gaps.
- **Rain-wind/thundershowers** is also expected in Sargodha, Faisalabad, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Khushab, Layyah, Bhakkar, Noorpurthal, Sahiwal, Pakpattan, Bahawalnagar, Bahawalpur, D.G.Khan, Zhob, Barkhan and Musakhel from **12th (night) to 15th August**.
- Partly cloudy to cloudy weather conditions are expected in southeastern and coastal areas of Sindh with chances of rain-wind/thundershowers in Tharparkar, Umerkot and Sanghar districts on **12th & 13th August**. Hot and humid weather to prevail elsewhere in Sindh during next few days.
- **Possible Impacts and advises:**
 - Heavy rains may cause Urban flooding in low lying areas of Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Mardan, Swabi, Gujranwala, Gujrat, Sialkot and Lahore during the forecast period.
 - Landslides may occur in vulnerable areas of upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Dir, Chitral, Swat, Kohistan, Buner, Battagram, Mansehra, Haripur, Abbottabad), Gilgit-Baltistan, Murree, Galiyat and Kashmir during the forecast period.
 - Tourists and travelers are advised to remain cautious during the forecast period.
 - Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities keeping in view the weather conditions and take care of their livestock as well.

Note: All concerned authorities are advised to remain “Vigilant” and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward Situation during the forecast period.

13 اگست سے 15 اگست کے دوران بالائی اور وسطی علاقوں میں مزید بارشوں کی پیش گوئی

محکمہ موسمیات کے مطابق مون سون ہوائیں ملک کے بالائی علاقوں میں داخل ہو رہی ہیں۔ جبکہ مغربی ہواؤں کا ایک سلسلہ ملک کے بالائی علاقوں کو بھی متاثر کر رہا ہے۔ ان موسمی نظام کے زیر اثر:

- **12 اگست (رات) سے 15 اگست کے دوران کشمیر** (واوی نیلم، مظفر آباد، راولا کوٹ، پونچھ، ہٹیاں، باغ، حویلی، سدھوتی، کوٹلی، بھمبر، میرپور، گلگت بلتستان (دیپام، استور، غدر، اسکردو، ہنزہ، گلگت، گانچے، شگر، بالائی خیبر پختونخوا (دیر، چترال، سوات، کوہستان، مالاکنڈ، شانگلہ، بنگرام، مانسہرہ، ایبٹ آباد، گلیات، یونیر، باجوڑ، مہمند، پشاور، نوشہرہ، مردان، صوابی، ہری پور، کرم اور خیبر) اور شمال مشرقی پنجاب (مری، سیالکوٹ، نارووال، منڈی بہاؤالدین، گجرات، گوجرانوالہ، حافظ آباد، وزیر آباد، لاہور، اوکاڑہ، قصور، شیخوپورہ، ننکانہ صاحب) میں تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان۔ جبکہ بعض مقامات پر موسلا دھار بارش بھی متوقع۔
- **13 اگست (شام/رات) سے 15 اگست کے دوران اسلام آباد/راولپنڈی اور خطہ پوٹھوہار** میں تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان۔ جبکہ بعض مقامات پر موسلا دھار بارش بھی متوقع۔
- **12 اگست (رات) سے 15 اگست کے دوران سرگودھا، فیصل آباد، جھنگ، ٹوبہ ٹیک سنگھ، خوشاب، لیہ، بھکر، نورپور، تھل، ساہیوال، پاکپتن، بہاولنگر، بہاولپور، ڈیرہ غازی خان، ٹوبہ، بارکھان اور موسیٰ خیل میں تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان۔**
- **12 اور 13 اگست کے روز** سندھ کے جنوب مشرقی اور ساحلی علاقوں میں مطلع جزوی ابر آلود/ابر آلود رہنے کے علاوہ تھریپارکر، عمرکوٹ اور ساگھڑ کے اضلاع میں تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان۔ تاہم سندھ کے دیگر علاقوں میں آئندہ چند روز کے دوران موسم گرم اور مرطوب رہنے کی توقع۔

محکمہ اثرات اور احتیاطی تدابیر:

- موسلا دھار بارشوں کے باعث اسلام آباد/راولپنڈی، مردان، صوابی، گوجرانوالہ، گجرات، سیالکوٹ اور لاہور میں نشیبی علاقوں میں اربن فلڈنگ کا اندیشہ۔
- بالائی خیبر پختونخوا (دیر، چترال، سوات، کوہستان، یونیر، بنگرام، مانسہرہ، ہری پور، ایبٹ آباد)، گلگت بلتستان، مری، گلیات اور کشمیر کے پہاڑی علاقوں میں لینڈ سلائیڈنگ کا خدشہ۔
- سیاح اور مسافر حضرات موسمی پیش گوئی کے دوران محتاط رہیں اور غیر ضروری سفر سے گریز کریں۔
- کسان حضرات موسمی حالات کو مد نظر رکھتے ہوئے اپنی زرعی سرگرمیوں کی منصوبہ بندی کریں اور مویشیوں کی حفاظت کا بھی خصوصی خیال رکھیں۔
