Subject: **PRE-MONSOON RAINS-THUNDERSHOWERS FROM 15 JUNE 2022**

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has informed that moist currents from the Arabian Sea are likely to penetrate in Upper Parts of the Country from Wednesday, 15 June (evening / night). Under the influence of this system the following weather conditions are expected: -

- Rain-wind / thundershowers are expected in Attock, Rawalpindi, Murree, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mianwali, Sargodha, Khushab, Hafizabad, Mandi Bahauddin, Sialkot, Narowal, Lahore, Sheikhupura, Faisalabad and Toba Tek Singh from Thursday, 16 June – Tuesday, 21 June.
- Rain-wind / thundershowers are expected in Multan, Dera Ghazi Khan, Rajanpur, Bhakkar, Layyah, Muzaffargarh, Kot Adu, Sahiwal, Khanewal, Pakpattan, Okara, Bahawalnagar, Bahawalpur, Khanpur and Rahim Yar Khan from Friday, 17 June – Monday, 20 June (with occasional gaps).
- Heavy Falls are expected in Rawalpindi, Jhelum, Gujranwala, Sialkot, Lahore, Kasur and Sheikhupura on Thursday, 16 June (evening / night) and Friday, 17 June that may generate Urban Flooding.

محلہ موسمیات کے مطابق بحیرہ عرب سے مرطوب ہوائیں 15 جون (بدھ) شام / رات سے ملک کے بالائی علاقوں میں داخل ہوں گی۔ جس کے باعث:

- اٹک، راولپنڈی، مری، چکوال، جہلم، میانوالی، سرگودھا، خوشاب، حافظ آباد، منڈی بہاؤ الدین، سیالکوٹ، نارووال، لاہور، شیخوپورہ، فیصل آباد اور ٹوبہ ٹیک سنگھ میں 16 جون بروز جمعرات تا 21 جون بروز منگل تک تیز ہوا ہوں / گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان ہے۔
- ملتان، ڈیرہ غازی خان، راجن پور، بھکر، لیہ، مظفر گڑھ، کوٹ ادو، ساہیوال، خانیوال، پاکپتن، اوکاڑہ، بہاولنگر، بہاولپور، خانیپور اور رحیم یار خان میں 17 جون بروز جمعہ تا 20 جون بروز سوموار تک وقفے وقفے سے آندھی / تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان ہے۔
- راولپنڈی، جہلم، گوجرانوالہ، سیالکوٹ، لاہور، قصور اور شیخوپورہ میں بروز جمعرات، 16 جون (شام / رات) اور جمعہ، 17 جون کو موسلا دھار بارشوں کا امکان ہے جس کے باعث راولپنڈی اور لاہور میں اربن فلڈنگ کا خدشہ ہے۔

Advisory for All Concerned Stakeholders

- Coordinate with concerned departments (NHA, FWO and C&W) for restoration of roads in case of any blockage / obstruction / closures.
- Billboards and hoardings are secured from effects of thunderstorms / wind.
- Preplace necessary emergency equipment at vulnerable / strategic locations.
- Availability of emergency services personnel and equipment (Rescue 1122 / Fire Brigade / Ambulance / Civil Defense) during the forecasted period.
- Travelers / Visitors are forewarned about risks posed at landslide / flash flood vulnerable locations. Furthermore, Local Administration / Police / Rescue Services are to guide / provide assistance to safe area in case of any emergency.
- In case of any eventuality, routine updates will be shared with PDMA.

Possible Impacts: -

- Heatwave conditions are likely to subside.
- Water availability may improve for crops, vegetables and orchards.
- Wind / dust-thunderstorms may cause damages to loose structures in Islamabad and Punjab during the forecasted period.

2. All concerned authorities are advised to remain alert and also take all necessary precautionary measures during the forecasted period to avoid any loss of life/property.

3. The concerned Deputy Commissioners are advised to keep operational / functional the District Emergency Operations Centers (DEOCs) round the clock during the above-mentioned period under intimation to PDMA, Punjab.
