SUBJECT: MORE RAIN THUNDERSHOWERS PREDICTED IN SOUTHERN/CENTRAL PARTS FROM FRIDAY EVENING/NIGHT TO MONDAY

Met office (vide Letter No. NWFC-5(10A)/2026/05) informed that due to the LPA (Low-Pressure Area) monsoon currents are penetrating in Southern and central parts of the country. Under the influence of this weather system:

- **Rain windstorm/thundershower (with isolated heavy falls)** is expected in Lahore, Sheikhupura Okara, Sahiwal, Pak Pattan, Vehari, Khanewal, Multan, Dera Gazi Khan, Rajanpur, Kot Addu, Muzaffargarh, Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, R Y Khan and Khan Pur from **24th (evening/night) to 27th July**.
- **Mostly partly cloudy at times cloudy weather conditions with rain-thundershower** is expected in Rawalpindi, Murree, Galliat, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Wazirabad, Faisalabad, Khushab, Sargodha, Sialkot, Narowal, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Nankana Sahib and Chiniot from **24th (evening/night) to 26th July with occasional gaps**.

2. Possible Impacts:

- Heavy rains may cause Urban flooding in Gujranwala, Lahore, on **24th/25th July** While in Bahawalpur, R Y Khan, Sialkot, Multan and Faisalabad from **24th to 26th July**.
- Windstorm & lightning may damage weak structures (solar panels, electric poles, bill boards etc.) during the forecast period.
- Tourists and travelers are advised to remain cautious during the forecast period.
- Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities keeping in view the weather conditions and take care of their livestock as well.

3. In order to maintain high level of preparedness and mitigation of the disaster all the district administrations and line departments are requested to ensure the following measures:

- i. Ensure **sufficient staffing round-the-clock in DEOCs** for effective coordination and response.
- ii. **Coordinate** with PDMA and all relevant departments to ensure **a unified prompt response**.
- iii. Ensure accurate and timely dissemination of **information on safety measures and evacuation plans** through **electronic and social media**.
- iv. Ensure **effective contingency planning** and preparedness measures for **urban flooding** in Monsoon season 2026.
- v. Ensure timely **desilting and clearance of all the drains** and **pre-placement of heavy earth moving machinery** at choke points to facilitate rapid response.
- vi. Motorway Police shall ensure regular traffic advisories, timely updates on road conditions, and guidance to travelers for safe travel.
- vii. Deploy **additional staff** and resources to high-risk areas.
- viii. Stay **alert Rescue 1122** and ensure pre-position search and rescue teams (DRF) along with necessary equipment
- ix. Generate **Situation Reports (SITREPS)** to cover any major incidents/developments on regular basis.
- x. Ensure **data collection and reporting** for post-flood analysis and improvements.
