

Subject: **WEATHER FORECAST FOR SUNDAY (NIGHT)**

Met Office has informed that mainly cold and dry weather is expected in most plain areas of the country. Cold and dry weather is expected in most districts of the province, while fog is likely to prevail in plain areas including Pothohar region during morning. However, light rain/snow is likely in Murree and Galyat during Sunday night i.e.06.02.2022.

2. In the wake of the current situation, It is requested that:
  - DDMA Rawalpindi is to coordinate with relevant departments (NHA, FWO and C&W) for restoration of roads in case of any blockage/obstruction.
  - DDMA to ensure that tourists/visitors in at risk/affected areas to be apprised/forewarned about weather forecast.
  - Travelers on Provincial and National Highways in at risk/affected area to be forewarned of adverse conditions and may detoured to safe waiting areas under guidance of respective DDMA, Local Authorities and National Highways & Motorways Police.
3. In case of any eventuality, twice daily/routine updates to be shared with PDMA for onward submission to quarters concerned.
