Subject: **MORE RAINS/ SNOW PREDICTED DURING THE WEEKEND (FRIDAY, 21 JAN 2022 TO MONDAY 24 JAN 2022)**

In continuation to this office earlier letter No. 275-Controlroom-PDMA/2022 dated 19.01.2022, Pakistan Metrological Department (PMD) has informed that another weather system is likely to enter Upper and Central Parts of the Country on Friday 21 January 2022 to Monday 24 January 2022. Under the influence of this weather system:

- More rain-thunderstorm with snowfall over the hills (with few heavy falls & hailstorm) are expected in Murree, Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jehlum, Mandi Bahaudin, Sarghodha, Khushab, Bhakkar, Mianwali, Faisalabad, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Gujranwala, Gujrat, Sialkot, Narowal, Lahore and Kasur from Friday (evening/night) to Monday (morning).
- Rain- thunderstorm in Okara, Sahiwal, Pakpattan, D.G Khan, Layyah, Rajanpur, Multan, Khanewal and Bahawalnagar from Friday (evening/night) to Saturday.

**Possible Impacts:**

- Heavy snowfall may cause road closures in Murree and Galliyat on Saturday and Sunday.
- Heavy falls may cause urban flooding in Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Lahore, Faisalabad, Sarghodha and Sialkot during the weekend.
- Possibility of landslides in vulnerable areas of Murree and Galliyat cannot be ruled out during the period.

**In the wake of the current situations it is requested that:**

- Concerned DDMA's to coordinate with relevant departments (NHA, FWO and C&W) for restoration of roads in case of any blockage / obstruction.
- DDMA's to ensure that Tourist / Visitors in at-risk / affected areas to be apprised / forewarned about weather forecast.
- Travelers on Provincial & National Highways in at-risk / affected areas to be forewarned of adverse conditions and may be detoured to safe waiting areas under guidance of respective DDMA's, Local Authorities, and National Highway & Motorway Police etc.

In case of any eventuality, twice daily / routine updates to be shared with PDMA for onward submission to quarters concerned.
